Historical Note:

The Spade and Trowel Garden Club was organized in July 1941 with the following charter members: Mrs. Winston Gilbert, president; Mrs. Kyle Whitescarver, vice-president; Mrs. Harry Myles, secretary; Mrs. W.J. Kraige, corresponding secretary; Mrs. N.H. Key, treasurer; Mrs. J.E. Davis, parliamentarian; and Mrs. Robert McNeil, publicity. Spade and Trowel was sponsored by the Grandin Court Garden Club. In 1942, Spade and Trowel joined the Virginia Federation of Garden Clubs. The club met in the homes of various members until the Roanoke Council of Garden Clubs purchased "Fairacres" in 1964. In addition to many efforts to beautify the Roanoke Valley and educate its citizens on gardening, the Spade and Trowel contributed to the community through various service projects and has also supported projects on the state and national level. The Spade and Trowel Garden Club disbanded in the 1990s, not long after celebrating its 50th Anniversary in 1991.

Scope and Content:

The Papers of the Spade and Trowel Garden Club consists of organizational records throughout the club's existence. Records in this collection include meeting minutes, treasurer's reports, club yearbooks, news clippings, correspondence, awards and scrapbooks. Records are well-kept and span 1941-1991, with the bulk of records ranging from the 1960s-1980s. Meeting minutes were kept in record ledgers for a number of years, before being recorded on loose-leaf paper. Scrapbooks were kept intact and are stored chronologically in separate boxes from the remainder of the collection.
