Historical Note:

Mill Mountain Playhouse was organized in 1963 as a nonprofit professional summer regional theater using Equity (union) actors, with first performances held in 1964. Beginning in the 1970s, productions utilized a "youth ensemble" company that included a mix of professional and amateur actors. Through 1976, performances were held in the ballroom of the former Rockledge Inn atop Mill Mountain. After that facility was destroyed by fire, the 1977-83 seasons were performed in the Grandin Theater. In December 1983 the group's name was changed to Mill Mountain Theatre, and it began holding performances in the Center in the Square Building.

Scope and Content:

The collection consists primarily of performance programs from the 1965 through 1997-1998 seasons; only in a very few instances are the playbills of all the season's performances included. Some programs contain histories of the Mill Mountain Playhouse/Mill Mountain Theatre. For example, 1968 provides a 5-year retrospective, there is a timeline history in the 1982 program, and the 1988-89 Silver Anniversary Season playbills include photographs of prior productions. Some playbills list the entire season's performance schedule. Season brochures are available for a number of years.
