## Student Participation in Government

Student Government was started at Jefferson in 1928 through the efforts of both the faculty and the student body. Its purpose has been to give each student a voice in the government of the school, and to instill in him a spirit of honesty and coöperation. To attain these aims, a Prefect and a Student Council were formed. In the former are vested the legislative, executive and judicial powers of the organization. 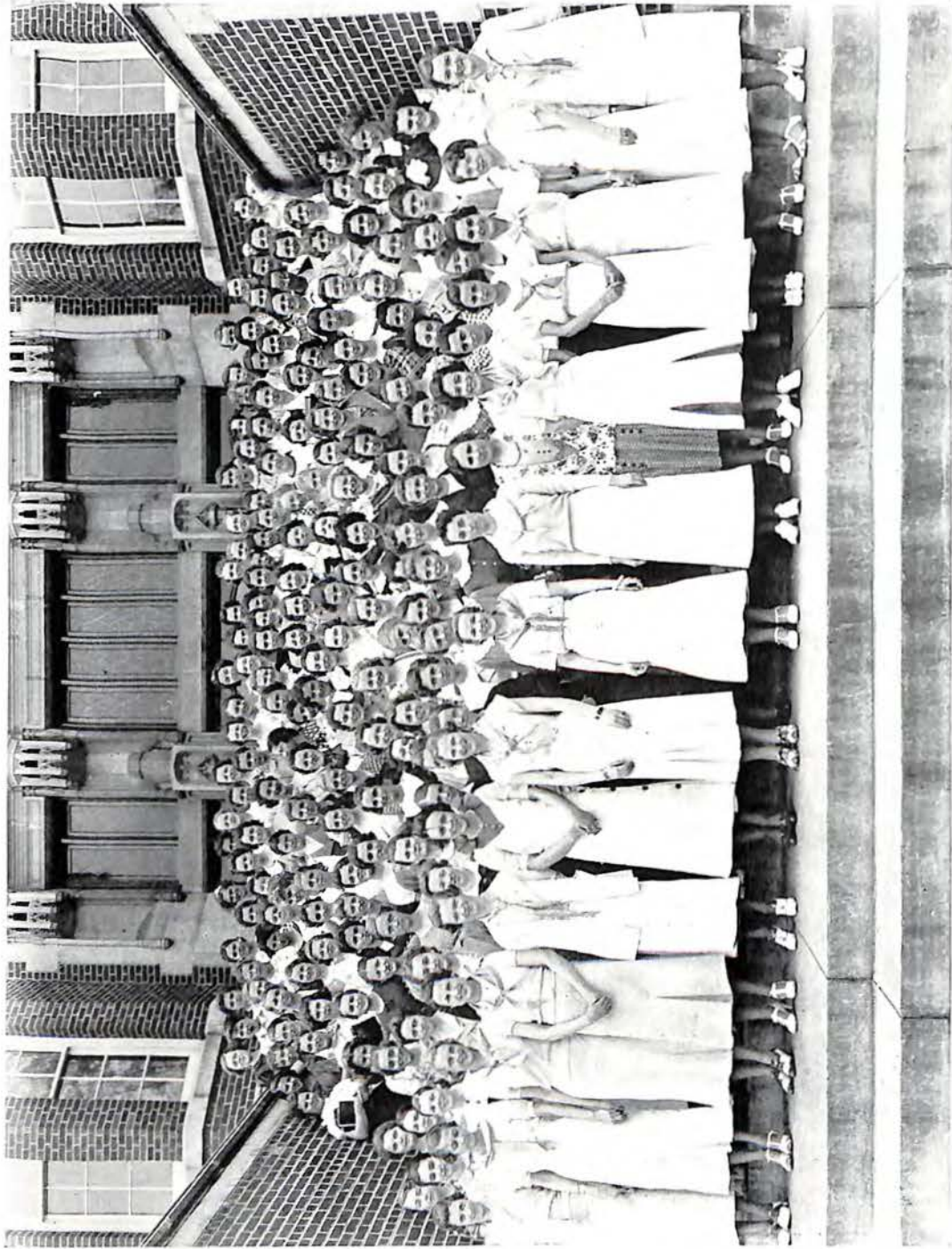

## The Junior Hi-Y Club

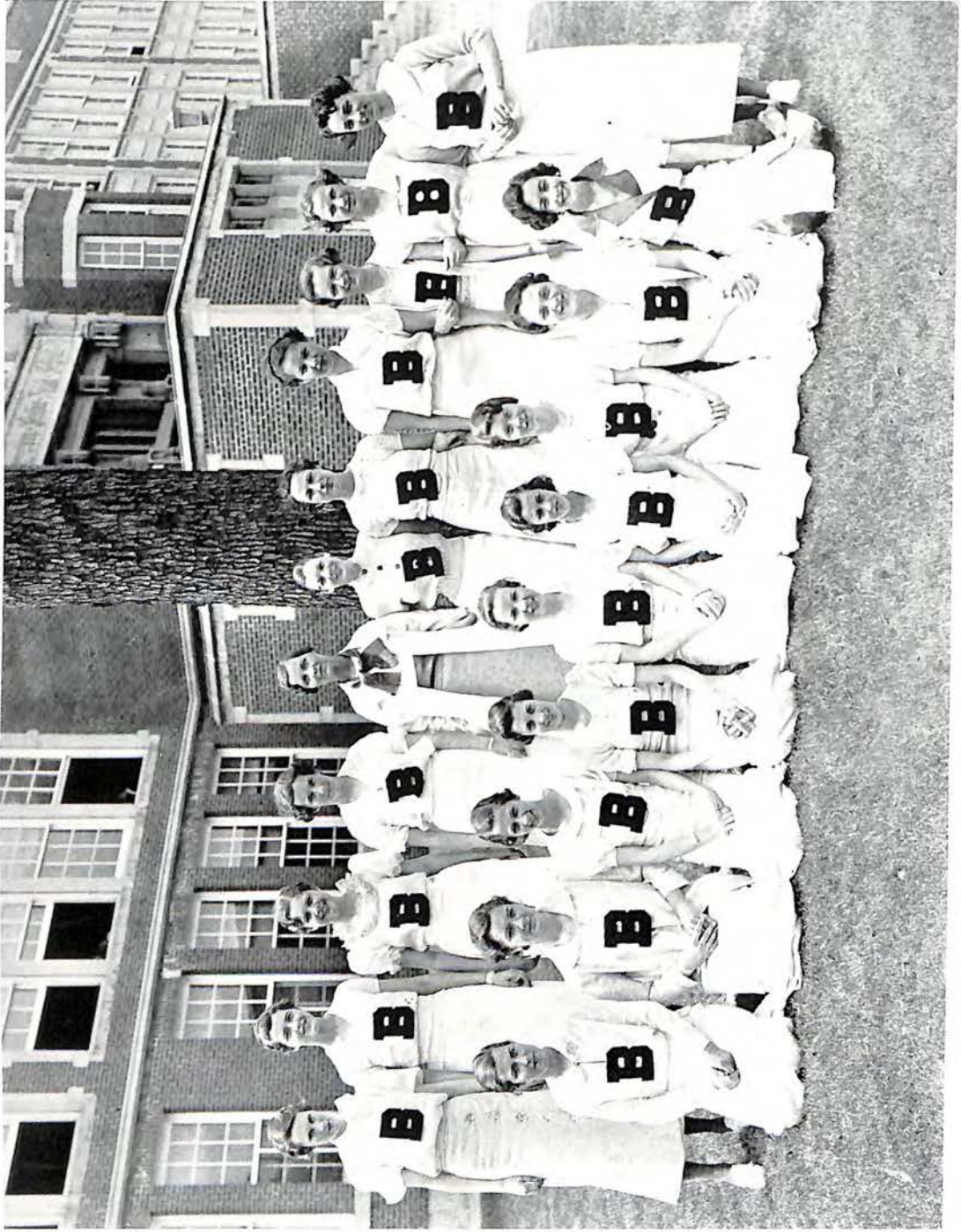
The Junior Hi-Y is a new organization at Jefferson High. It is the first club of its kind to be organized in the 2d Hi-Y District of Virginia.

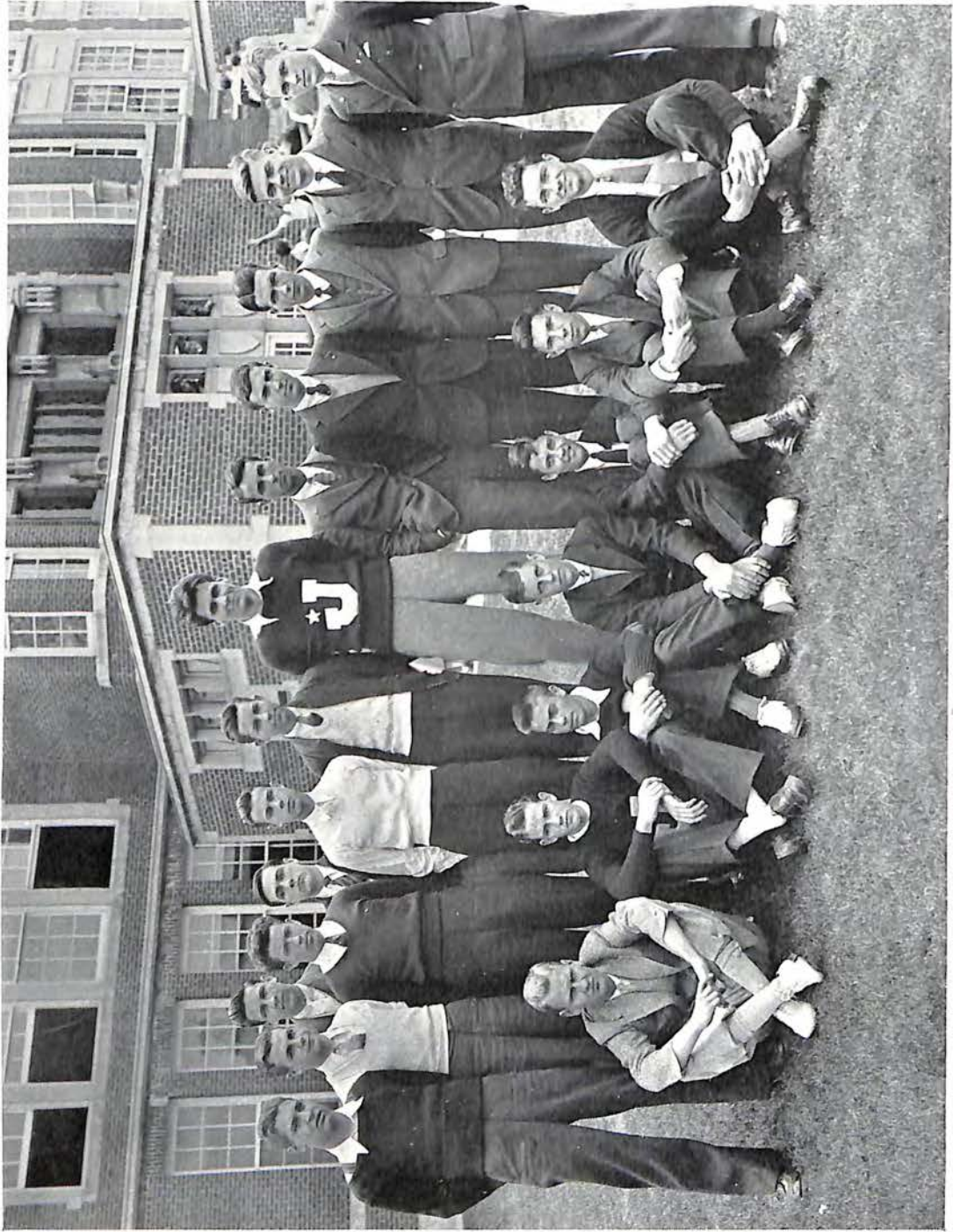

During the past year this society achieved a record membership of one hundred and forty.

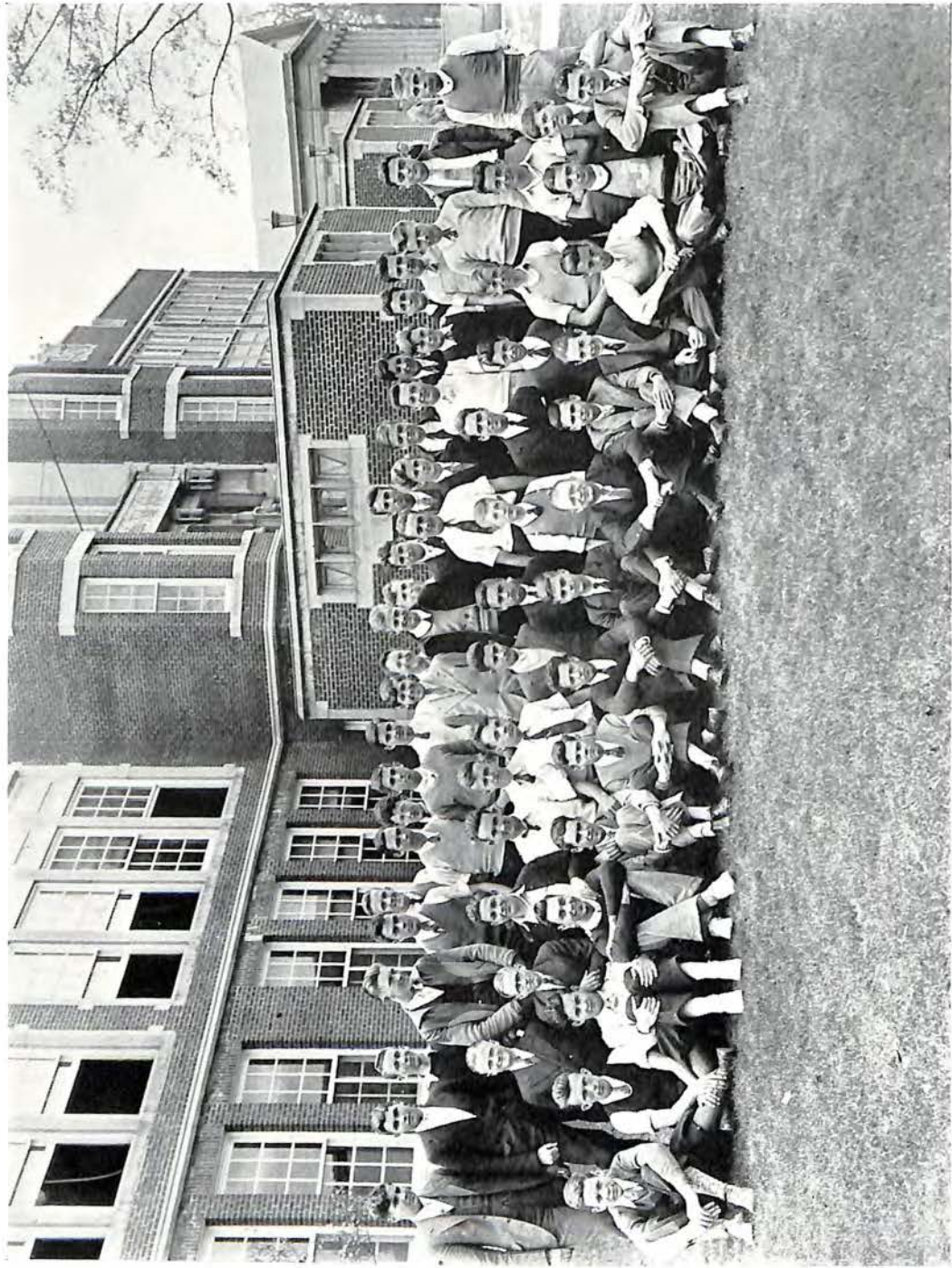
In the fall interesting programs were given on mythology, while in the spring term miscellaneous programs on current topics were presented.

The Program Chairman received such a good response from the members who were asked to contribute to the program that approximately twenty-five girls received letters or stars.

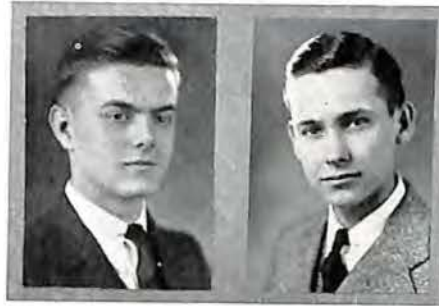

The team, handicapped by being composed for the most part of new recruits, did much toward whipping into shape some excellent gridders for next season. Watch 'em!

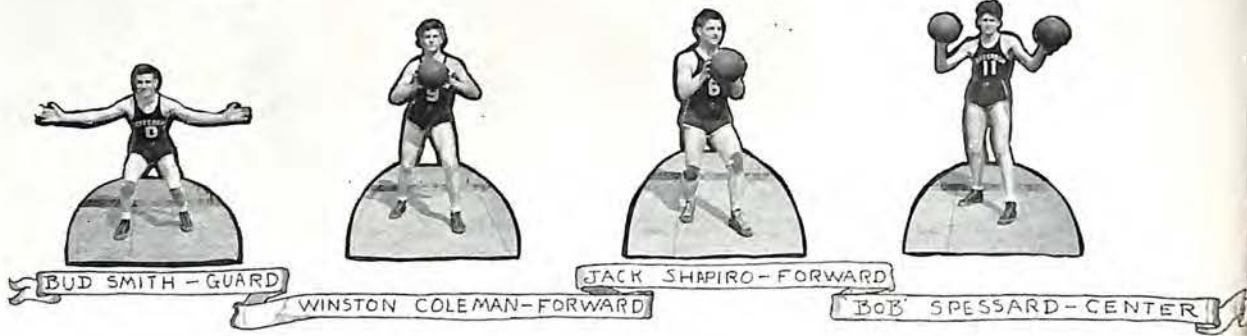

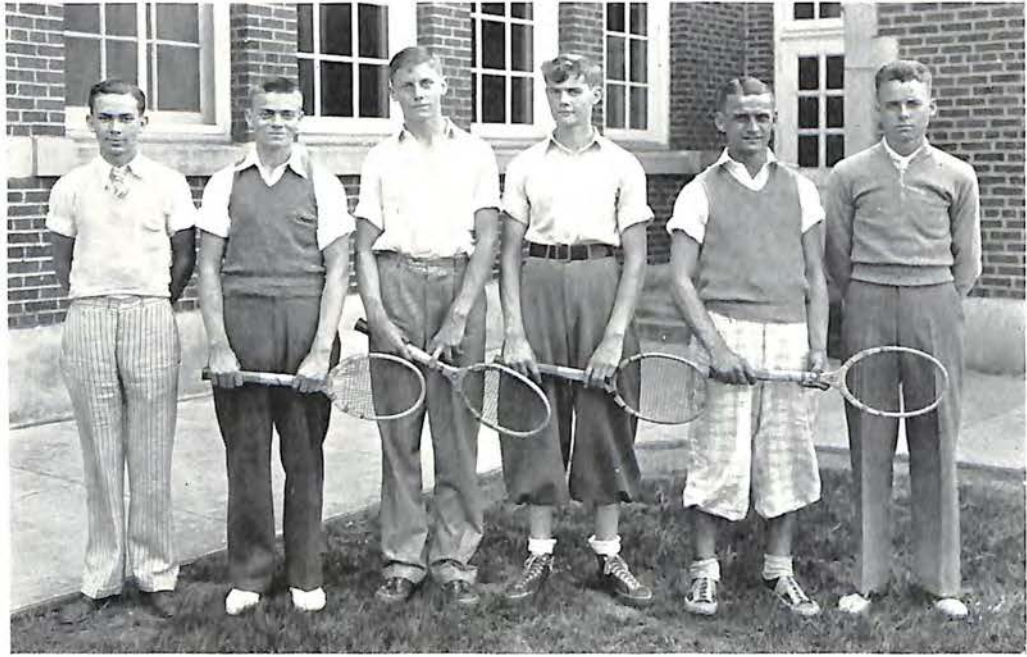
