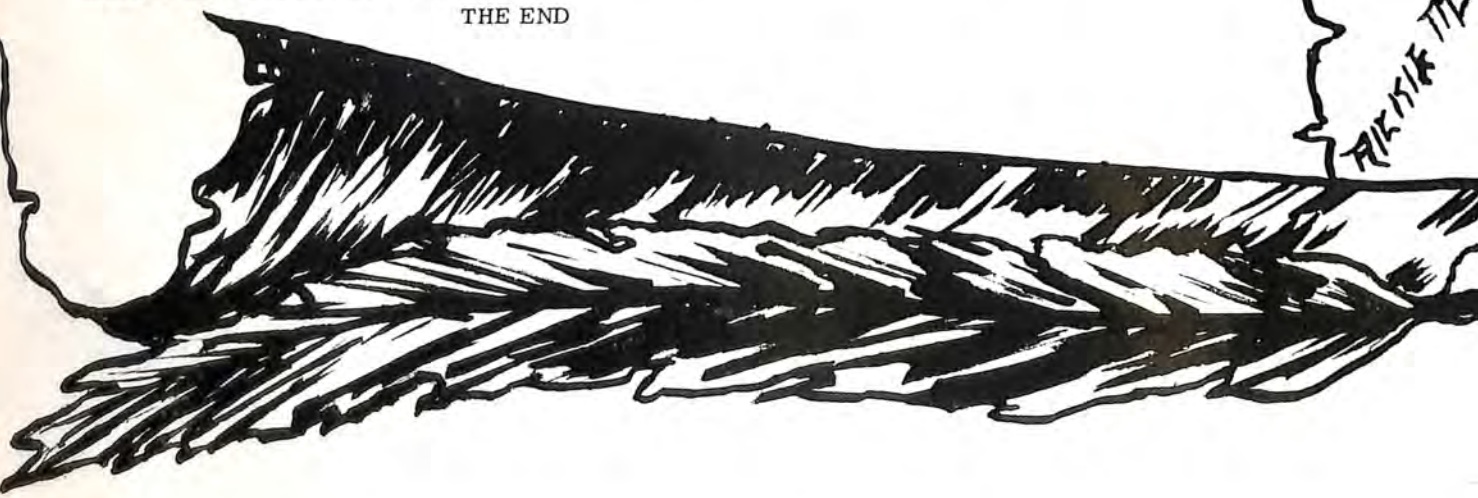
Susan Assaid,--leaves Miss Hutton her Latin book and hopes that she will never forget to decline a verb and conjugate a noun.

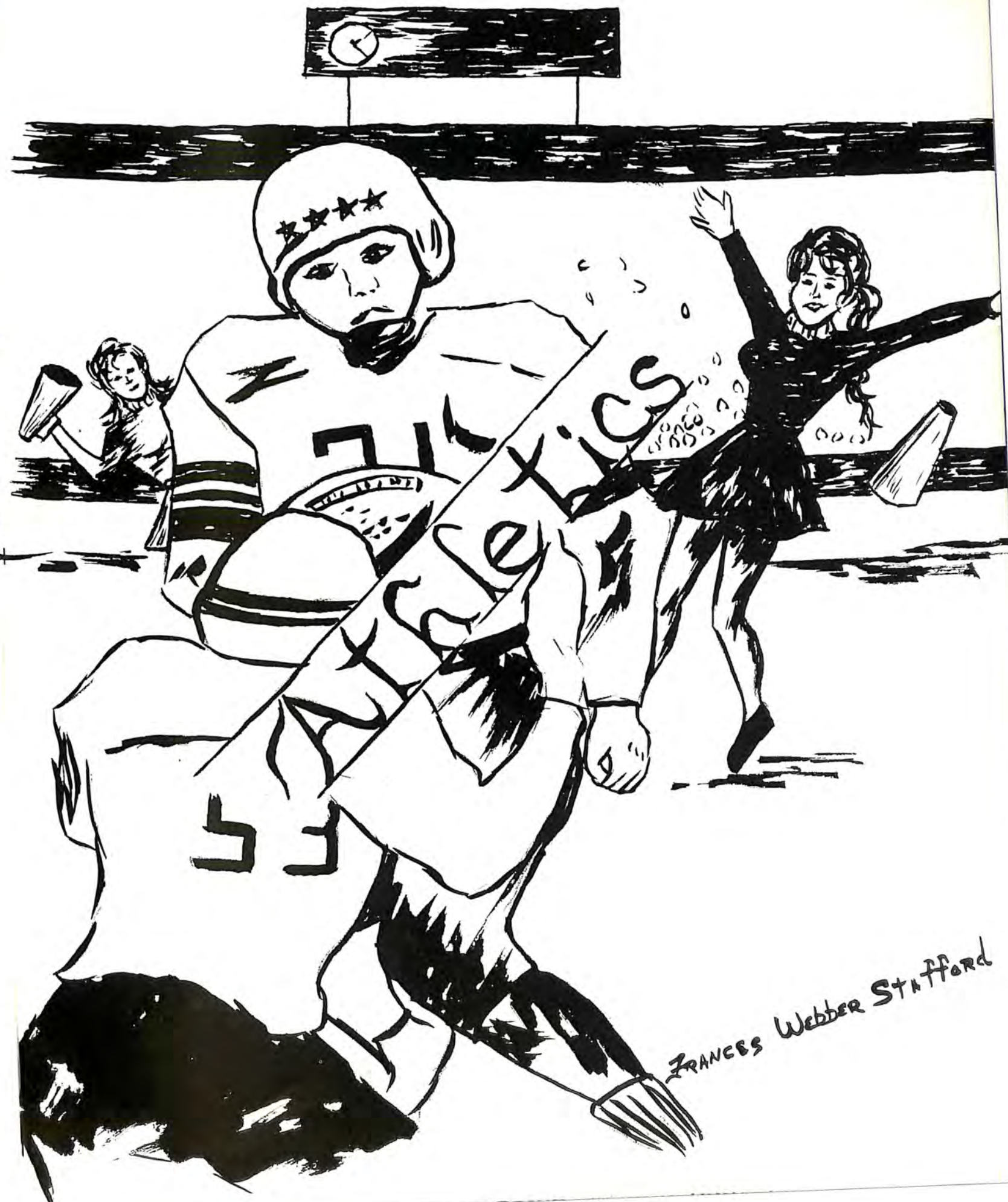

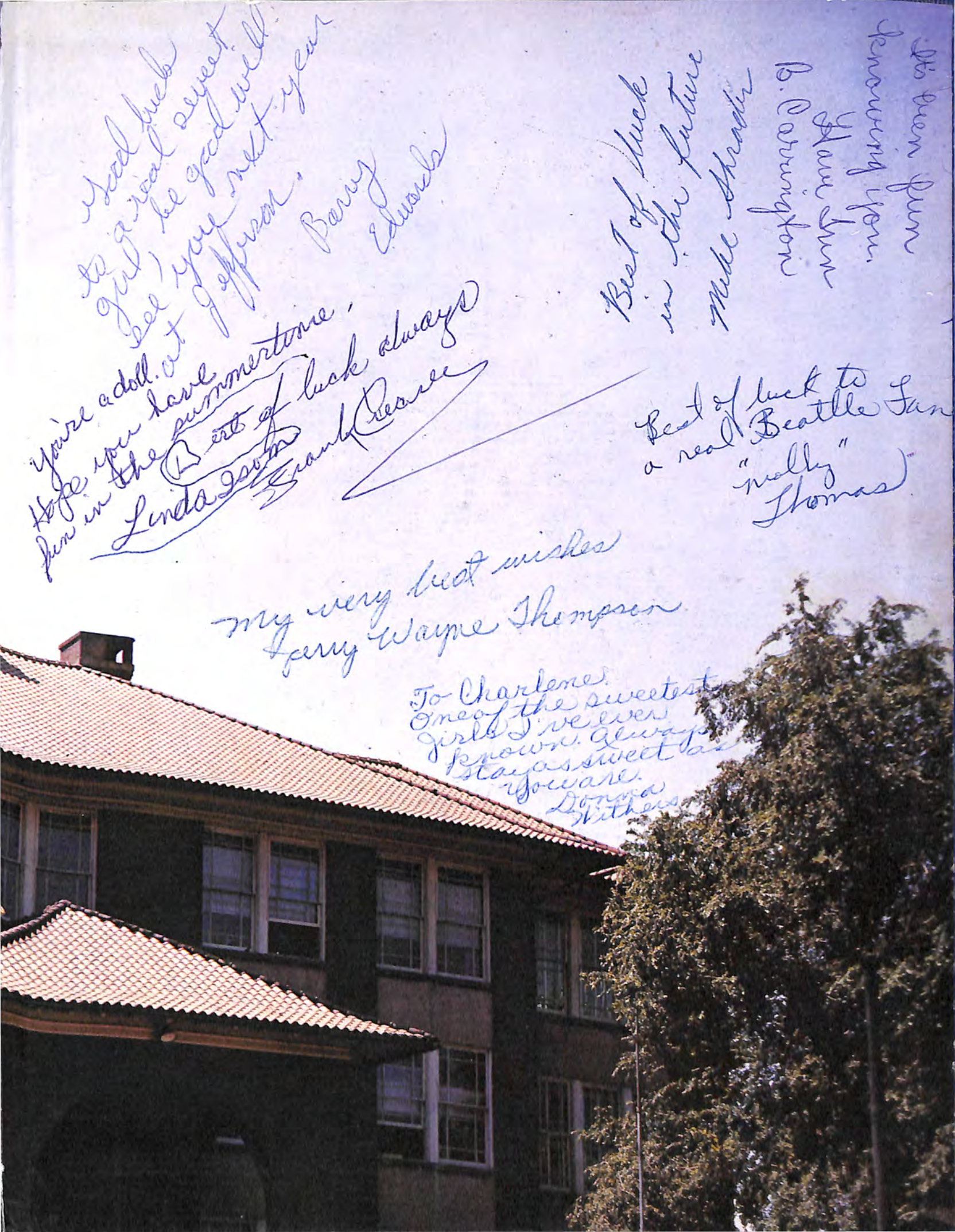
