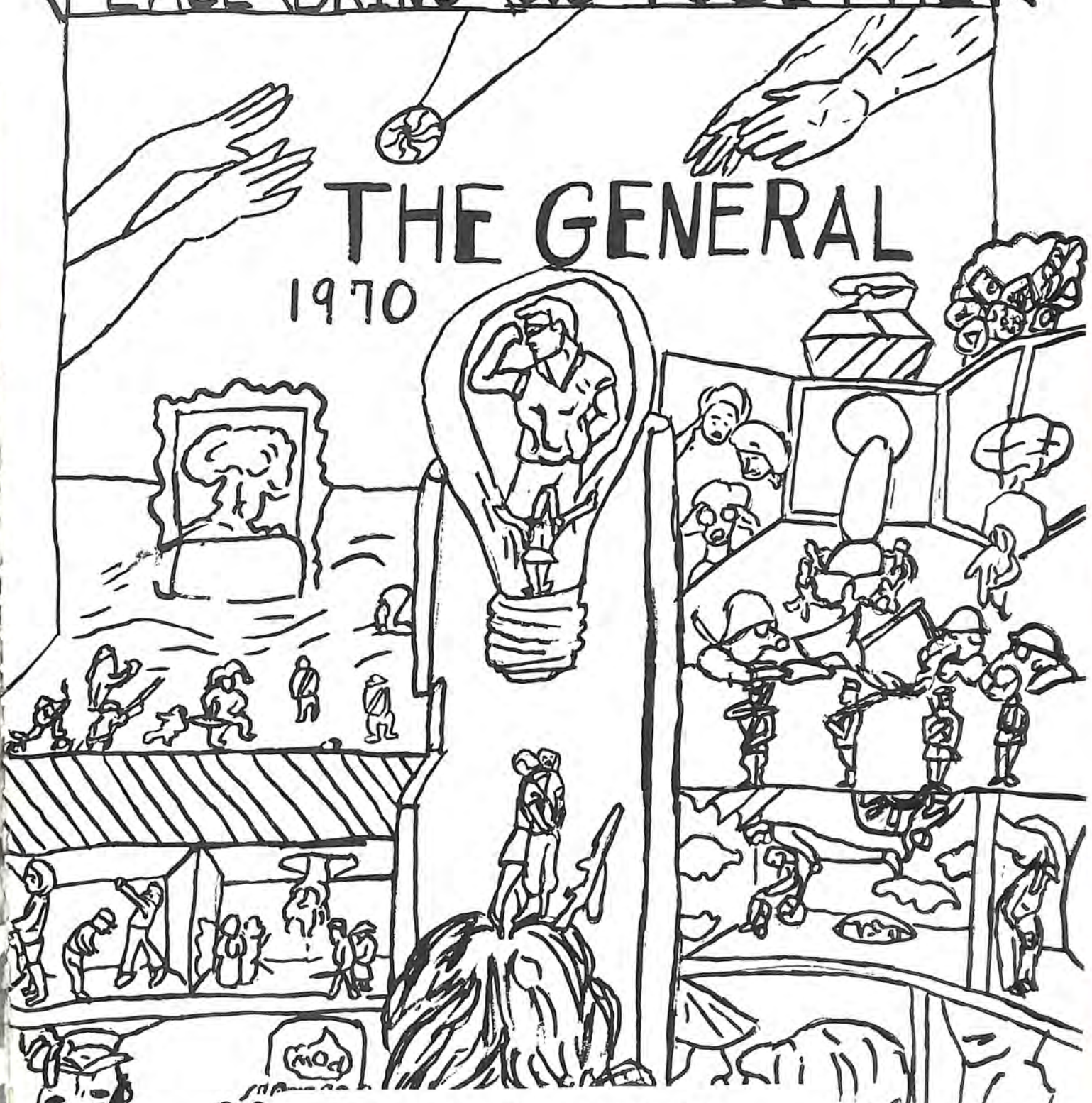

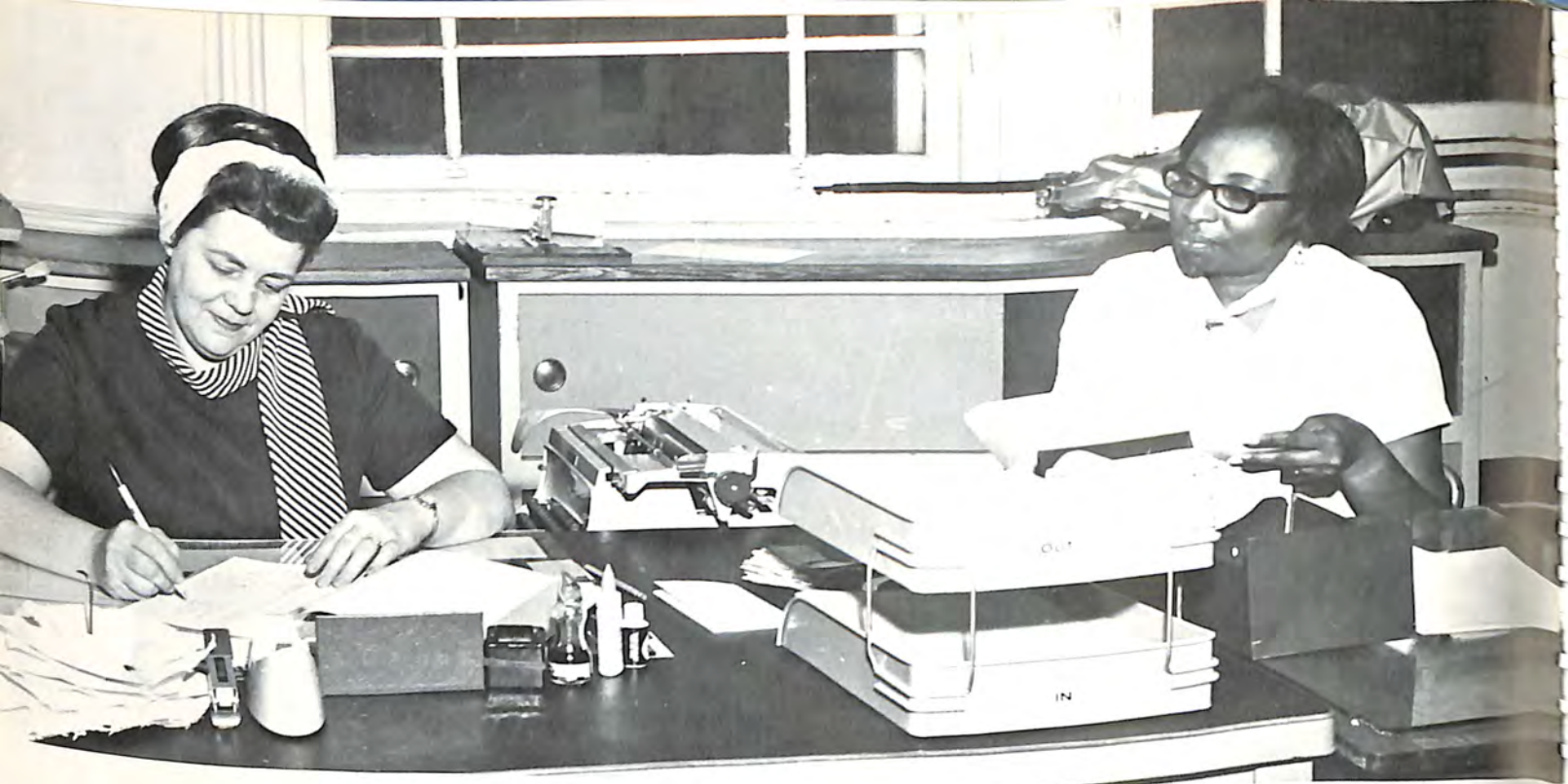
DEDICATION TO OUR PEACE CHILD
