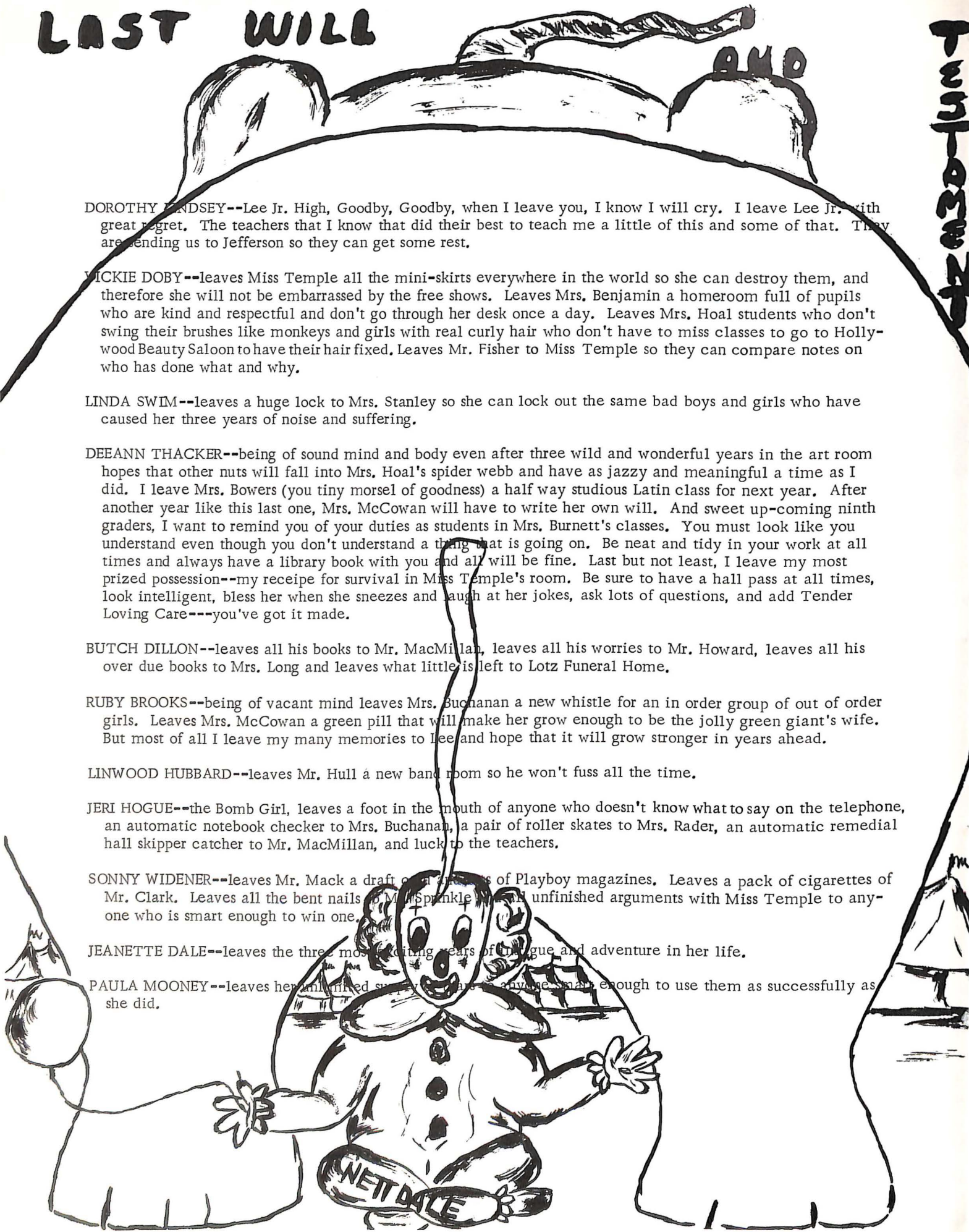
LINWOOD HUBBARD--leaves Mr. Hull a new band room so he won't fuss all the time.

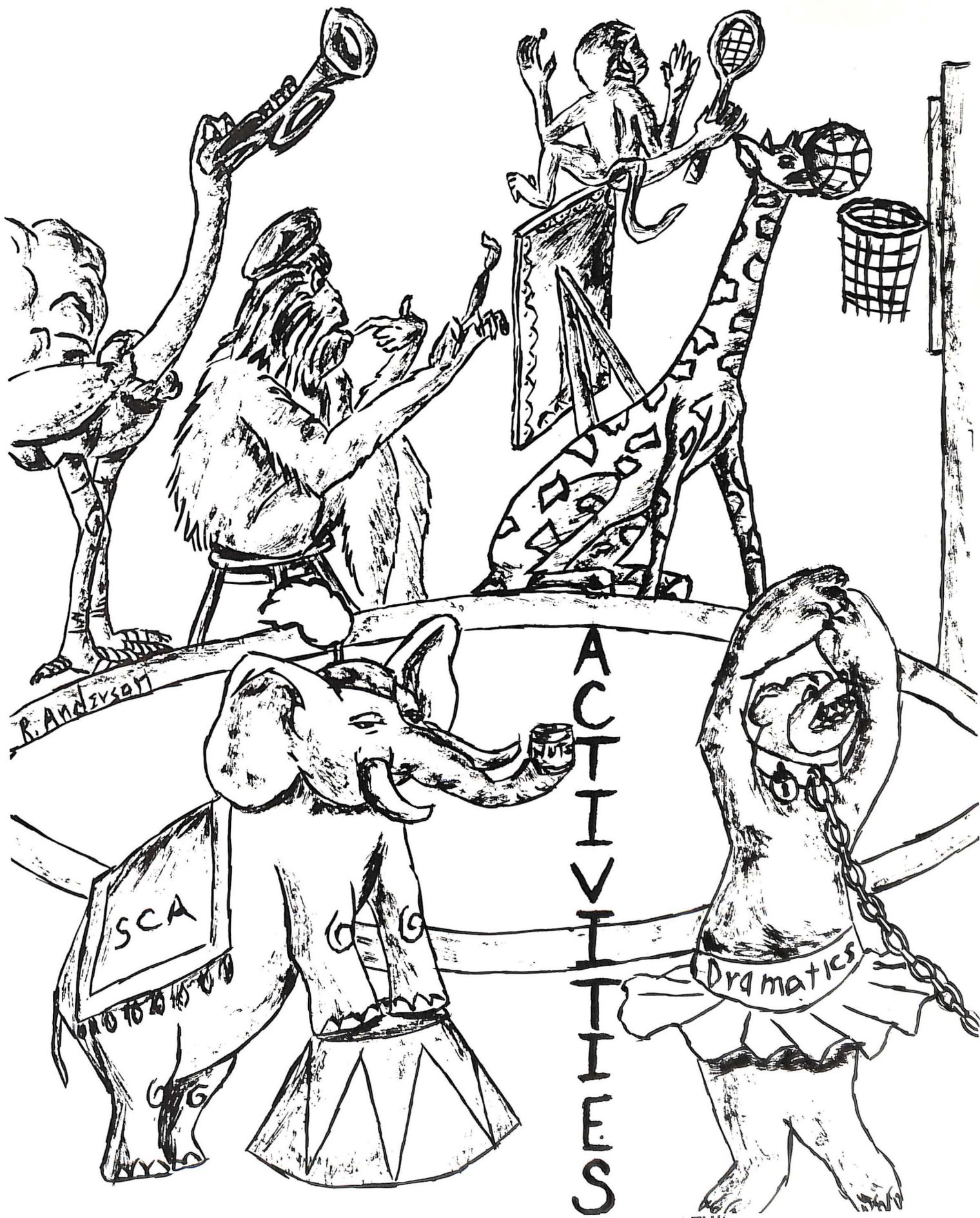
