Edward Franklin, son of Benj. F.-- born-Cub Creek,
Aug. 4, 1777- He married Elizabeth Cook (B. June 1,
1786)- dau. of Rev. Soldier Thos. Cook-Charlotte.

Edw. Franklin D March 3, 1859- she died 1862. They married
on Jany. 9, 1803- very probably at Cub Creek Church.

In Rev. John Rice's Diary or Journal he says-(date of
"On second Sabbath in May, 1809, Cub Cr. Church (he was then
its Pastor) "Baptised children of E. Franklin, D. Adams, and
S. Hannah, and 3 blacks".

E.F. & E. Cook by 1809, probably
had -by May, 1809 at least 2-maybe 3 children. The 3 oldest
children of E.F. & E.C. were:

1- John Franklin- B. Sept. 27, 1804 (md. Martha Jane Anderson)
(My grandfather-& portraits at V.V.)

2- Martha Ann Franklin- B. Dec. 28, 1806 (Md. Daniel DeJarnett)

3- Thomas Franklin- B. Oct. 1, 1808- Md. Judith Early Anderson.

From this- Pretty certainly, Rev. J.H. Rice baptised
John Franklin and Martha Ann Franklin-& possibly- Thos. F.-
Edward & Eliz. Cook Franklin had 10 children- 7 boys &
3 girls. the 6th. child was James Franklin ("Old Uncle
Jim- portrait in V.V. dining room).

Edward F. above was a "Gentleman Justice"-Pitts.
