Biographical Note:

Alexander Broadon Claytor was born 26 March 1910 to Solon L. Claytor and Henrietta B. Johnson Claytor in Copper Hill, Virginia. He completed his early education at schools in Floyd County, Botetourt County and Roanoke City and received degrees from Virginia State University and Tennessee Agricultural & Industrial State College, now Tennessee State University. On 28 April 1942, Claytor married Catherine Christine Williams, daughter of Roanoke, Virginia funeral director C. C. Williams. Claytor owned a 310 acre farm in Rockbridge County, Virginia and worked as an insurance agent and funeral director. In 1993, Claytor donated his his life savings to Washington and Lee University to establish the Christine and Solon Claytor Scholarship Fund in honor of his wife and father. Claytor died 5 March 1995 in Lexington VA.

Scope and Content:

- The A. B. Claytor Collection is comprised of one (1) record storage box.
- This collection is made up of one (1) photo album, which is approximately 11.25 x 7.25"; loose photographs in black and white and color, and color slides; various documents including funeral programs, a marriage certificate, and an invitation; newspaper clippings and other published articles.
- While most of the material in the collection is comprised of family photographs owned by A. B. Claytor, articles relating to Claytor's endowment to Washington and Lee University are included.

- The collection dates from approximately the early 1920s to 1995.
