The **Power Staff** tries to keep students informed of happenings around the school. It is composed of 7th, 8th, and 9th grade students.

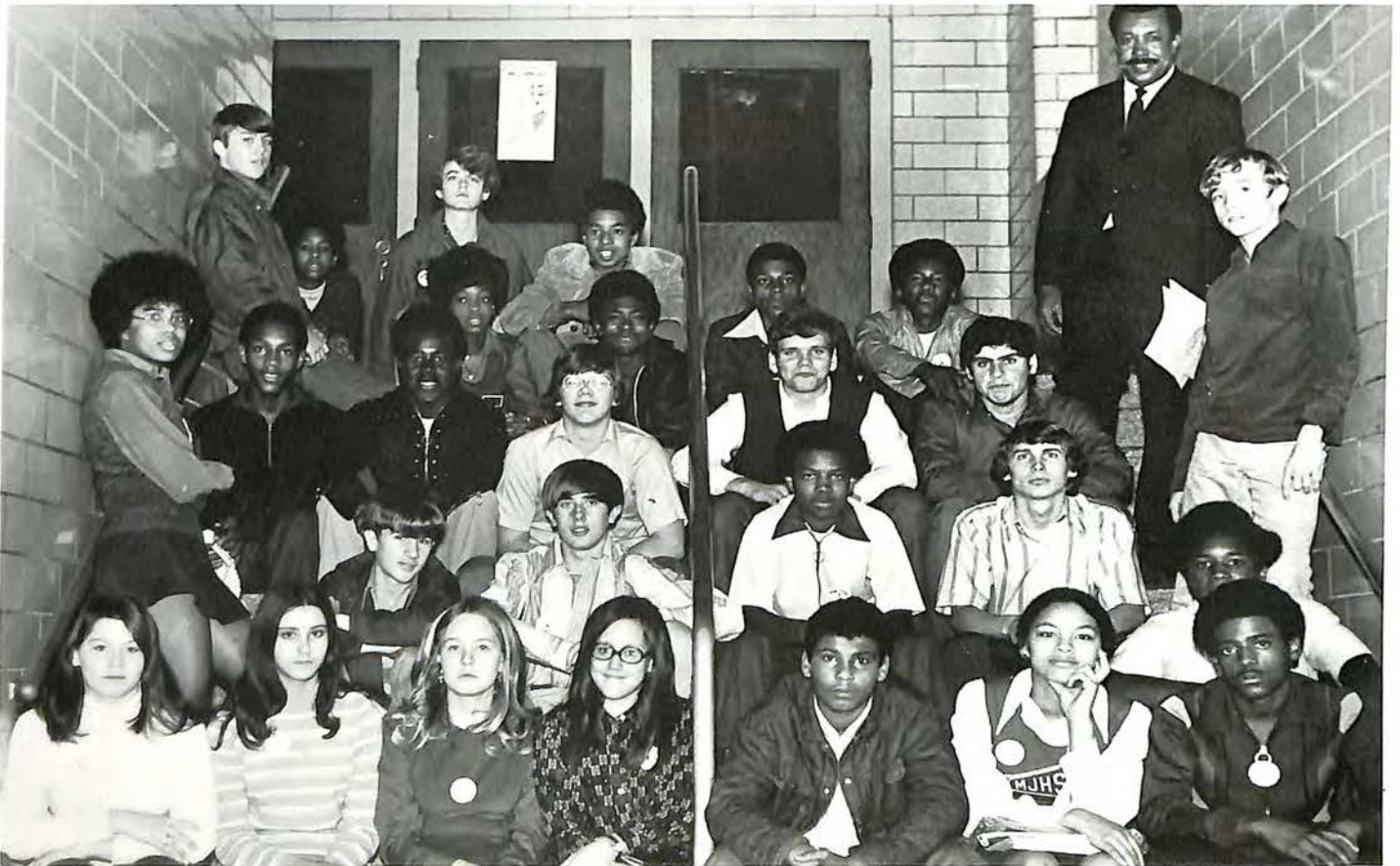


# SCA

## Music Club



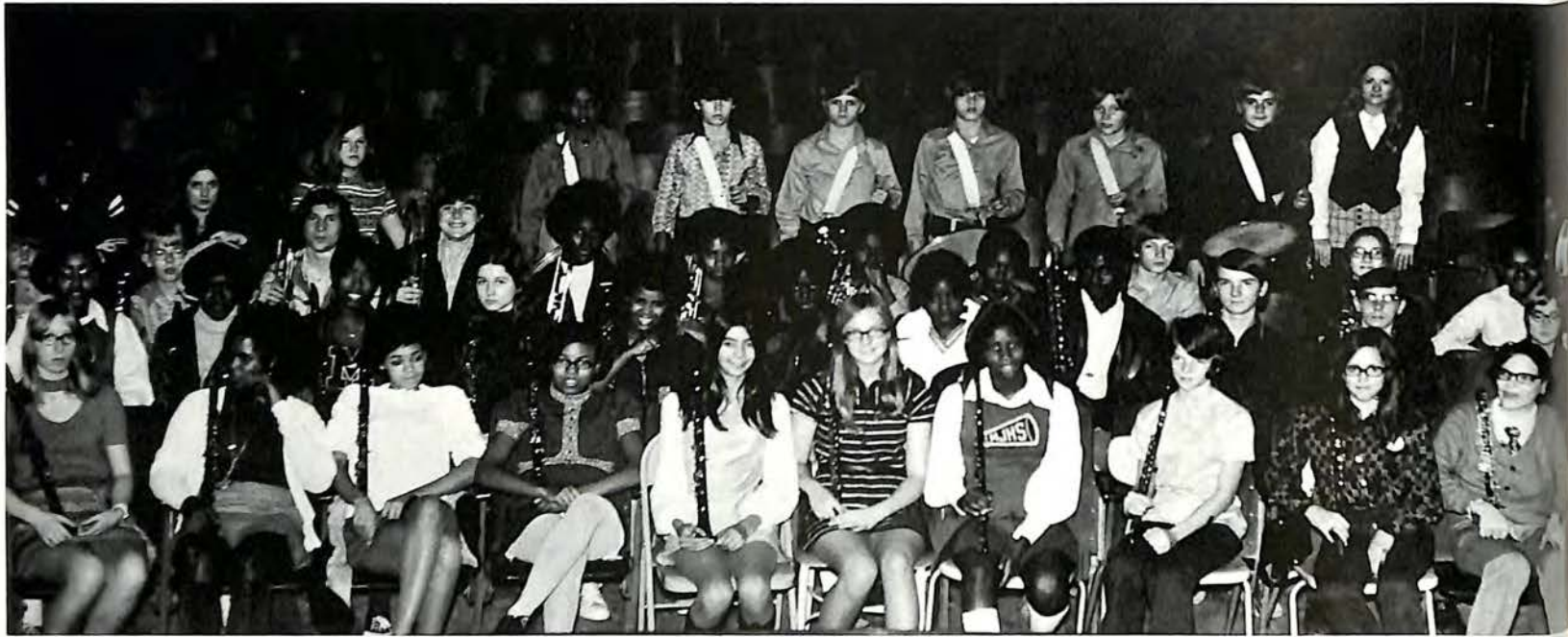
This activity strives to enrich the lives of students through musical experiences.
