## WE'RE 10 YEARS OLD!

William Ruffner Junior High School, constructed in 1970, was named after William Henry Ruffner (1824-1902). Ruffner served as a pastor, chaplain, and geologist. He then became the first superintendent of Virginia's public schools. The names "Saints" and "Ruffner Rock" derived from his last two vocations.
Our school emblem is the fleur-de-lis. Our school colors, forest green and gold, were chosen by Mr. Dennis Cummings before Ruffner opened.


Ruffner in the Beginning

Over the decade, Ruffner has remained one of the Roanoke Valley's top athletic contenders. During Roanoke City competitions in basketball, in football, and in other sports as well, Ruffner has repeatedly won the city championship. In academic achievement, Ruffner had the highest percentage of freshmen among the city Junior High Schools to pass the Virginia competency tests. Ruffner, one of the three feeder schools of Fleming, has been honored by several students who have become valedictorian at Fleming.

Commercial development has taken place near Ruffner. The land around Ruffner, recently agricultural fields, has become parking lots, retail stores, and apartments. Hill's, Best, Food World, 7-Eleven, and a motel now dot the scenery around Ruffner. In the school itself, intra-school telephones, closed circuit televisions, a giant fishbowl, new flag girl and drummer uniforms, a math lab, computer time-share Guidance Information Service, and many other things have been added to modernize Ruffner.
