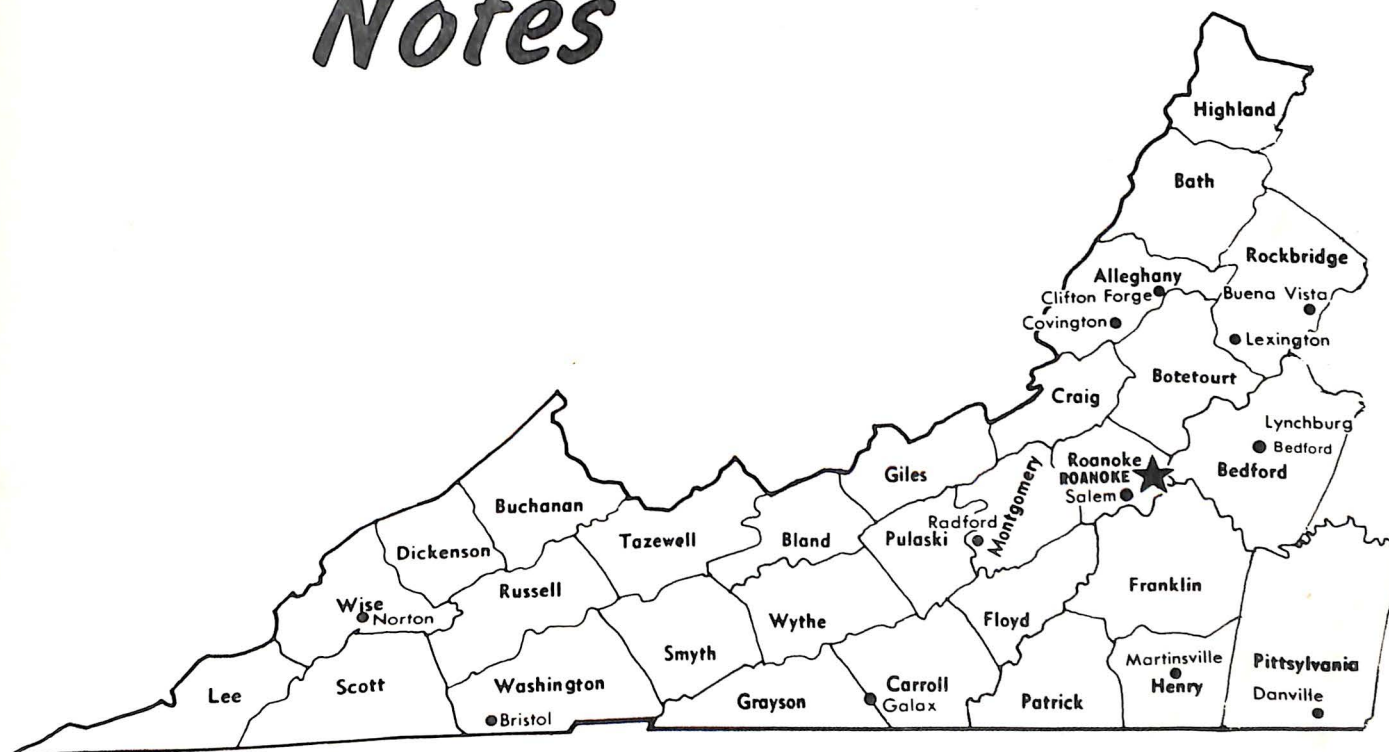

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

I want to welcome all our members for 1978 and ^{hope} that each will find something in the VAN that will be of help. The surname index will be published as planned but may be the last time. The index has over 700 names and that is not complete - all members did not send in names. The SVGS voted that future surname indexes would be limited to 10 names per member. Our membership has grown so fast that to keep up with the surname index is almost too much for one person. Pedigree charts would take care of the surname list and be a much better source for a person checking for surnames. More information is given on a chart and names are easier to place according to time. Remember that a name may not be common in your area but very common in another area. My maiden name, Waskey, is not common but there were 5 William Christopher Waskeys who fought for the CSA in Va. -- my great grandfather and four of his nephews. A little extra research had to be done to put each one in their proper place on the charts. So please send as much information as possible on the person you are seeking data on. Almost forgot -- please designate Mr., Mrs, or Miss -- some names are used for either male or female, some parents placed a name on us that should be male and the person is female ---- Well, my face has been red several times when I ask for Mr. Jones and it should have been Mrs Jones.

PEDIGREE CHARTS

As usually money is holding us back in furnishing pedigree charts for each member to fill out. So if you would fill out a chart and mail it to us we will place it in Vol. II (which is in the Virginia Room of the main Roanoke City Public Library). Vol. I has been indexed. Numbering on a chart: #1 is the person which starts the chart - can be male or female and is the only exception to the rule that all males are even numbers and all females are odd numbers. As you fill in the chart, you will notice that when a number is doubled you have the father (4-8-16 etc) and the 5-9-17 etc will be the wife of the even number (and mother of 2-4-8 etc). On the charts try to include as much information as possible -- it is much easier for someone to identify the person and it may be the one they are working (possible to give you some information). We also accept charts from non-members as well as members. Several people have been able to get help from the charts in the notebooks.

PS: Use only the maiden name of the wife --- never add her married name unless she was a widow, be sure to designate whether 1st or 2nd marriage.

The Marriage Bonds & Minister Returns of Roanoke County, Va, were copied by Marvin U Neighbors in 1965 from the originals in the court house. Also Charles T Burton copied the records there - the differences between the two copies are noted. The Society wants to thank these two for allowing us to publish their material in our quarterly. This material may not be published without permission of the two men. As you will see there are differences and a person should get a copy of the original to be sure which date or name is correct.

Usually the person copying the records for his own use will not spend a great deal of time trying to figure which number or letter is correct and will put down first impression - especially if they can go back to the original if the material is needed for research.

This material has not been checked against the Marriage Register of Roanoke County -- this is a record of the bonds and minister returns in the files of the court house. So there are probably more marriages recorded for the period than we have listed here.

VIRGINIA APPALACHIAN NOTES

THE DARSTS OF VIRGINIA

by

H. Jackson Darst

"When a few weeks old I was carried to the old "Darst place" at Dublin to be shown to my venerable great-grandmother, Margaret (Trolinger) Darst, who in her partial blindness, asked mother 'to hold him closer.' Although I cannot remember great-grandmother, I grew up in an environment in which she played a significant role and where family history was a part of the everyday fabric of life. A sense of continuity with family members long deceased existed; one learned very early the significance of being 'well-born.'"

This is the first paragraph from the preface of THE DARSTS OF VIRGINIA, a chronicle of ten generations in the Old Dominion, with sketches of the Cecil, Charlton, Glendy, Grigsby, Larew, Miller, Trolinger, Welch, Wygal, and Wysor families.

One has to read and examine THE DARSTS OF VIRGINIA to appreciate the research and authenticity behind it. What began with the distribution of mimeographed copies of this "Genealogy" 1943, the research of a high school student, became a 574-page book published by the author in 1972, Williamsburg, Virginia.

The book has fifty illustrations, fourteen chapters on the descendants of the Darst family, ten appendices of allied families, documented notes on each family, a bibliography and index.

The very outstanding bibliography lists as sources: articles, books and pamphlets, church records, family Bibles, newspapers and religious papers, genealogical charts, public documents, scrapbooks, theses, dissertations and research papers, unpublished materials in private collections, and unpublished materials in public collections.

THE DARSTS OF VIRGINIA by H. Jackson Darst has been placed in the Virginia Room of the Roanoke Public Library as a gift from The Southwestern Virginia Genealogical Society, Roanoke, Virginia.

"U.S. POPULATION CENSUS RECORDS AND H.R. 6993. On 6 May 1977, Mr. Philip R. SHARP (Indiana) introduced a bill in the Congress which is aimed at amending title 13 U.S. Code, by requiring population census records to be transferred to the National Archives within 50 years after a census and that such records be made available after 75 years to persons conducting research for genealogical, historical or medical purposes.

At the present time, the bill is in Committee (Post Office and Civil Services) and no action, including hearings, has taken place. Because of the impact of the bill on genealogical research, we should not hesitate to write to our Congressman asking their support for H.F. 6993. Also, our Congressmen should be urged to get the bill moving and out of Committee so that it can be acted upon on the floor of the House of Representatives."
