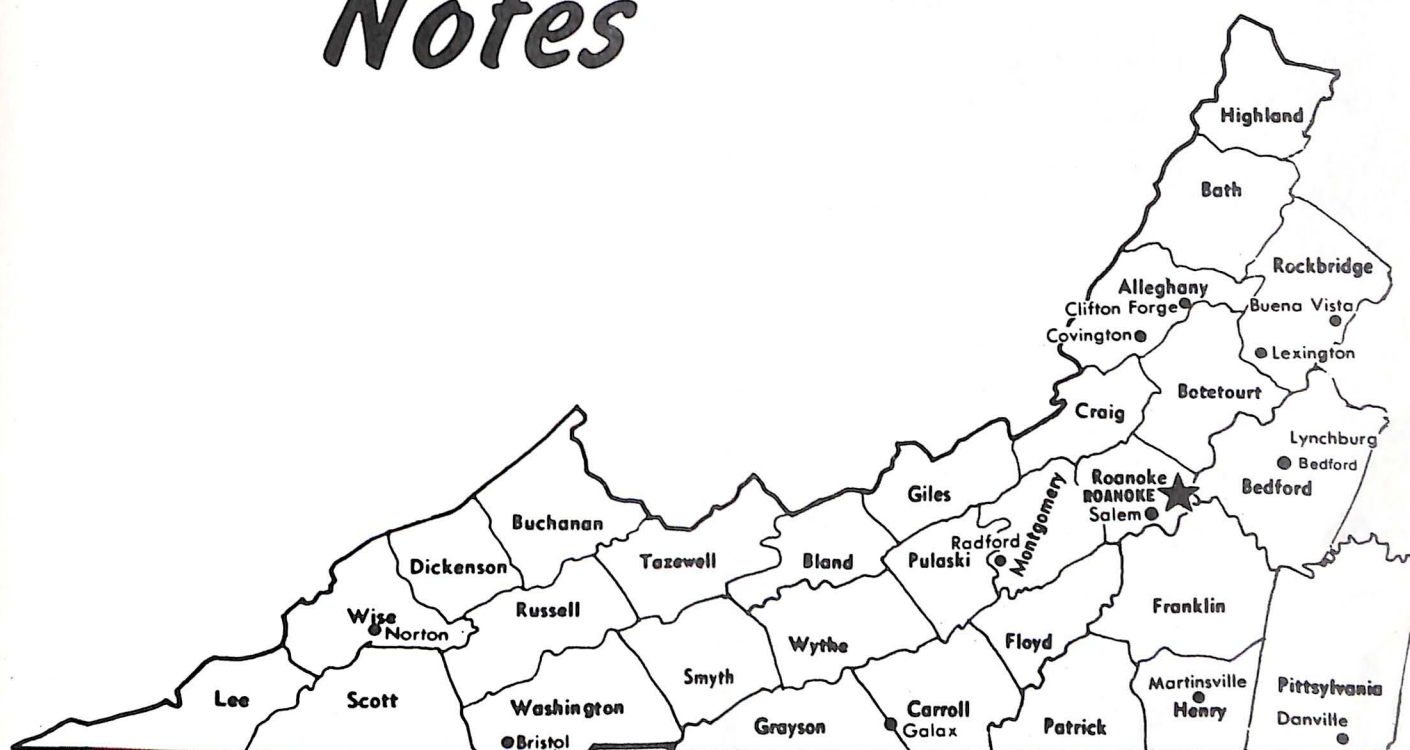

I have thoroughly enjoyed my time as president and thanks again to everyone.

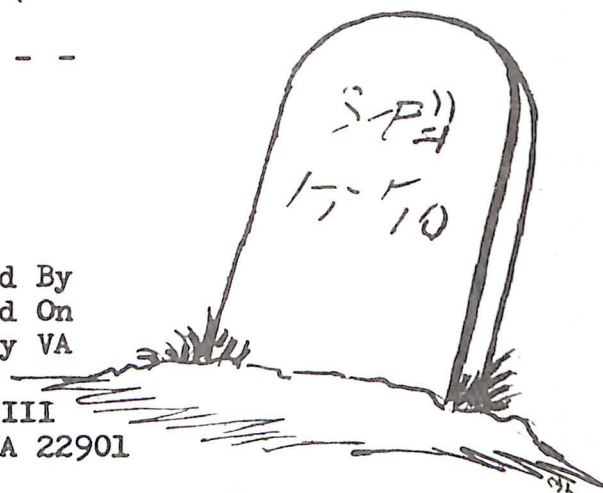

NOTES

1. There are other stones with engraving too weather-worn to read. Chalk or tracing could make these stones readable. Also there are graves with no stones.
2. Another cemetery (Probably Walker) is located over the crest of a hill and about 300-500 yards behind the Lipes cemetery. This cemetery on the edge of the woods has about 13 uncut stones; one roughly engraved "Walker Died 1862". This stone is laying face down to protect the engraving. None of the stones are standing?



SOME FREEDMEN IDENTITIES

Introduction

There has been almost a deafening silence about the Reconstruction period in Montgomery County, Va. This is understandable for the same kind of "stillness" pervaded much of the rest of Virginia, as well as other parts of the "Old Confederacy." After the wrenching and traumatic civil war experience of the "Lost Cause" and the aftermath of military rule, the reaction to Reconstruction was to dismiss it from memory. The one significant exception to this in Montgomery County has been the book by Lula Porterfield Givens, "Highlights in the Early History of Montgomery County, Va." (R.D. Smith & Bros, Pulaski, Va. 1975). Her material was derived, in part, from the MA Thesis by Ann Swain, "Christiansburg Institute: From Freedmen's Bureau Enterprise to Public High School", Radford College: May 16, 1975. Mrs. Swain is currently the President of the New River Historical Society.

Discussions with Ann Swain broadened and deepened concurrent research on Freedmen's Bureau records then underway. Montgomery County was determined to be one of only a few counties to have had two Freedmen's Bureau Censuses taken. One was taken in August 1865 by Major B.C. Carter, and contains 1530 names. The second one was taken in April 1867 and contains 2460 names of Freedmen and their families - including those who were freeborn before the civil war. These numbers, 1530 (1865) and 2460 (1867) may be compared with the slave population of 2,219 (with 147 Free Blacks) in 1860 and the 2882 "Free Colored" in 1870, of Montgomery County.

This article uses the 1865 census as the focus for comparison with the 1867 census. This is done because the 1865 one lists the former owners and the 1867 one does not, (it rather lists the employer or plantation owners where the freedmen lived). The former owner is of greater geneological value because of wills, deeds and other public and private records that may be further traced once the former slaveholder has been identified. The two censuses have been compared and in a number of cases a surname has been identified where none existed in the 1865 census.

Research is continuing and will be expanded in Montgomery County and other counties of Appalachia, as time and money will allow.

O	Octaroon - A person with one White parent, and one parent with one quarter Black or African blood (a quadroon).
Q	Quadroon - A person with one quarter Negro or African blood; theoretically with one grandparent of unmixed African blood.
/	Name/variant of name
X	1866 Marriage Register References; hyphenated names of females contain maiden name/married name.

Editor's Note: This article is part of a Community Development Study by Richard B. Dickenson of Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, Blacksburg, Virginia. Parts II and III will be published in the next two issues of VAN.

Quoting Mr. Dickenson, "It should be emphasized that this is a preliminary sourcebook of Black Appalachian origins, with selected freedmen and former slave owners. They were selected on the basis of matchability between 1865 and 1867 censuses. Also included are excerpts from the 1866 Marriage Register, where applicable. . . . The (completed) article contains approximately 350 freedmen and freedwomen names out of the 1530 in the 1865 census (the 1867 census contains 2420 names); and 51 of the 327 slaveholders in the 1860 Montgomery County, Va. Federal census."

SWITCHES & CINDERS

Told by Mrs Carrie Straton Waskey to her daughter, Mrs Claude S (Babe) Fowler.

The year is about 1892. The place is now Myrtle, W.Va., about 20 miles from Logan. The home is a two-story log house, known as the Col. Floyd's old home. There are two rooms up and two rooms down - each with a huge fireplace. The family: the father, Allen Butcher Straton; the mother, S. Jane Deskins Straton; the two children are Carrie, about 6 years old, and Joe, about 4 years old. The time was about November with Christmas not too far away. Toys, as we know them, were unheard of in that area, and hard candy just as rare. The presents were hand made and usually clothing.

The trip to Logan took the better part of the day and when we went, we spent the night with my grandparents, William and Mary (Peerry) Straton, and return home the next day.

Father made the trip to Logan about a month before Christmas for supplies and purchased some hard candy for Christmas as a special treat for us. Mother hid the candy, but I found it. Each day Joe and I would sneak a piece or two of the candy and one day there was no more candy. It did taste so good!

Christmas Eve, we hung up our knitted yarn stockings (which were made by my grandmother Martha (Bevins) Deskins) by the fireplace and placed our shoes under them. Then off to bed with dreams of what Santa Claus would bring us.

The next morning we ran down the stairs to see what Santa Claus had left for us.

I heard Joe, crying, ask "Did Santa Claus bring you just what he gave me? --- A switch in my stocking and cinders in my shoes." I replied, with tears streaming down my face, "Yes, that's what I got."

(Note: My Mother is now 92 years old and not in the best of health, but several years ago, I recorded the above story on tape. I have heard stories of people getting cinders and switches, but my mother is the first person to say that it happen to her. She does not remember the rest of that Christmas, but that morning is very vivid in her mind.)

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## The Eddy Family of Virginia

The Eddy Family by Nelson R. Eddy, whose notes appeared in the October, 1977 VAN, has now been compiled into a four-volume genealogy, The Eddy Family of Virginia. Volume I of the set is an Introduction and Index to the other volumes, which are made up of bound individual genealogy tables.

The book begins with an excellent description of the Eddy Coat of Arms, whose motto was: "CRUX - MIHI - GRATA - QUIES."... "THE CROSS IS TO ME A WELCOME REST."

There are variants in the early spelling of the name Eddy, as Eddee, Ed, Edwy, etc. In the "Doomsday Book," the name EDDUE occurred in a description of little Abington, Cambridgeshire, and in times of King Edward the First, persons named Edde and Ede or Edwy are made mention as having paid taxes in Worchestershire.

This study is confined to the Eddy family that immigrated from Scotland to Virginia. Some early Virginia county records are Augusta, Bath, Botetourt, Frederick, Montgomery, Rockbridge and Rockingham counties. Sources of information from Virginia, as well as other states, include copies of marriages, personal letters, land deeds, war records, newspaper clippings, gravestone inscriptions, family association reports and photographs.

WILLIAM R. GILLESPIE, b. 4 Jan. 1851, Smyth Co. Va.; m. 25 Nov. 1874 in same county to Margaret Ann Custer, dau. of Henry and Eleanor (Dickey) Custer. Brought family to near Huntsville, Schuyler Co., Illinois 1882/3, where he d. 2 June 1888 and his wife d. 13 April 1892. William R. was son of:

REESE A. GILLESPIE, b. ca 1828 (was age 22 in 1850 census); he m. 29 Nov. 1848 in Wythe Co. Va. to Sarah Hanshew, dau. of Peter Hanshew. Reese A. took family to southern Missouri (county unknown) between 1855 & 1860, where he & wife died in an epidemic. Their 4 sons, Andrew, William R., Jacob and David, then returned to Smyth Co. Va. In 1870 Census of Smyth Co., Jacob age 16 was living in household of A. J. Hubble, and William R. age 18 was living in household of William M. Buchanan. No further record found of son Andrew; family tradition says youngest son David was adopted by some family, name unknown. The son Jacob m. 14 July 1874 to Lucinda Cooley & they died at Ponce City, Okla. Reese A. Gillespie was the son of:

ROBERT GILLESPIE, b. about 1786 in Montgomery (now Smyth) Co. Va; he d. there 15 Dec. 1858. Unable to find his marriage record. Annals of Tazewell says she was a Miss Bates, but a descendant says she may have been Helen or Nancy Hayter. Their known children were: John, James, William H., David and Reese A. Have found descendants of son Wm. H., but need children of sons John, James and David. Robert Gillespie was son of:

JAMES GILLESPIE, b. ca 1761 in old Augusta Co. Va. As early as 1787 he lived on North Fork of Holston River in what is now Smyth Co. Va., adjoining his brother Thomas who m. Margaret Bowen, dau. of Reese Bowen who was killed Battle Kings Mountain 1780. James Gillespie may have married Isabella Gillespie, dau. of Robert Gillespie who wrote will 23 May 1797 in Botetourt Co. Va., but I need proof of this. James Gillespie wrote will 23 Feb. 1833 and died 18 Aug. 1834 in Smyth Co. Va.. Will names his wife Isabel and these children: William, Jane, Robert, Mary, Matthew, Thomas Russell, Elijah, James, Sarah, and Isabel. James Gillespie was probably son of:

WILLIAM GILLESPIE, who had wife Mary. William lived near mouth of Cowpasture River in old Augusta Co. Va., as early as 1746/7. By 1774 he was a tithable with 3 sons in Botetourt Co. Va. He appears to have gone from there to Pendleton Co., S. C. around 1780 with sons John & Wm. Jr., and others. In 1800 Census he was living in household of son William Jr., in Pendleton District of S. C. In 1797 Wm. Sr. deeded 354 acres of land on waters of George's Creek of Saluda River to James and Thomas Gillespie of Wythe and Russell counties, Va. (Pendleton District, S. C. Deeds.) Then in 1799 James and Thomas Gillespie of Wythe and Russell Counties, Va., sold 245 acres on Bowen's Creek of George's Creek of Saluda River in Pendleton District, S. C. to Thomas Boyd. (Note- Would like to hear from anyone descending from this family of having knowledge of them. I'm anxious to fill in the missing names of wives, etc. Mrs. Wilfred L. Bowles, R#1, Bowen, Ill.)
