

MY DEAR EMMA

(War Letters of Colonel James K. Edmondson 1861-1865)

"My Dear Emma is a volume of life and war letters to his wife of Colonel James K. Edmondson, an outstanding figure of Lexington, whose life spanned across the 19th century. Everything he did well, even the letters were models of penmanship and a delight to read. His concern for his family and his good works of the area bespeak of a noble and able person." PREFACE

James K. Edmondson was born February 11, 1832 at "Savernake" farm two miles southwest of Buena Vista. His parents were James and Margaret Edmondson. In 1857, he married Miss Emily (Emma) Jane Taylor of Staunton, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James Taylor. Emma's sister, Laura, married Albert Marshall Moore and died very young, leaving two little girls, Mary, age 5, and Frances, age 3. James and Emma Edmondson had no children of their own and raised the two girls. Frances married Paul M. Penick; and Mary married Edward Robinson. One grandniece, Miss Mary M. Penick, gave the 139 letters to the Rockbridge Historical Society in 1956, and the other Penick sister, Mrs. Frederick Pearse, supplied illustrations for the text of this book.

Edmondson's letters, beginning April 19, 1861, were regular and detailed of the happenings of the Confederate Army. The last war letter was May 4, 1863 written to Emma by L. C. Vass, Chaplain 27th Virginia Infantry, informing her of her husband's loss of his left arm in the battle of Chancellorsville. This would necessitate his retiring from active service and returning to Lexington where he would do his part for the war effort from there. When he returned to Lexington in the summer of 1863, he was made commander of the Military Post at Lexington. James K. Edmondson was surely one of the outstanding Lexingtonians of his day. He had been a soldier, politician, judge, business man and loyal servant of his alma mater, Washington and Lee University. He passed away March, 1898, and his funeral was held at the Lexington Presbyterian Church where he had been a deacon for many years. The Pastor, Dr. Thornton Whaling, conducted the service, and his remains were placed in the Stonewall Jackson Cemetery, as reported in the Lexington Gazette, April 6, 1898.

The book has 151 pages, hard cover, index, footnotes and illustrations. A gift copy from the author to the Southwestern Virginia Genealogical Society has been placed in the Virginia Room of the Roanoke City Public Library. A copy may be ordered from Professor Charles W. Turner, Washington and Lee University, Lexington, Virginia 24450. The price is \$8.00.

Material for publication:

- 1. Please type, if possible, on 8½x11" paper, single space, with minimum margins of 1" on all sides and headings patterned on those in this issue. PLEASE use a dark ribbon and CLEAN keys, mail in large manila envelope if ready to publish. If handwritten, please write plainly or print. If you feel you cannot type well, please type the material with double space. Please read the material over before sending it and check all dates.
- Give source of material. Original documents where found, type, number of page, etc. We cannot print material from printed source unless we have permission from the author.
- 3. Deadline for submitting material is the first of the month previous to the month of publication.
- 4. Material contributed will not be returned unless accompanied by a stamped self-addressed envelope.
- 5. We welcome all family histories (may have to be edited due to space) copies of court records, Bible records, etc. That little bit of information may be of help to someone. Of course, we cannot promise next issue publication.
- 6. On family histories, our policy is to print prior 1900 -- much as we would like to carry forward the modern day generations it uses too much space.

NOTE: We cannot vouch for the accuracy of the material submitted to us or that the "translation" of the original document is true. If you have read such material, you can understand.

QUERIES:

- 1. Unless queries are to be used as fillers, submit one at a time. Since this is a quarterly, queries not used when originally submitted may become dated and of no value to the writer.
