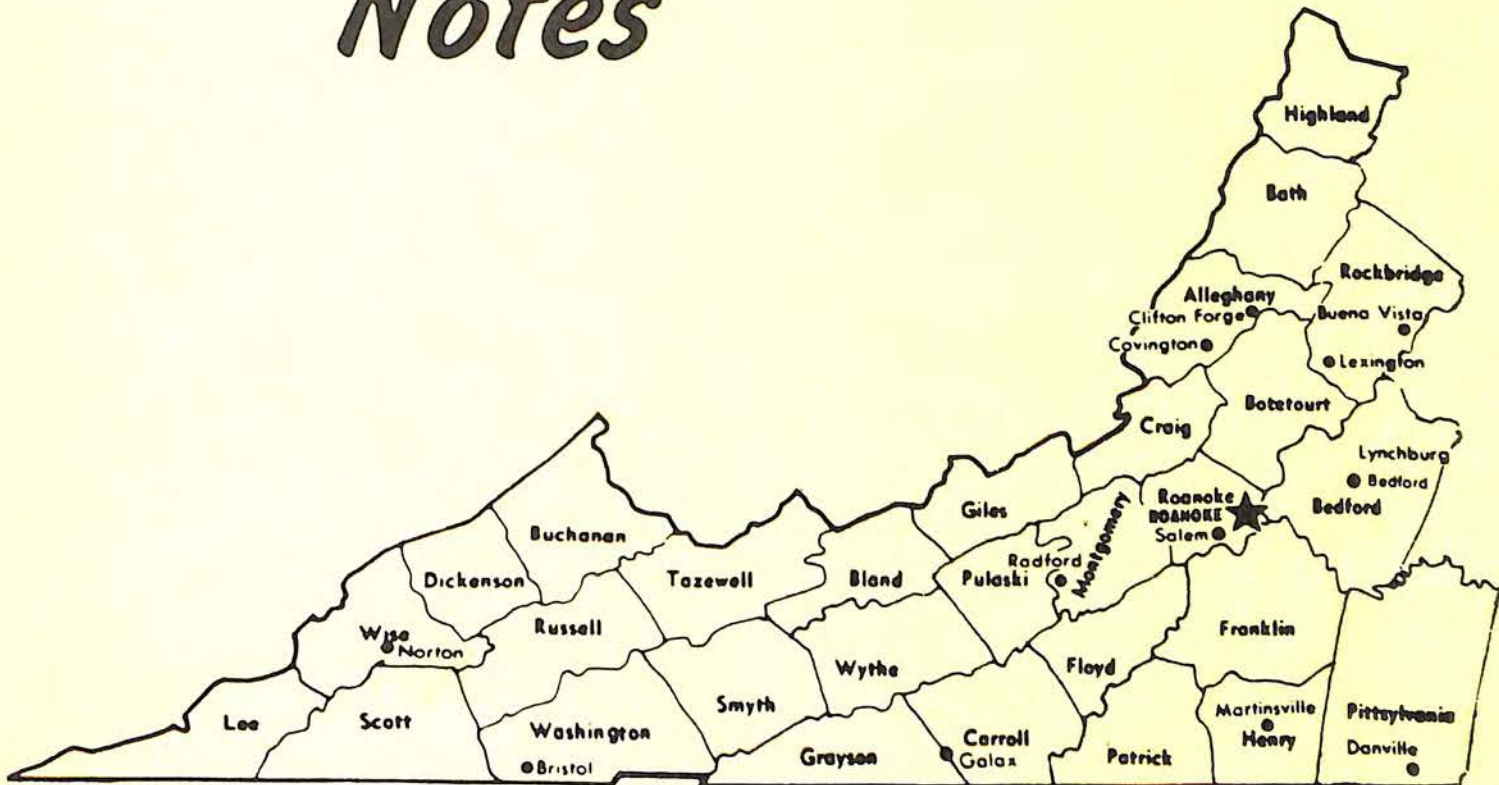



PARROTT OBITUARIES

(Note: These were found in a scrapbook - no indication of newspaper or date of publication.)

AN OLD CITIZEN GONE -- Lipscomb Parrott, an aged and respected citizen died at his home near White Shoals at 3 o'clock on the morning of August 9th, 1883. Some time ago while walking about the house he fell and received an injury and while confined to bed by reason of this, he was attacked by diabetis, which disease resulted in his death. Mr. Parrott was a man of wonderful vitality; at the age of ninety years and upwards he was accustomed to ride over his farm and see to his affairs, and this he continued even after he became unable to mount a horse without assistance. At his death he was in his 94th year--probably the oldest citizen in our county. He was a man of the greatest energy and untiring industry, by reason of which he had amassed a considerable fortune, consisting of a large landed estate and a great amount of personal property. He was a man of the sternest integrity, of unflinching devotion to principle, and at the same time of the warmest and most generous impulses. In all he was a noble citizen, liked and respected by all who knew him, and his memory will long be cherished. He leaves two sons. His aged wife preceded him to that undiscovered country only a few months ago.

ELIZABETH PARROTT

wife of Lipscom Parrott and daughter of Wm and Martha Vermillion, was born in Russell co., Va. Her parents moved to Lee co., Va., where they both died, leaving sister Parrott in charge of her brothers and sisters. Though young herself, she brought them up as a mother. She professed faith in Christ at the age of 14, near Jonesville, during camp-meeting, joined the M. E. Church, South, in which she lived a consistent life until death. Was married the year 1843, became mother of four children. Two of them preceded her to the future home, two sons and her aged husband are left to follow. Her redeemed and cleansed heart seemed to be the gateway of charity, the poor never came to her and were turned off naked and hungry. As the end drew nigh and the shadows fell long amid frailties and much sufferings, she often rejoiced in hopes and expressed an ardent desire to quit life here and enter it anew in heaven. This desire was granted May 17th, 1883, at which time Death finish his dread work and let the ransomed spirit go to grasp the God we seek.

BOOK REVIEWS

THE EVOLUTION OF THE SOUTHERN BACKCOUNTRY - A CASE STUDY OF LUNENBURG COUNTY, VIRGINIA 1746-1832 by Richard R. Beeman. Richard Beeman, a professor of history at the University of Pennsylvania, and director of the Philadelphia Center for Early American Studies, chose Lunenburg County to reconstruct a protrait of everyday life in the Southern Colonies. In determining the best Virginia County to study he found that Lunenburg County seemed to have the best combination of local records, including court records, deed books, wills and inventories, tithable and tax lists, Anglican parish Vestry books, and assorted denominational records.

Lunenburg is the Anglicised format of Lunenburg, which was one of the titles of George I, as Duke of Brunswick-Lunenburg and was formed from Brunswick County in 1746 and later acquired a part of Charlotte County.

The settlers who came to shape Lunenburg's social order encouraged a different type of economic development. They were diverse in economic position, ethnic and religious background and often in social aspirations. Part of the land was acquired by patent but more often was bought, labor was provided by black slaves and also white servants.

The rise of enthusiastic, evangelical religion was a movement of profound social as well as theological significance in the history of 18th Century Virginia and was a challenge to the Anglican gentry culture. Early ministers who led in the religious culture of Lunenburg were James Craig, Anglican; Separate Baptists, John Williams and Elijah Baker; Presbyterian, John Thompson and Robert Henry; Methodist, William Hill. Certain family names as Chambers, Billups, Stokes and Taylor appeared in positions of leadership in the economic, political and religious life of the county in earlier years.

Lunenburg County made a remarkable contribution to the War effort during the American Revolution. The Lunenburgers were closely unified by 1861 when the cultural and political beliefs were defined as "Southern". This provided the mechanism by which the white citizens of Lunenburg, plain folk and gentry, cavaliers and frontiersman, Episcopalians, and Baptists were bound together.

The book is well documented with tables, maps, an appendix of court records, footnotes and well indexed. Kenneth Gehner of Princeton, NJ, answered one of Calvin Weddle's queries in WESTERN MARYLAND GENEALOGY and sent him the following: Bedford Co., PA Orphans Court, 20th November 1797, Vol. 2, pages 32 and 33:-- "The Petition of Conrod Oyler fourth Son of Jacob Oyler late of Bedford Township and County Yeoman Dec^d was read to the Court Setting forth 'That the said Jacob Oyler lately died Intestate at Bedford Township and County aforesaid leaving lawful Issue to survive him viz, Frederick Oyler eldest Son Jacob Oyler, Felty Oyler, Conrod Oyler (the said Petitioner) Mary intermarried with Benjamin Waddle, Jonas Oyler, Peter Oyler Laurence Oyler, John Oyler, Catharine intermarried with John Link Margret intermarried with George Coffman Barbara intermarried with George Herbaugh Motelena intermarried with Garas Wolf: - that the said Intestate at the time of his death was Owner and Possessed of a certain Tract of land situate in Bedford Township aforesaid Containing by estimation Two Hundred and twenty two and three quarter Acres and the usual Allowance adjoining lands of John Dibert and the Heirs of Matthias Walters"

Waddle is an early spelling of Weddle and Oyler is another spelling of Eiler.

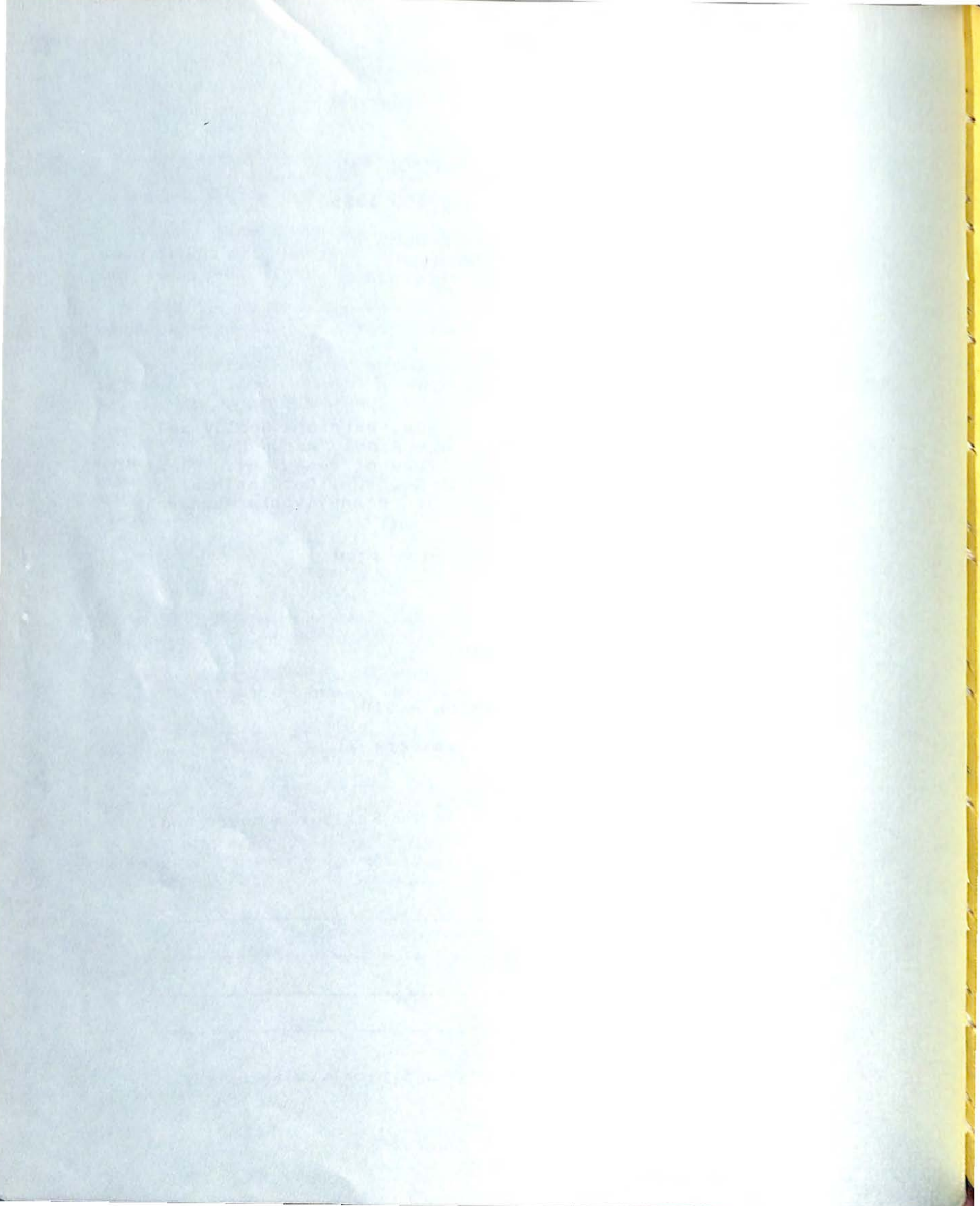
