

H. W. Scott President The following petition is from Box B: 1798 - 1814, Wythe County. The original is found in the Virginia State Archives, Richmond, Virginia. A zerox copy has been placed in the Virginia Room, Central Roanoke City Library, Roanoke, Virginia.

"To the honourable the General Assemble of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

"The Petition of the subscribers who are inhabitants of Washington,
Wythe, Tazewell, Russell and Lee Counties Humbly Sheweth.

"That a North branch of the main Holstein River has its source and almost

the whole extent of its Stream within the limits of Virginia.

"That the said North Fork might be made Navigable for Boats from Jeffry Heldritosses*(or Heldritopes) Mill to its junction with the main River a small distance below the Long Island. (*or Holdritch's)

"That the said River has been descended with <u>Boats</u> of <u>burthen</u> from near the Saltworks to David <u>Pegin</u> Milldam -- the greatest obstruction to the Nav<u>igation</u> that your Petitioners voice complains of is a grievance

"That it would facititate convenance, encourage (agri)culture and be of advantage to the Citizens of Virginia was the said River cleared and declar-

ed a Public Highway.

"Therefore the Prayer of your Petitioners is that your honourable body would take the premises into serious consideration so that measures may be pursued to"

"afford us the Releif that we Naturally expect Gentlemen from the result of your deliberations.

"And your Petitioners as in duty bound shall Pray."

BATH COUNTY, VIRGINIA 1850 MORTALITY SCHEDULE

When the census taker took the emuneration of the family, he also asked for the name of anybody who died during the year ending 1 June 1850. This information was not included in the census filmed by the U.S. National Archives but may be found on microfilm at the Virginia State Archives, Richmond, Va. The following is a selected list of people from the record.

This day came the parties by their attornies, and there upon came also a Jury, to Wit, John Clayton, John Hopkins Otey Stephen White, Robert Cowan, Samuel Hancock, Philip Brown, John Beard, Joseph Poindexter, Thomas Nance, William Holt, Thomas Haynes & Francis Dickerson; who being Elected tried & Sworn the truth to Speak upon the Issue Joined upon their Oath do Say that the Plaintiff is a Free Woman & not a Slave as by replying She hath alledged, And they _s asseess the Plaintiffs Damages by the Occasion in the Declaration mentioned to forty Shillings & 1 Penny tender her Costs Therefore It is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the Defendant her Damages afores'd in form afores'd assessed & her Costs by her about her Suit in this behalf expended & the Said Defendant may be taken &c.

Be it known to all men, that I, Jeremiah Ferguson of the County of Franklin and State of Virginia, do hereby make this my last Will & Testament in manner and form as follows, to Wit: First, I dsire all my just Debts and Burial expenses to be paid, and, to accomplish that, I desire that immediately after my death as soon as through expedient that my Executors shall sell my man Gabriel, also all my perishable property of every description, stock Household & Mitchen furniture Tools, and all other articles belonging to me on a Twelve months credit or otherwise as may be through best by my Executors.

2nd, I give and bequesth to Sarah Scott all that Track of Land known by the name of Fores Cabbin and whar Sanford Scott now lives on to him the said Sarah Scott and his heirs forever. 3rd, I give and bequeath to Jeremiah Thornton a Track of Land known by the name of Coalhill about two Hundred Acres it being the Land I got of Milliam Ferguson, Deceased. Estate adjoining John T. Waid and others to him the said Jeremiah Thornton and his heirs forever. 4th I Give and Bequeath to Rachet Akers a part of my Land known by the name of the Pole Bridge Land on Storey Creek Beginning whar my line crosses the road near Clarks School House thence a Jorth East corse the senter and Top of the Ridge to the mouthof the Branch below wher Stephen Mullins now lives wher the aforesaid branch fall in to Story Creek, and thence due East to James Youngs line and with it to Peter Saunders ye lines to Sammuel Hairstons line and with my line to the beginning. To him the said Machet Akers and his heirs forever. 5th I give and bequesth to Wiley Thornton a part of the pole bridge Track of Land Beginning on the Branch wher my line crosses the branch below 'Hilliam Grammers and won the branch as it meaners to Story Creek and the same covars to the line I bequesthed to Rachet Akers and with it to wher it intersexted (illegible) with James Youngs line and along my line to Hugh Oneals line and with it to Isbol Cooks line and with it to William Brommers line and with it to the Beginning. To him the said Wiley Thornton and his heirs forever. 6th I give and bequest to Francis Thornton the balance of the Pole Bridge land bound by the line I bequesthed to Rachet Akers and Wiley Thornton adjoining 'Hilliam Luke known by the name of Sulfer Springs on Story Creek. To said Francis Thornton and his heirs forever. 7th I give and bequeath to Marget Thornton and Charles Thornton to be equally divided between them when they both arive age of Twenty One years old all my track of Land I now live on, it being the land I bought of Andrew Ruls heirs. To them and their heirs forever. 8th, I give and bequeath to Samuel Thornton a Track of Land lying in the County of Floyd on Little River it being the Land I bought of Mark Seuls heirs. To him the said Samuel Thornton and his heirs forever. 9th I give and bequeath the surplus if any of the proceeds of the part of property I directed sold to pay debts and defray expences. To Mary Thornton to dispose of at her pleashure. 10th I constitute and appoint Stephen Akers and Sanford Scott my Executors agreeable to the directions of my Hill to act as such with out any security for their performance only ther oath. Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my Will. In witneys hear of I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 10th day of April 1834.

Polly Goodwin, Eliza Horn, Littleberry Hardiman Deaton, Sarah Temple, Francis Asberry Deaton and John W Day. Also I leave My family Bible to my son Francis Asberry Deaton.
- I, John Deaton, having, since the foregoing Will was executed, married Luvina Eller, between whom and myself there is a marriage Setlement on record in the Clerk's Office of Roanoke County Court, and it being provided in said Settlement that the said Luvina is to have no portion Of my Estate, except Such as I may direct by Will or otherwise And now wishing to bequeath to the said Luvina, my present wife, the Sum of Two Hundred Dollars, Also one cow, which she may make choice of, and that she have her support for the next ensuing twelve months after my decease. and do direct in my Will, before making distribution Of my Estate amongst my six Children, do pay to my said wife Luvina Deaton the Sum of Two Hundred dollars, but that Legacey to be void If I should survive her ----
- 4th I do hereby make and Ordain John W Day and Francis Asberry Deaton, Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I, John Deaton the Testator have to this my Will written on sheet of paper, Set my hand and Seal this fourteenth day of February in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty three.

BACKSIGHTS
ILLUMINATING A DARK CORNER: ROBERT ROSE, ROAD BUILDER

The multitalented Reverend Robert Rose, through those entries in his mid-eighteenth century <u>Diary</u> dealing with road building in the Tye River area of Albemarle (now Nelson) County, has helped to throw a little light on early road building in Virginia. Very few written records were kept by those who practiced it.

One who practiced road building and who did write about it, sketchily, was the Reverend Rosert Rose. The conventional view of early roads was that of primitive trails and paths, particularly in the West. Even in the earliest stages of settlement in large areas of Virginia in the eighteenth century, this period of trail-blazing was brief.

Throughout the seventeenth century, "path" was the term used to denote the routes traveled by both the Indians and the white settlers to describe Virginia lines of travel not worthy of the name "road."

"Consulting the Oxford English Dictionary, we find that the word trail is derived from a 'trail,' that which is left by the passage of a thing or person over a surface. Therefore, a trail should be defined as the most elemental form of a path, a followable route. The path is a footway, 'especially one beaten by feet,' permitting the passage of a person or a horseman, but not a wheeled vehicle. Paths suitable for travel on horseback were often designated as 'bridle paths' in Virginia road orders."

Finally, the dictionary defined "road" as a suitable way for the passage of wheeled vehicles. A road then would include bridges over larger streams, and possibly some grading. It would seem that the paths of the Indians became the paths and the roads of the white men as settlement moved into the Piedmont in the years after 1700.

Road signs appeared at intersections directing travelers to "the most noted places" by 1738. Mileage markers were erected by 1737 or earlier, as noted by William Byrd II, who mentioned having seen 13 miles of the road from Germanna to Fredericksburg similarly marked.

Rose, located in the Piedmont up-country in the shadow of the Blue Ridge, was involved in the construction of several roads and bridges. As noted in his diary dated January 30 - February 3, he was for five days engaged in road building and bridge operations.

"January 30 - Cloudy, went with Mr. Harvie and my people on the Buffalow Road, moved a heap of stones.....

"February 1 - Finished the Bridge over the Spring Branch, cut down the Bank at Buffalow, levelled part of ye Hill by Naked Creek & got Home at Night,

these 3 days has cost Me 36 Men's labour, to do my Neighbours a pleasure before I have got Necessarys for myself...

"February 3 - ...finished the road two Miles from one Rolling Road to the other, very Cold, got home about 3 pm."

Robert Rose owned plantations in Essex and Orange Counties. He owned many slaves and white indentured servants. On his home plantation, he owned 39 slaves at the time of his death in 1751. When two or three planters of the stature of Robert Rose, Peter Jefferson, and Joshua Fry were assigned a road to clear or open, constructing or opening a road would have been neither difficult nor unusual, as they could easily have had access to 100 men or more at a time for employment.

From Rose's <u>Diary</u> we learn how roads and bridges of what has been called Virginia's Golden Age were laid out and constructed by such eighteenth century gentlemen as Robert Rose.




