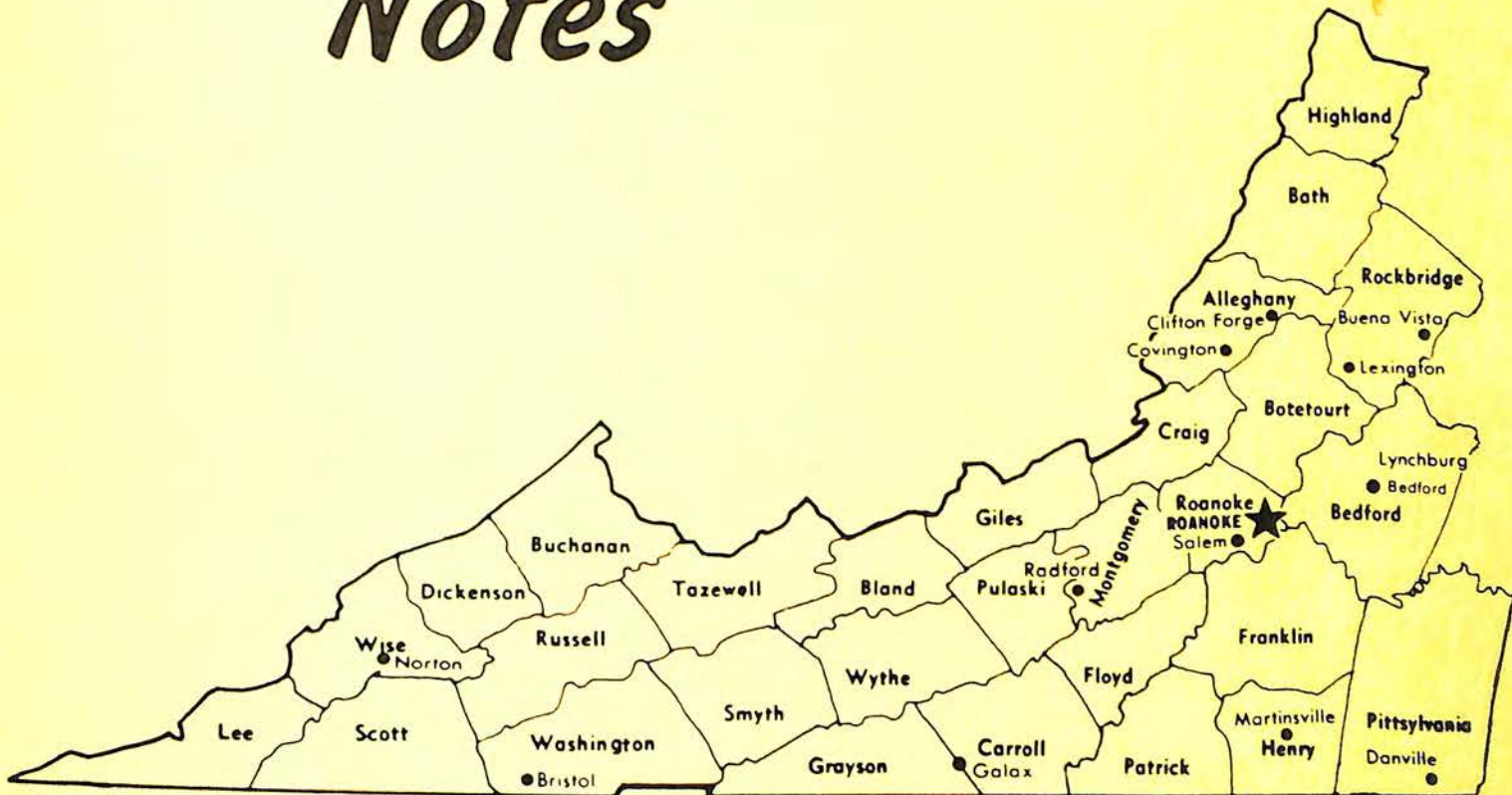

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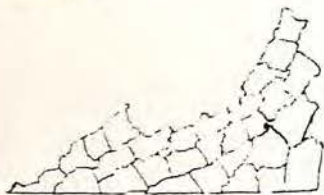

Dear Fellow Genealogists:

As the weather changes and the autumn leaves fall, we tend to reflect on the activities of the year. The Southwestern Virginia Genealogical Society has been busy this year providing activities and services for those who have interest in research in the southwestern section of Virginia.

Among our special projects this year, we provided two excellent workshops - one in the spring on tracing German ancestry and recently one on tracing Maryland roots.

Mary Meyer, a nationally known genealogist and authority on Maryland genealogy, presented an excellent workshop at the Hotel Roanoke on Saturday, October 10. Mrs. Meyer's first presentation on the settlement of Maryland gave valuable insight into immigration patterns and clusters of settlement in Maryland. She then talked about the various research centers in Maryland and how best to use their resources. Mrs. Meyer's third lecture was on migration patterns. She talked about traditional migration patterns in Maryland, Pennsylvania and Virginia as well as noting many exceptions to these patterns. Throughout her presentations, Mrs. Meyer talked about her bibliography and referenced a number of valuable sources. Although attendance was not as large as in our past workshops, the participants were enthusiastic about the activities of the day.

The executive board would like to have suggestions from the membership concerning what we might plan in the future in workshops, tours and programs. Your suggestions will help us as we try to provide interesting and informative activities.

"Where as it has pleased Divine Providence in the Consumation of will & inscrutable purposes, to remove from his sphere of earthly action, one of the oldest, most useful and respected members of this Court; and whereas this Court and Bar, who have so long and favourable known the moral and practical worth of the deceased, not only as a member of the Court, but in all the private relations of life, - are desirous of testifying to the County and his afflicted friends their high sense of that worth, and the public loss occasioned by his death; therefore,

Resolved 1st:

That, in the death of Moses Greer, Sr. this court and Bar have lost one of their purest, most useful and agreeable members; the County one of their best, most respected and beloved citizens:- one whose loss, both in a public and private point of view, will not easily or soon be supplied.

Resolved 2nd:

That, in testimony of our esteem and respect for the many virtues of the deceased, and in tender consideration of his bereaved family, Robt A. Scott, Deputy Clerk to this Court, be, and is hereby required to transmit to Mrs Greer, widow of the deceased, a copy of these resolutions, with assurances of our cordial sympathy in her afflictions; also to each of the news-papers published in the town of Lynchburg, accompanied with a request on the part of this Court & Bar for their publication

Resolved 3rd:

That, in farther testimony of our regard for the memory of the deceased, the Clerk of this Court be, and is hereby ordered to spread these resolutions on the record of the Court.

THE BORDEN and BEVERLEY PATENTS of
ORANGE and AUGUSTA COUNTIES, VA.

A number of years ago the Southern California Genealogical Society advised the members that two very interesting maps could be obtained for \$1.00 each by writing to a Mr. J. R. Hildebrand (whose address is now unknown) regarding the BEVERLEY PATENT, a map drawn and compiled by him in 1954 and a "Map showing 92,100 acre grant for BENJAMIN BORDEN lying and being on the West side of the Blue Ridge in the County of Augusta" which he presumably also drew but did not so state nor is his name shown anyplace.

After having had these maps for many years we think this might be a good time to try and break down the information shown on both of them so that they may be of a little more value to the researcher than, what is now, a jumble of names and lines on two large sheets of paper. We will deal with these Patents as two separate entities, but it should be kept in mind that both covered immense areas of land, which today would be in several counties.

The real purpose of this article is to list in alphabetical order the various names, dates and acreage of the later owners of small patents in these vast areas. We also wish it were possible to reduce the sheets in size so that the approximate locations could be shown, which might help in deciding what present county or counties the land might be located in, but if this were done to fit a page in this book, much would be of little value as the plot size would be so small it would be almost unreadable, therefore dates may be the only way of pinpointing a probable location of an ancestor. We hope you find one or more lost names in these hundreds listed!

We will start first with the BENJAMIN BORDEN Grant dated November 6, 1739 shown as being the Patent Book 18, Page 360 (in Richmond, Va.) and give a little of the information we think is rather interesting, but will omit all the various trees such as red oaks, hickories, white oaks, sugar trees and on and on, used as boundary points; the poles and poles (which were used as distances); the rivers and branches and all such which made up land grants, even of small areas, of those early dates, and give some of the other details before listing those we know received plots of land - some large and some small - and most issued by Benjamin Borden, Sr.

"GEORGE II BY THE GRACE OF GOD OF GREAT BRITAIN, FRANCE AND IRELAND,
KING, DEFENDER OF THE FAITH, ETC.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING

Know Ye that for divers good causes and considerations, but more especially in consideration that Benjamin Borden, late of the Province of East Jersey, now of the County of Orange, in Virginia hath lately caused to be imported and settled on the land herein after mentioned one family for every 1,000 acres, we have given, granted and confirmed and by these presents for us,

our heirs and successors do give, grant and confirm unto the said Benjamin and to his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of land, containing 92,100 acres, situate lying and being on the West side of the Blue Ridge in the County of Augusta and on the North and Northeast Branches of James River, between the Blue Ridge and the North Mountain, and bounded as followeth (To wit): BEGINNING - At three hickories andetc...etc to the beginning, with all woods, underwoods, swamps, marshes, low grounds, meadows, feedings, and his due share of all veins, mines.....In Witness whereof we have caused these our letters of patent to be made.

Witness our trusty and well beloved William Gooch, Esquire....etc.....the Sixth day of November One Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty Nine, in the Thirteenth Year of our Reign. (Signed - WILLIAM GOOCH.)"

There is a notation on this map that the grants listed were from Benjamin Borden, Sr. but there were many vacant areas shown, some of which were later sold by his heirs. Also there were questions regarding some of the Deeds, stating they overlapped. Beginning with the alphabetical names of the first part will cover those which are shown on the Borden Patent and the second part will give the names in the Beverley Patent.

There is no actual legal description of the Beverley Patent, such as that shown on the Borden Patent which gives the trees, rivers, branches, poles and so forth but it does indicate that it abuts the other in a number of spots and may be what caused the difficulty later in what was called "overlapped deeds". Following will be quoted from the Map:

118,491 Acres. THE MANOR OF BEVERLEY PATENT _ Lying and being in the COUNTY OF ORANGE between the Great Mountains, on the River Sherando - August 12, 1736 - Signed by WILLIAM GOOCH, ESQ., Lieut. Gov. - September 6, 1736 to:

WILLIAM BEVERLEY, of the County of Essex, Gentleman.
SIR JOHN RANDOLPH, of the Town of Williamsburgh, Knight.
RICHARD RANDOLPH, of the County of Henrico, Gentleman.
JOHN ROBINSON, of the County of King and Queen, Gentleman.
UNDER GEORGE II, of ENGLAND.

(Note: Beverley acquired the Rights of the other Patentees September 17, 1736.)

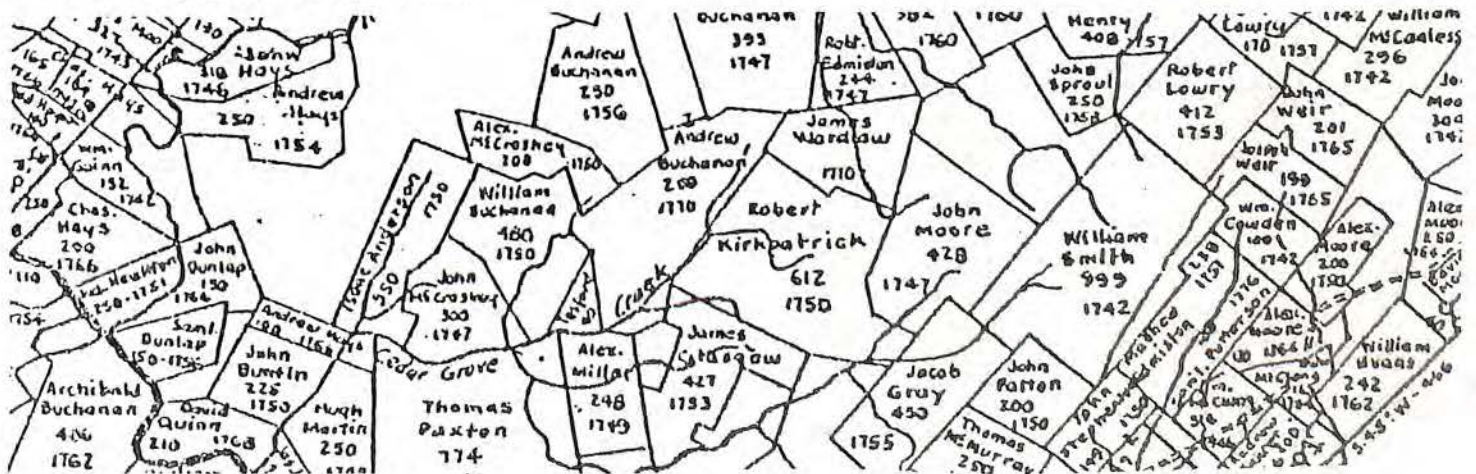

LETTER OF A REVOLUTIONARY PATRIOT

Received from member James W. FORESMAN, 15 Tuarangi Road, Grey Lynn, Auckland, New Zealand, with the following citations:

Bedford County, Virginia, 16th Day of February 1781

Dear Brother: (i.e. Thomas Kennedy, in Kentucky)

I have the happiness to write to you by Mr. David Crews, who is my particular friend, and who will either, I hope, deliver my letter or send it safely to you. I send by him a quire of paper for you and Mr. Constant, which you must divide. I would have sent you a quire apiece, but Mr. Crews has many things of his own to carry. My family are well. I had a letter from brother Joseph a little while before Christmas. He was in health, so was Mother and all the friends there. I saw a man that lodged at brother Joseph's, in January, who brings me word that he had been to see brother Hugh, who had moved to Shanado, near Cunningham's Mill, in Virginia, and that he was very sick and likely to die, and had, when Joseph left him, not taken any nourishment for fifteen days; consequently, we may expect he is gone to the world of spirits, where we are all hastening. I expect brother Joseph here in the next month. He is mightily desirous, I learn by his letter, to move to Kentucky, and indeed, I have a great mind to venture in a short time myself, and I wish I knew what was best. Times are exceedingly troublesome here, our taxes are so high. But I should not, I think, be worsted, if I had not such a parcel of girls. When we drafted for regular soldiers in August last, it was every fifteenth man; if it falls to my lot again, it is hard luck, indeed. Col. Morgan has lately taken five or six hundred British prisoners, which are now passing through this country: but notwithstanding this little piece of good luck of ours, you may depend, I have of late, been very much afraid we should become a conquered people.

I have of late heard from those families who were taken from Martin's and Ruddle's station. Three young men have lately made their

escape from Detroit, and bring word they are comfortably settled in that neighborhood, except those who were butchered by the savages before they reached there. Col. Bird, they say, is very kind to them, etc. I have not seen the men, but one of my acquaintances tells me it is a fact. If you do not live in great fear, I think you live in more satisfaction than we do here. I would be glad to have the lands surveyed and the works made ready for the grants as soon as it may be done with safety; but I am not able to get anymore warrants till brother Joseph comes out with cash; besides, you may depend, it appears to me to be a great risk at present, wether we can support our independence or not: so that I am unwilling to borrow money if I could get to venture. Several able people that were to have been joine with me in getting warrants to send to Kentucky, to Mr. Constant, have all fell back. Some think they cannot pay their taxes without the money they had intended for that use. However, if brother Joseph brings cash, I intend to lay it our in warrants, if things don't get worse. It is expected the seat of the war will be in Virginia next summer. Mr. Crew tells me that if our warrants are located wrong in the surveyors book, we can locate them over again, provided no other location interferes. If so perhaps those warrants Duncan located may be altered. You did not inform me in your letter of the 21st of November, wether you were likely to raise any hogs. Pray remember me in kindest manner to Mr. Constant and Couchman, and all acquaintances in the Fort.

Do not let any, except a particular acquaintance, know that I think our country in a bad way, because it is only my private opinion, and would fain hope I am mistaken. I wish you many blessings and above all, a constant and grateful sense of God's almighty goodness. This is the ardent wish of your affectionate brother.

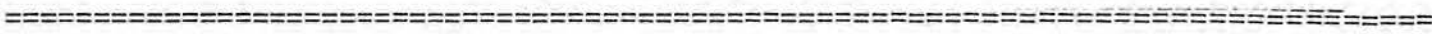
P.S. My wife joins me in love to you and the children, Since writing the above, we are all bodily summoned to meet the English, who are within a day's ride of us, we learn, with a considerable force. What the issue will be, time will determine. In less than three hours I am to leave my family and go in defense of my country.

"The fort was called Strode's Station. He was taken prisoner at the Battle of Guilford Court House, North Carolina, on the 15th of March 1781, and died on board a British Prison Ship, on the 26th of June following--literaly starved to death.

Dr. John Kennedy, the distinguished physician, was the father of John Kennedy and Thomas Kennedy of Strodes Fort. When a lad of six years of age, he with other boys, was stolen (or kidnapped) off the shores of Ireland, taken to the Colony of Maryland and there sold for a term of years, which he faithfully served out. He became a leading citizen, and his sons likewise were prominent men.

The latter part of this was supplied by Mrs. Maude Ware Lafferty, a cousin of Alice Smiser from the fort a Strodes Station etc."

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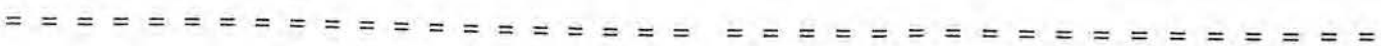

A FEW OF THE DESCENDANTS OF CHARLES MAYBERRY/MABRY OF GRAYSON (CARROLL) CO. - 176?-1840 by Ora Belle Mayberry McColman and Other Descendants. Charles Mayberry (name changed to Mabry) settled in Grayson (now Carroll) Co. in the late 1700's, married the daughter of Samuel Helton (Hylton) whose name is believed to have been Sarah Elizabeth. It is believed he was the son of Isaac Mayberry who was in now Patrick Co. at Mayberry (now Meadows of Dan) in the late 1700's. Nine children: Amelia married John Reynolds, Joshua G., John W., Isaac, Nancy married William Tyler Sutphin, Samuel S., Elizabeth married Hiatt Montgomery, Joseph J. Mabry, and Susannah married Jesse Reynolds. At least eleven grandchildren migrated to Illinois and beyond in the 1860's and 1870's and four migrated into Kentucky. 499 pictures. After talking to older members and the ones doing research on the West Virginia Ashleys, we learned this family descended from a John and a Richard Ashley." They settled in Kanawha County, Virginia (now W.Va.) between 1808 and 1820. Researchers disagreed on the relationship of John and Richard. Many family charts have been included. Two other books which are very good - "The Researcher's Guide to American Genealogy" by Val D Greenwood (under \$20.00) and "The Source"- A Guidebook of American Genealogy" edited by Arlene Eakle & Johni Cerny (\$39.95). Dear Member of the Virginia Genealogical Society,

By now you may have heard of the closing of the building housing the Virginia State Library and Archives on August 18. At present the state is awaiting the results of tests to determine whether or not the structure is safe to reopen because of problems such as asbestos, mold and fungus. Work has been done, according to the newspapers, to upgrade the electrical system, the failure of which prompted the closing. There are no publically announced dates for reopening at this time.

The Virginia State Library and Archives represents the largest single concentration of genealogical material on Virginia. The closing of this major facility, while obviously necessary, is of great concern to all genealogists in Virginia and to those around the country with Virginia ancestors. The sad condition into which this building has been allowed to deteriorate is illustrative of the over-all lack of attention by the state government and the General Assembly in particular, to the State Library for some time. The present building is fifty years old and has out-grown its usefulness as the secure storehouse for Virginia's historical, literary, and archival treasures.

A new General Assembly convenes in January for the long session and presentation of the governor's biennial budget. Now is the time for each member of the Virginia Genealogical Society who is a resident of Virginia to write to Governor Baliles and to their state senator and delegate. I have already written to the governor and to all members of the Senate and House finance and appropriation committees. Funding for the State Library must be increased.

Each letter to these state officials should be concise. It should briefly state your concern that the library is closed and, more importantly, that you strongly urge the governor and General Assembly to provide more funding to the Virginia State Library and Archives to insure proper and improved preservation and processing of archival materials and proper and improved services to the public. You might wish to add that if the present building is determined to be unsafe for continued use, that an immediate move of the library and archives be made to secure, safe quarters where the public will have access and parking. We do not want to see a similar situation develop in Virginia as in Maine where the State Library has been closed for similar reasons since April 1986! Even if the present building is reopened, you should urge state officials to take immediate steps towards the planning and construction of a new, modern and larger State Library building with parking. A new building will take years to achieve but a start must be made soon.

Your local public library will be able to provide you with the names of your state senator and delegate. The governor's address is: The Honorable Gerald L. Baliles, Office of the Governor, Richmond, VA 23219. For years the State Library has helped genealogists; now is the time for us to reciprocate. Please write soon.
