

Dear Fellow Members:



## IT'S THE LAW

Virginia Statutes Pertaining to Cemeteries

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## RELIGIOUS AND CHARITABLE MATTERS: CEMETERIES

Chapter 3. - CemeteriesArticle 1. - General Provisions

- § 57-22. Conveyance of land to trustees for cemetery use. - Land may be conveyed to trustees, not less than five nor more than nine in number for the use of any city, county, magisterial district, cemetery association, ecclesiastical or other society, as a cemetery. It shall be held by such trustees and their successors for such use and no other. (Code 1919, § 50.)
- § 57-23. Appointment, change or removal of trustees. - On the application of the governing body of a city or town, the Commonwealth's attorney of a county, ten citizens of a magisterial district, or the proper authorities of any such association or society, for whose use such cemetery is held, the circuit court of the county in which the cemetery is situated may, from time to time, appoint, change, and remove the trustees, as provided in § 57-8, whenever it may seem to the court proper to effect or promote the purposes of the trust. (Code 1919, § 51.)
- § 57-24. Powers and duties of trustees. - Such trustees and their successors shall have power to make such rules and regulations for the burial of the dead, the laying off, assignment and sale of burial lots, and the management, care, preservation and improvement of the grounds, as they may deem proper. They may take and hold personal property and money for the purposes of the trust, and what is so acquired and all money received from the sale of lots shall be accounted for by them and faithfully applied to such purposes. (Code 1919, § 52.)
- § 57-24.1. Trustee for purpose of suit. -- In the case of any private or family graveyard, where no trustees have been designated, and it appears that the interest of justice may be served by the appointment of a trustee or trustees for the purpose of suing or being sued, on the petition of any interested party, the court of record wherein deeds are recorded of the county or city in which such cemetery is located, may appoint a trustee or trustees for the purpose of suing or being sued. The petitioner shall bear the expense of such proceedings, provided that in the event a recovery is effected on behalf of such trustee or trustees, costs shall be taxed as provided by law. (1970, c. 94.)
- § 57-25. Condemnation of land for cemeteries. - If it be desired at any time to establish a cemetery, for the use of a city, town, county or magisterial district, or to enlarge any such cemetery already established, and the title to land needed cannot be otherwise acquired, land sufficient for the purpose may be condemned. Application for the condemnation shall be made by the governing body of the city or town, the Commonwealth's attorney of the county, or any ten citizens of the magisterial district, as the case may be, to the circuit court of the county in which the land lies, and the proceedings shall be according to the provisions of Title 25 for condemnation of land thereunder, so far as they can be applied to the case. The title to any land acquired under the proceedings, if for the enlargement of an existing cemetery, shall vest in the trustees of such cemetery; and if for the establishment of a new cemetery, the

title shall vest in trustees to be appointed under § 57-23. The land shall be held by the trustees and their successors as provided by § 57-22. (Code 1919, § 53.)

- § 57-26. Restrictions as to location of cemeteries and as to quantity of land. -
- (1) Restrictions as to location. - No cemetery shall be hereafter established within a county or the corporate limits of any city or town, unless authorized by appropriate ordinance subject to any zoning ordinance duly adopted by the governing body of such county, city or town; provided that authorization by county ordinance shall not be required for interment of the dead in any churchyard or for interment of members of a family on private property; nor shall any cemetery be established within 250 yards of any residence without the consent of the owner of the legal and equitable title of the residence; provided that subject to the foregoing if the location for the proposed cemetery is separated from any residence by a state highway, it may be established upon such location without the consent of the owner of such residence if it be not less than 250' from the residence at its nearest point thereto; provided such prohibition and restriction shall not apply where the tract of land intended for use as a cemetery is separated by any residence by a state highway and now contains a public or private burial ground and is not within the corporate limits of any city or town; and no cemetery shall be hereafter established, and no burial made in any part of any cemetery, other than a municipal or city cemetery, located within 300 yards of any property owned by any city, town or water company, upon which or a portion of which are now located driven wells from which water is pumped or drawn from the ground in connection with the public water supply.
- (2) Quantity of land. - Nothing contained in §§ 57-22 to 57-25 shall be so construed as to authorize a conveyance of more than 300 acres or the condemnation of more than 2 acres of land for the use of a cemetery.
- (3) Action for damages. - When damage is done to adjacent land by the establishment of such cemetery, whether established by purchase or condemnation, the owners whose lands have been damaged shall have a right to action for such damage against any person, firm, corporation, or municipality, establishing the cemetery; provided such action be instituted within one year from such establishment.
- (4) Exceptions. - The prohibitions and restrictions as to the location or establishment of cemeteries shall not apply to the town of Stuart, in Patrick County, to the town of Gretna, in Pittsylvania County, to the town of Shenandoah in Page County, or to the Woodbine Cemetery in the city of Harrisonburg, Rockingham County. And if the location for the proposed cemetery be in Norfolk County it may be established on such location if consent thereto be given by the owners of every residence within 250' thereof at its nearest point to any such residence, or if the location for the proposed cemetery is separated from any such residence by a state highway it may be established upon such location without the consent of the owner of residence if it be not less than 150' from the residence at its nearest point thereto. (Code 1919, § 56; 1926, p. 866; 1934, p. 13; 1942, p. 102; 1944, p. 462; 1948, p. 492; 1952, c. 108; 1954, c. 10; 1960, c. 161.)
- § 57-27. City of Richmond may prohibit burials in certain cemeteries. - The governing body of the City of Richmond may, by ordinance, prohibit the burial of dead bodies in the cemeteries known as Hams's, Cedarwood, Methodist, Union Mechanics', Ebenezer, and Sycamore cemeteries, respectively, and may by such ordinance provide for penalties for violations of the same by fine not exceeding fifty dollars, or imprisonment in jail not exceeding six months. (Code 1919, § 57)

Chapter 3. - CemeteriesArticle 2. - Jointly Owned Cemeteries.

- § 57-28. Cities and counties may establish. - Any city and county, or any number of cities and counties, may jointly purchase or otherwise acquire land for the purpose of improving and establishing a jointly owned cemetery or cemeteries, and the governing bodies of the cities and counties purchasing or acquiring land for joint cemetery purposes shall have the power to plan any such cemetery and amend and revise any plans so made, to determine the perpetual upkeep requirements of such cemetery and of perpetual upkeep lots therein, to fix the purchase price of all lots therein, and to designate pauper lots and lots with and without perpetual care. (1944,p.326; Michie Suppl. 1946, § 53a.)
- § 57-29. Trustees. - After acquiring and planning such cemetery or cemeteries, the circuit court of the county wherein the cemetery is located shall appoint not less than five nor more than nine trustees, who shall reside in the city or county, for the purpose of managing and controlling such cemetery. The trustees shall have the power to convey lots in the cemetery in accordance with the plan thereof, without authority of court, and to include in deeds of conveyance such reasonable restrictions and conditions as they deem advisable, and shall have all other powers granted by general law to trustees of cemeteries. Such trustees shall, before entering upon the performance of their duties, give bond with approved security and in such penalty as the court determines for the faithful performance of their duties.(1944, p. 326; Michie Suppl. 1946, § 53a)
- § 57-30. Funds from sale of lots and for perpetual upkeep. - The trustees shall, upon delivery of a deed for any lot or portion thereof, except a pauper lot, collect the purchase price and pay it to the designated treasurer of either the county or city establishing the cemetery. The amounts received from the sale of lots or portions thereof as herein determined shall be used by the city and county to pay for the cost of the land and improvements. All funds for perpetual upkeep shall be properly invested under the direction of the governing bodies of the city and county. The balance of the purchase price of lots or portions thereof, and so much of the income from invested perpetual care funds as may be needed, shall be paid annually to the trustees, to be used by them along with all other funds received by them for the maintenance, operation and upkeep of the cemetery and of the perpetual care lots therein. (1944, p. 326; Michie Suppl. 1946, § 53a.)

Article 3. - Disposition of Property for Maintenance and Care.

- § 57-31. May be in perpetuity. - No disposition of property heretofore or hereafter made for the maintenance or care of any cemetery, burial ground, burial lot in a cemetery, or monument, or other erections about such cemetery or burial lot, shall fail by reason of such disposition having been made in perpetuity, but shall be valid.(Code 1919, § 59; 1918, p. 103; 1920, p. 10.)

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 Learning about Virginia's laws which govern cemetery operations takes a little time and study and it is comforting to feel that these laws protect both those inside a cemetery and those outside.

Our Genealogists who do a lot of work in cemeteries will be more interested in the laws under Article 4 which deal with abandoned and neglected graveyards and removal and reinterment of remains.

Your Petitioner therefore prays that your Hon'ble house will consider the hardship under which he lies & grant him the Necessary and your Petitioner will pray \_\_\_\_? Nathan Ryan, the 20th of October 1791.

Cemetery is no longer maintained & is in very bad condition with some of the tombstones completely turned over & lying face down; therefore, not all graves are listed here.

## FRANKLIN COUNTY, VA, PUBLIC LIBRARY

The first Franklin County Public Library building, located directly behind the courthouse in Rocky Mount, was a gift from David K.E. Bruce of Charlotte County, Virginia. Between 1937 and 1942, Mr. Bruce, who later served as ambassador to England, France, Germany, and NATO, and as special envoy to China in the 1970s, donated libraries to eleven rural Virginia communities. With the exception of Hanover County, the recipient localities are all in the southwestern part of the state and share common borders.

Like Franklin County's first public library, all of the donated buildings are typical of the 18th century style of colonial Virginia architecture and are almost identical to each other. Mr. Bruce requested that colonial Virginia colors be used for the interiors, and the libraries be constructed from plans by the firm of Claiborne & Taylor Inc., which conducted the restoration of Williamsburg.

Besides the eleven buildings, Mr. Bruce also donated furnishings, equipment, and a basic collection of books to each county.

Unsuccessful in his attempt to remain anonymous as the benefactor to the eleven communities, Mr. Bruce never revealed why he donated library buildings, as opposed to some other form of educational assistance, nor did he ever explain how he selected the recipient counties.

Mr. Bruce's gift served Franklin County as a library for forty-six years until a new facility opened in August of 1986. Renovated in 1987, the old library now houses various county offices.

One of the goals in constructing a new library was the inclusion of a local history room for the study of the county's past and the lineage of its people.

After a year of preparation, the Gertrude Casler Mann Local History Room opened in 1989. Named for the co-founder of the Franklin County Historical Society, the room houses approximately 400 books, plus file folders, maps, genealogy magazines, and displays of artifacts and memorabilia of local interest.

While the room's collection is geared towards the study of local family histories, it also contains books on 58 of Virginia's 95 counties as well as information on various areas in Maryland, Kentucky, Tennessee, Ohio, and Pennsylvania.

The highlight of the room is the Mann Collection, a one hundred and eleven volume set compiled by the library staff from Mrs. Mann's correspondences over the years with genealogy buffs in the United States and Canada.

Each volume contains a table of contents of family names. In addition, there is a cross-reference index to the entire collection so that a researcher can locate a specific family even if that family name is found in more than one volume.

Currently, the library staff is compiling, organizing, and indexing a supplemental set derived from additional work done by Mrs. Mann.

Complementing the materials in the local history room, the library's reference section includes such tools for genealogical study as the Raney and Garrett Collections (both sets contain information on family histories), census records, a cemetery book compiled by the Franklin County Historical Society, and information on wills.

Between January and September of 1991, visitors from twenty-three states and Canada have used the materials at the Franklin County Library for genealogical research.

**VIRGINIA STATE LIBRARY & ARCHIVES**

Family bibles and family registers are frequently the only source of birth and death records prior to 1853 when Va began recording vital statistics and during the years 1896 through 1912 when Va did not require the registration of births and deaths. The growth of the Va State Library & Archives collection of photocopies of bible records is dependent on private individuals having their records duplicated. The enclosed brochure describes how this process may be accomplished. Would you please make your membership aware of "The Family Records." From brochure: .....Placing your family Bible records in the Archives helps ensure that the information will be available to future generations of researchers. Here is how to have your records placed in the Archives collection. \*If you can bring your original Bible to the Archives, we will make arrangements to copy the family information for the collection at no charge. \*If you cannot visit the Archives, make good quality photocopies of the title page of the Bible showing the date of publication and any pages which record dates of birth, death, marriage or other important family information. Send the copies you make along with information about the Virginia counties of residence of the families shown in the record to the Archives and Records Division, Virginia State Library and Archives, 11th street at Capitol Square, Richmond, Virginia 23219-3491.

(Note from editor: Many family histories list the source as 'family Bible' - for many this is not proof because they have not been able to see the Bible. By placing a copy in libraries where the public can see it, researchers have a source of information not heretofore available. Also, there is always the chance the Bible could be destroyed in your home - by fire, flood, being discarded by someone, etc. Not only place a copy in the Archives but in a local library - more places the copies are placed, the less chance of the record being lost. AND DON'T FORGET THE VIRGINIA ROOM, ROANOKE PUBLIC LIBRARY.)

There are good leads here but if you don't agree - prove it. All information is well set-up and easily read. There are selections from John Sowers' newspaper "Pearisburg Gazette" 1868, 1869 on the people of Giles, giving an idea of life for those years & showing the importance of this source for research. There are photocopies of a few marriage consents. For those who have not seen the original records, these are very easy to read - not all records are this good. There is a complete given & surname index - the numbers refer to the census number & not the page number which make the name easy to find.
