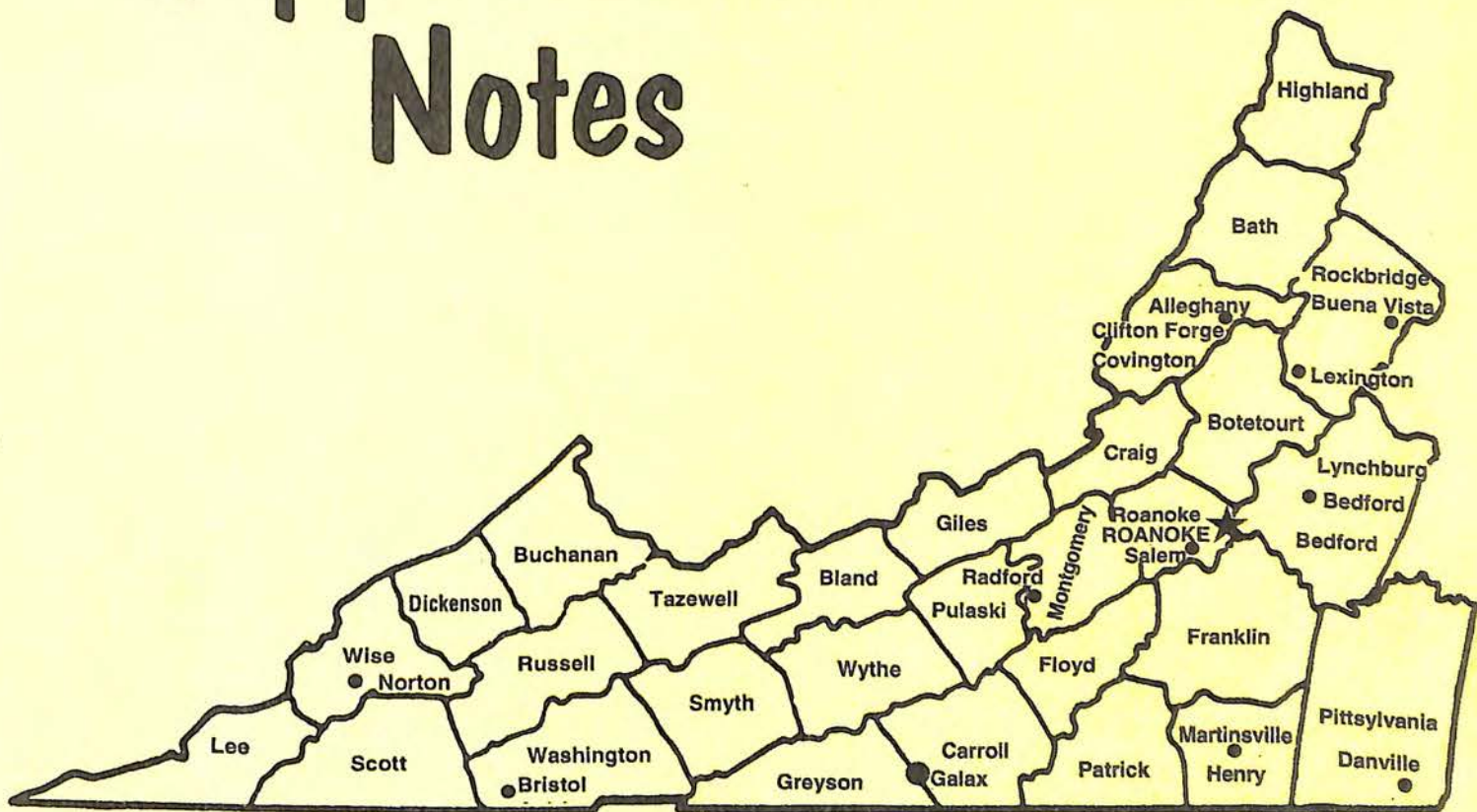

The VAN is published quarterly, usually in February; May, August and November. These issues are followed by an annual index issue. Society memberships are on a calendar year basis and those memberships, which are not renewed by January 30, will be deemed as inactive and removed from the mailing list. Single memberships are \$15.00; Family memberships are \$18.00; Organization and Library memberships are \$12.50. Members with mailing addresses outside the United States will add \$10.00 to the above fees, to help defray the additional postage fees for the mailing of the VAN. Back issues of the VAN are available at a reimbursement cost of \$4.00 each, as long as the supply lasts.

Smyth county was formed from Washington and Wythe in 1832. It lies in the valley formed by the Alleghany and Clinch mountains, with Washington county on the western and Wythe and Bland on the eastern borders. The valley lands are very fertile, and the upper lands produce the spontaneous blue grass upon which large herds of cattle are annually raised. The county is drained by the North, Middle and South forks of the Holston river, which have their rise in this county while the Norfolk and Western railroad extends through its middle part east and west. It has been demonstrated by actual experience within the last few years that the county (especially the Rich Valley and Chestnut Ridge sections) cannot be surpassed for the production of tobacco—either fine yellow or heavy shipping. Corn, wheat, oats and buckwheat are grown in paying quantities, and the dairy and orchard products are varied and valuable. Iron ore, limestone and salt are found in great abundance, as are also lead, copper, gypsum and marble. Marion, the county seat, is a thriving, handsome town of considerable business importance, situated about the centre of the county, 275 miles southwest from Richmond, on the line of the Norfolk & Western Railroad, and on the banks of Middle Fork Holston river. It is the site of the South Western Lunatic Asylum. The county has an area of 57 square miles, 327,394 acres, and the lands have an average assessed value of about \$5.00 per acre.

LAND SALE SYSTEM

from Burton Collection

The following is taken from a letter that Mr. Charles Burton had written to a client concerning land during the 1780s.

"A number of people in the area were claiming land for which there had been no grant issued. The Commissioners were appointed to hear each person's claim, and investigate their proofs of claims, and decide who was entitled to how much land at what place. Some people were here with no permission of any kind. Some had permission. This permission, or warrant, could be acquired by military service, or by purchase from the State. This warrant could be sold and assigned to another person. The holder of a warrant could have the County Surveyor go to the land he had found (not already claimed by someone) and have it surveyed by metes and bounds. This surveyor's report could also be sold and assigned to another. The holder of the surveyor's report could then send it to the Land Office so that a grant could be issued to him. After the grant was issued, when the land rights were sold, a deed was written and recorded. When the Warrant, or surveyor's report was assigned, it was endorsed on the back, as we do a check. Sometimes there were several assignments made on the same document.

Now, when the Commissioners issued the Certificate, we are thinking about, they were saying that they had looked into the documents presented to them by 'John Doe', and had decided that he was entitled to the supposed 800 acres. They had examined the papers which those named had assigned to him, and found them to be legal. 'Doe' would send this Certificate to the Land Office, and a grant would be issued to him. But, again, this Certificate could be sold and assigned to another.

When a person, with a Warrant, found some unclaimed land that he liked he went to the Courthouse and had this location recorded in the Entry Book. The last part of the Certificate -- interest from 17 Nov 1769 -- probably means that their rights were assigned to 'Doe' on that date.

BREACH OF MARRIAGE CONTRACT

Ann Myres, Plaintiff against William Snodgrass, Defendant

The case was argued by Watts & Allen Taylor for the plaintiff, and by Miller & Baldwin for the defendant. The contract was fully proved. The defendant's ground of defence was that she had departed from virtue, but in this he was not borned out by evidence. It did indeed appear, she had been seduced by the defendant, who produced witnesses to prove that she had frequently 'bundled' with young men, but such was their character and manner with but one exception, (Wilson) that the jury did not give the 'least credit' to their testimony. The defendant was most ably supported by his counsel.

The jury after a consultation of about half an hour decided in favour of the Plaintiff --- damages, Three hundred dollars. The defendant's property was supposed to be worth two thousand dollars.

**LEGISLATIVE PETITION
 for GILES COUNTY, VIRGINIA**

To the General Assembly of Virginia

The undersigned petitions would humbly represent to Your honourable body that grant ^{apparent} inconvenience is now and has been for most of the present Year suffered, by those persons who are owners of lands lying along the margin of New River, because of the want in most instances of the means and ability of procuring the necessary fencing along those part of the farms bordering upon said River.

Your petitioners would represent that in the month of May last, a freshet happened in said River that overflowed its banks and carried away perhaps nineteen Twentieths of all the fencing along the river, leaving the Crops of the Farmers residing on the River there in a very flourishing Condition exposed to destruction by all the ^{stock} that usually range about the River, and to prevent which these seemed to be but one resort and that was to connect the fencing with the River at the upper and lower ends of the farms, and make the River answer the purpose of the fencing which by an act of Providence the owners had been defenced of. Your petitioners would further state that this resort proved to answer a very valuable purpose and that so far as Your petitioners are informed no person suffered any loss whatever by stock passing around the points of connection by the fencing and the River. Your petitioner therefore Confidently believe that it would be of very great advantage to the farmers alonge the River to be permitted to use the said river as a lawful fence. this river is in average width about three hundred Yards, and but little probabily that stock would ever attempt to cross. Your petitioners therefore earnestly desire that Your honourable body may pass a law declaring New River a lawful fence and as in duly bound will ever pray &c

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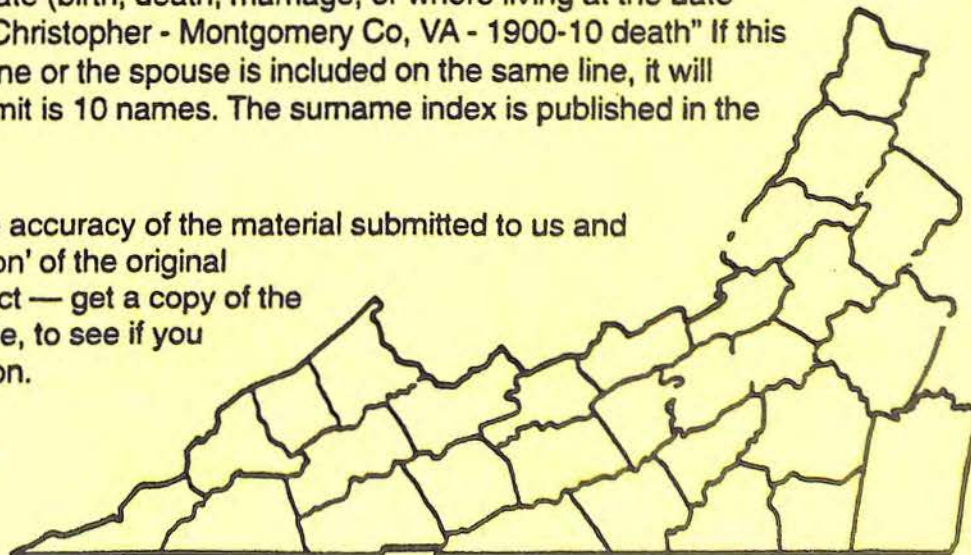
