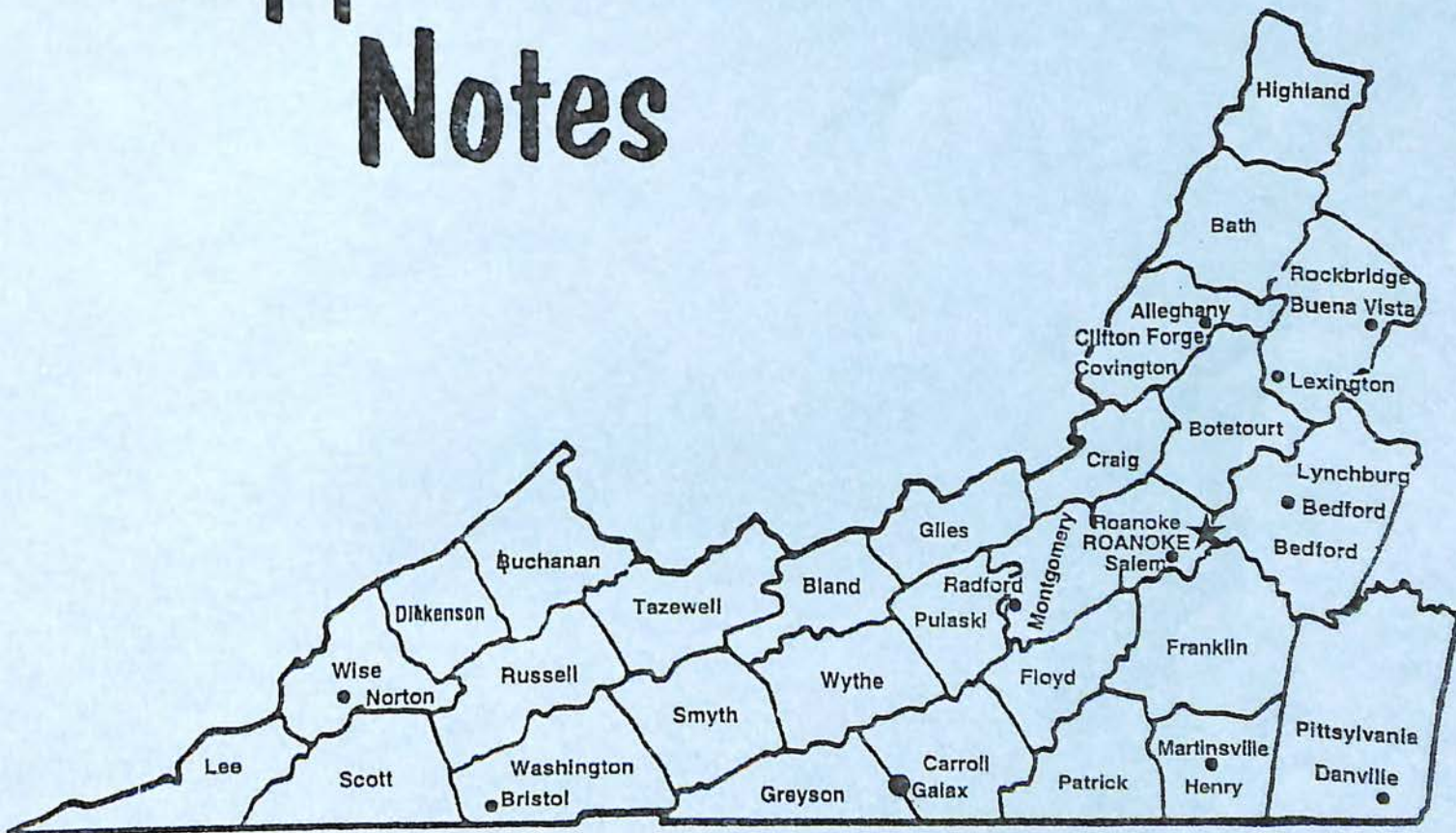

The **SOUTHWESTERN VIRGINIA GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY, INC.** is a tax-exempt corporation under section 501(c)(3) of the Federal Income Tax Code. Section 170 of the Tax Code provides for the treatment of contributions to the SVGS as a deductible contribution by the donor. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to the SVGS may be deductible for Federal estate gift tax purposes, if they meet the applicable provisions of sections 2055, 23106, and 2522 of the Tax Code.

MEMBERSHIP: Each SVGS member will be mailed a copy of the "Society's" quarterly, the VIRGINIA APPALACHIAN NOTES (VAN). The VAN is usually published quarterly. The annual index will be included in the Fall issue of the VAN for that year. Society memberships are on a calendar year basis and those memberships, which are not renewed by January 30, will be deemed as inactive and removed from the VAN mailing list. Single or family memberships are \$20.00; Organization and Library memberships are \$15.00. Members with mailing addresses outside the United States shall add \$10.00 to the above fees and all monies are payable in U. S. currency. All payments should be made by check or money order, payable to: **Southwestern Virginia Genealogical Society, Inc. or to SVGS, Inc.** and mailed to **Post Office Box 12485, Roanoke, VA 24026-2485.**

BACK ISSUES of the VAN: 1995 and earlier, are available at a reimbursement cost of \$4.00 each, as long as the supply lasts. More recent issues are \$6.00 each. These prices include postage. Mailed to Virginia addresses please add 4.5% sales tax. A bulk mailing of old VANs to one address may be eligible for a discount. 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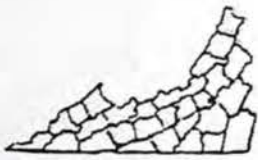

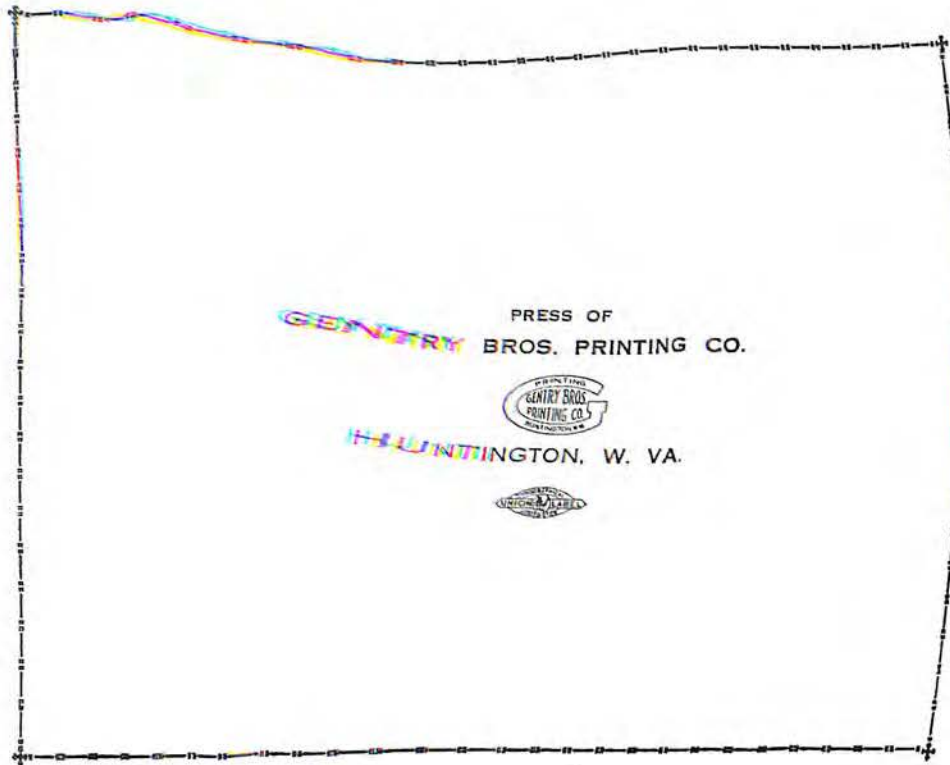

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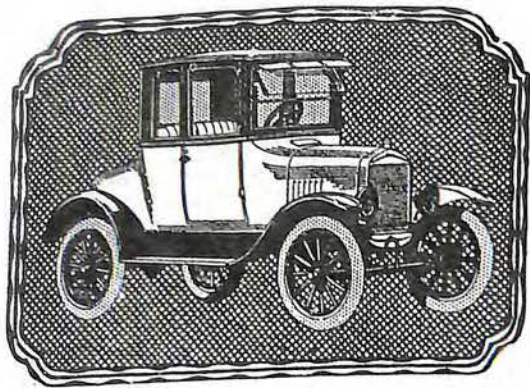

Locate Civil War relatives online

I

I receive a lot of correspondence about Civil War ancestors. The letters are fascinating and I try to include as many of them as I can when I write my columns.

But I also get many questions that ask for information about finding a Civil War ancestor when all the writer has is a name and maybe an inkling of where the person lived. This presents problems and I have generally suggested that the writer make friends with his or her local librarian.

However, there are ways of going about a search on your own, and with the generous guidance of the Civil War Preservation Trust, I am going to discuss them in this column. The CWPT puts out a publication, Hallowed Ground, and a recent issue gave detailed information about finding a relative who may have fought in the Civil War.

that the census is indexed by the head of the household, which may be either the man you are seeking or his father. If you try this method, you should at least know where he enlisted so you will have an idea of who can be excluded.

- cwc.lsu.edu is excellent if you have the name and the state or place where he enlisted. Go to "Researching People in the Civil War Era." States are enormously proud of the contributions their citizens made during the Civil War. Most have published histories of their military units and often they have references to individual soldiers. This is one of the best sites I have found for Civil War information of all kinds.
- scv.org/membership/genealogy.asp is the address of Sons of Confederate Veterans Genealogy Network. It details information by state, including several from the North.

I

If you have a male ancestor who lived in this country during the Civil War, there is a good chance that he served in the military. About 50 percent of draft age men (generally 18 to 35) in the North served in the Union Army; about 75 percent of draft age men in the South served in the Confederate Army.

At a minimum, you should know his name. It is a plus if you also know where he enlisted or was conscripted and the company or regiment he joined. Check with family members who may have information about the relative you are researching. Often a distant cousin will have just the file or photo or discharge paper you need.

However, even if all you have is the name, there are records available on the Internet. If you do not have access to a computer, then try to use the one at the local library.

Hallowed Ground suggests these Internet addresses in any search. I checked them and they are up and running:

- itd.nps.gov/cwss is the address for the "Civil War Soldiers and Sailors System" of the National Park Service. At this site you can start with a name and go from there.
- fisher.lib.virginia.edu/census can give you the Federal Census of 1860. This site is invaluable if all you have is the name. Note

● nara.gov/genealogy/civilwar/html is the site if you know both the soldier's name and his regiment. This is the address of the National Archives in Washington, and people there are delighted to help with Civil War research. There is a small fee.

Two excellent books summarize most of this information: "Tracing Your Civil War Ancestor," by Bertram Groene, and "Civil War Genealogy," by George Schweitzer. In addition, many Virginia Civil War regiments have their own Web sites, complete with their battle histories and names of individuals who served. I started with Google and typed in "Civil War regiments Virginia" and found an enormous amount of information.

Finally, you can write the Civil War Preservation Trust at 1331 H St. N.W., #1001, Washington DC 20005.

Washday 1916

Years ago a Kentucky grandmother gave the new bride the following receipt, for washing clothes. It appears below *just as it was* written, and despite the spelling, has a bit of philosophy.

Tombstones and flowers

Reader Mary Williams of Pulaski provides this week's digital camera news by sharing tips for using her Olympus D-490 zoom camera to record tombstones relating to her genealogy research.

"I am dabbling in genealogy and also like to go to various cemeteries to make lists of all the stones. It is very time-consuming to try to write out all the information or expensive to take pictures with a 35 mm and have them developed," Williams wrote. "I have found that digital works fine for this purpose. The 8 MB card that came with the camera at the lowest resolution gives me 139 pictures, and the 32 MB card I bought will give me 399."

Initially, Williams hesitated to use the lowest resolution setting on her camera but finds it works well and produces readable stones. She transcribes the information on the stones from the screen and then erases the images.

She also reminds us that the camera cards are dropping in price. A year ago, she paid more than \$100 for a 32 MB card, but she recently bought a 64 MB card for about \$30.

Nothing solves the battery need, so it is necessary to have two sets of rechargeables, she said.

Many photo centers now will make prints from digital sources. You can even order prints online at www.shutterfly.com or www.Kodak.com You simply upload your images to the website and your prints are mailed you usually the next day.

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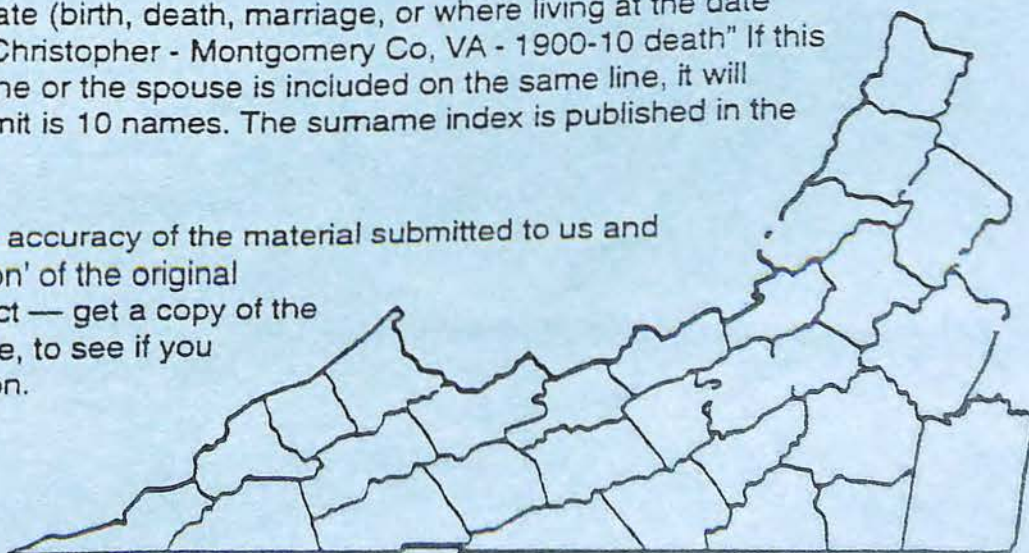
