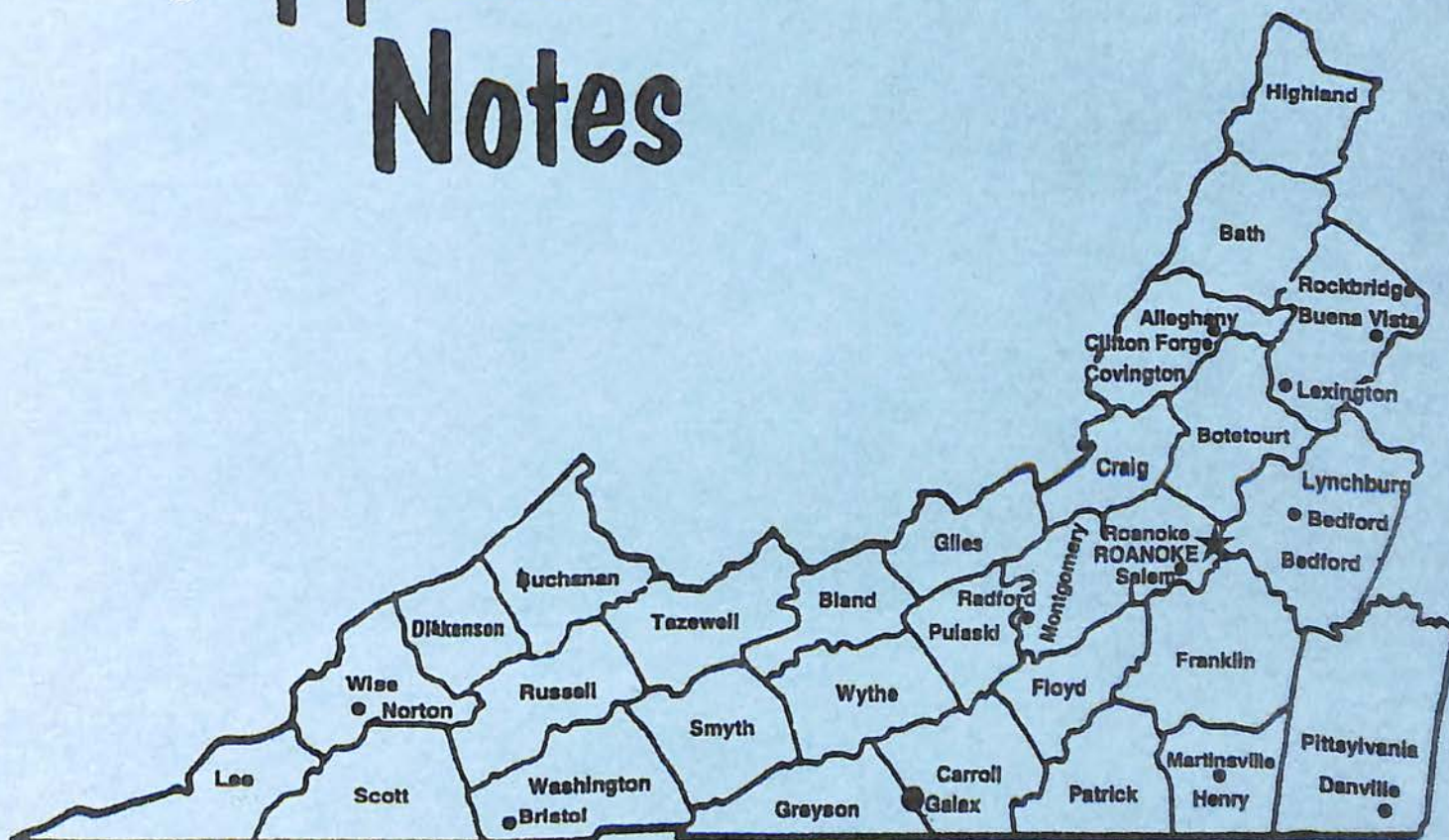

The **SOUTHWESTERN VIRGINIA GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY, INC.** is a tax-exempt corporation under section 501(c)(3) of the Federal Income Tax Code. Section 170 of the Tax Code provides for the treatment of contributions to the SVGS as a deductible contribution by the donor. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to the SVGS may be deductible for Federal estate gift tax purposes, if they meet the applicable provisions of sections 2055, 23106, and 2522 of the Tax Code.

MEMBERSHIP: Each SVGS member will be mailed a copy of the "Society's" quarterly, the **VIRGINIA APPALACHIAN NOTES (VAN)**. The VAN is usually published quarterly. The annual index will be included in the Fall issue of the VAN for that year. Society memberships are on a calendar year basis and those memberships, which are not renewed by January 30, will be deemed as inactive and removed from the VAN mailing list. Single or family memberships are \$20.00; Organization and Library memberships are \$15.00. Members with mailing addresses outside the United States shall add \$10.00 to the above fees and all monies are payable in U. S. currency. All payments should be made by check or money order, payable to: **Southwestern Virginia Genealogical Society, Inc. or to SVGS, Inc.** and mailed to: **SVGS, ATT: Membership, Post Office Box 12485, Roanoke, VA 24026-2485.**

BACK ISSUES of the VAN: 1995 and earlier, are available at a reimbursement cost of \$4.00 each, as long as the supply lasts. More recent issues are \$6.00 each. These prices include postage. Mailed to Virginia addresses please add 4.5% sales tax. A bulk mailing of old VANs to one address may be eligible for a discount. All payments should be made by check or money order, payable to SVGS and mailed to: **SVGS, ATT: Jim Nelson, Post Office Box 12485, Roanoke, VA 24026-2485.**

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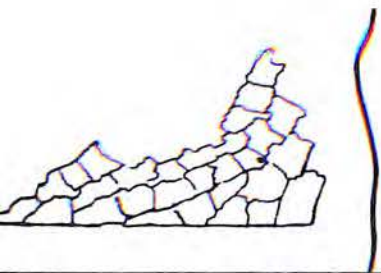

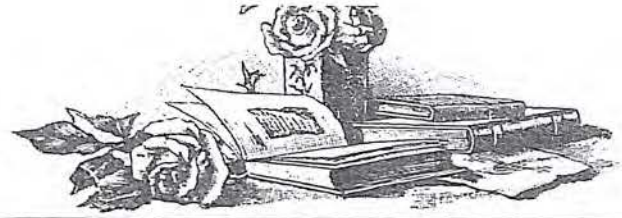

Generous Donations Allow Replacement of Old Equipment

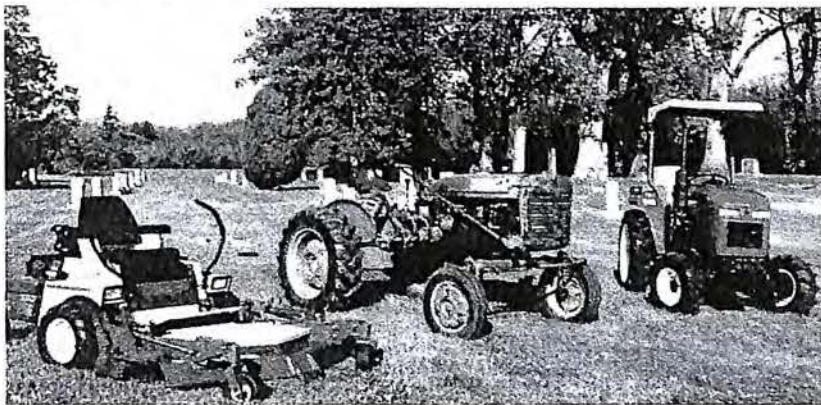
Fair View Cemetery may hold a record for the continuous use of aged equipment in the maintenance of the 75-acre burial grounds.

Three Farmall tractors, vintage 1947, 1948 and 1949, have served the cemetery for more than 55 years. Two of the tractors saw their last days this year, leaving only the 1948 Farmall in service.

Fortunately, a substantial and unexpected donation allowed the purchase of a small 20 HP Nortrac at a cost of \$6,500, as well as other critical equipment.

The cemetery requires three riding lawnmowers. We were able to purchase a Grasshopper riding lawnmower for \$9,500. Donations covered the cost of a F150 four-wheel drive pickup for \$21,150.

With the generous support of contributors, we are pleased to report that the new equipment was paid in full to our suppliers.

**JOSEPH BURWELL
KENNERLY**

April 18, 1926 - June 26, 2004



The Fair View Foundation pays tribute to a devoted and knowledgeable member of our Board of Directors, Joseph Kennerly.

Mr Kennerly's volunteer service to the Board spanned 28 years — one of the longest tenures in the 114-year history of Fair View Cemetery.

A native of Roanoke, he was educated at St. Andrew's School and Jefferson High School. Joe earned his degree at the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science. He later studied with Virginia Western Community College, the University of Virginia, and the School of Theology at the University of the South in Tennessee. He also served with the U. S. Navy Hospital Corps.

Joe touched the lives of many through his lay ministry at Christ Episcopal Church, and his membership in the Masons at Pleasants Lodge #33, Murray Royal Arch Chapter, the Scottish Rite, and the Kazim Shriners/ Provost Guard.

Joe is well remembered for his many years as a Licensed Funeral Director, and his 30 years of service with the Virginia and City of Roanoke Health Departments.

He is survived by his wife, Kathryn Bell Kennerly, two sons, their families and many devoted relatives and friends.

Valentine's Day has Special Significance for Fair View Cemetery

February 14, 2005 will be the 115th Anniversary of beautiful Fair View Cemetery. It was on that date in 1890, when Roanoke was Big Lick, that a group of leading citizens established Fair View Cemetery.

Over the years, great care has been taken to preserve the unique iron fence facing the Salem Turnpike entrance to Fair View. During 2004, the fence was sanded, primed and painted. The detail work was difficult and tedious, but our ongoing commitment continues to be to preserve, protect and enhance the cemetery property for future generations.

Replacing Memorial Marker Collars an Ongoing Challenge

From Spring to Fall each year, our maintenance staff continues to replace concrete marker collars that have deteriorated over the years. Approximately 250 are scheduled for restoration in 2005 at a cost of \$9,000.

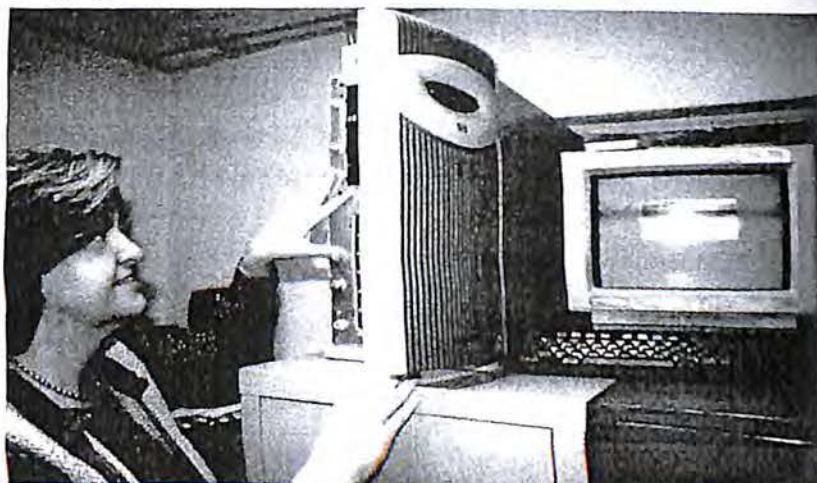
New Trees to Replace Those Removed During 2004

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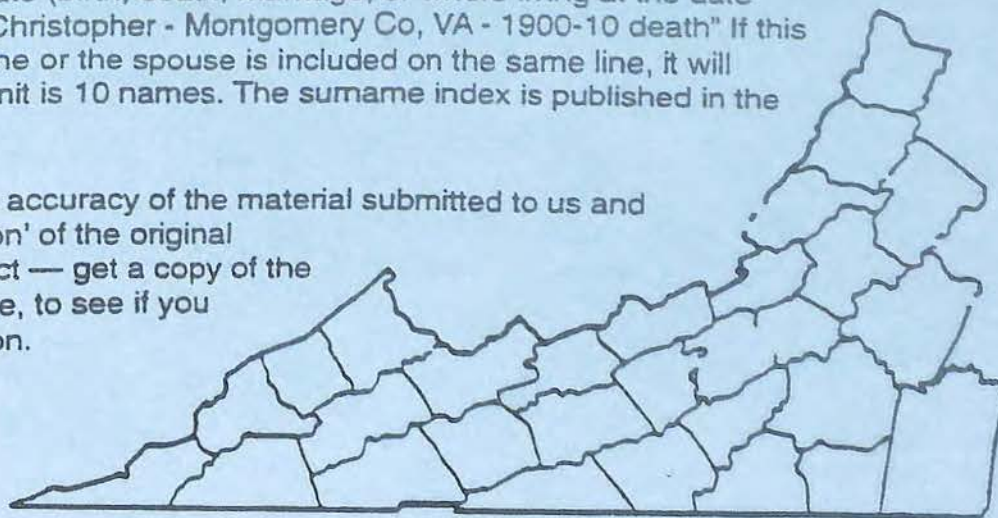
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
