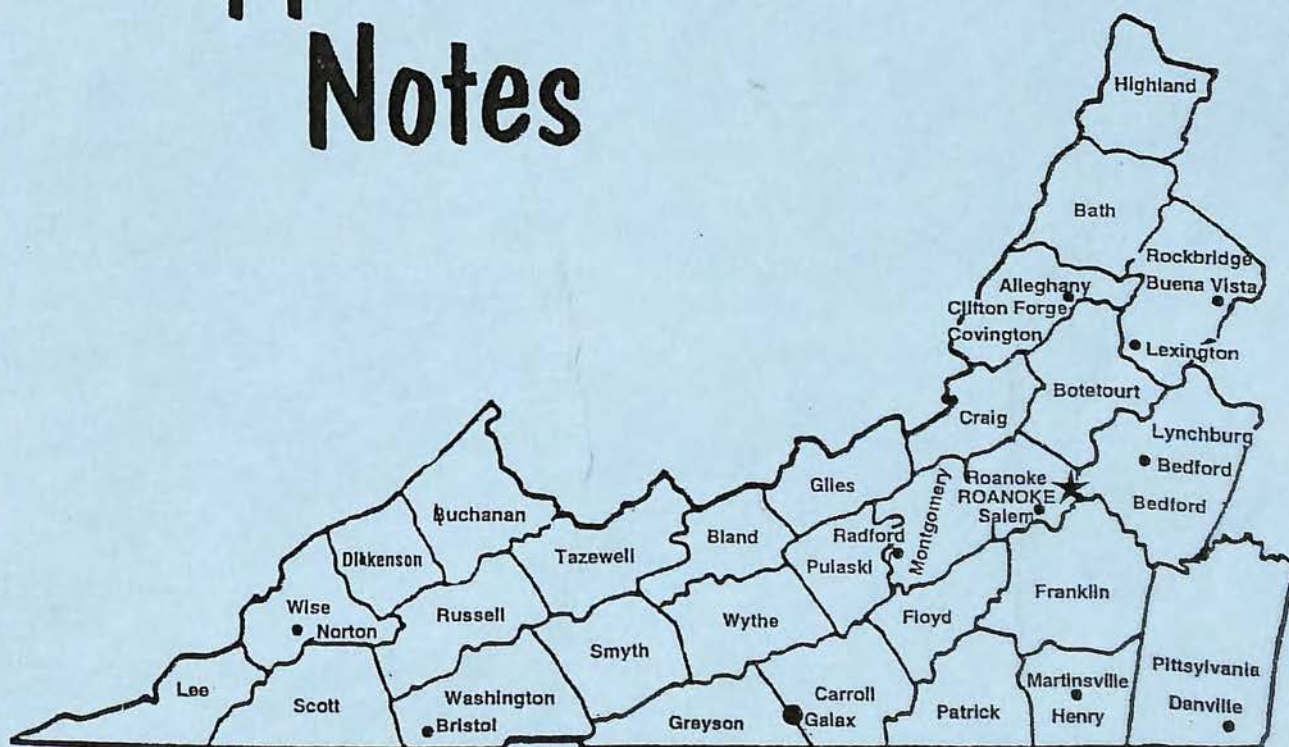

The **SOUTHWESTERN VIRGINIA GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY, INC.** is a tax-exempt corporation under section 501(c)(3) of the Federal Income Tax Code. Section 170 of the Tax Code provides for the treatment of contributions to the SVGS as a deductible contribution by the donor. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to the SVGS may be deductible for Federal estate gift tax purposes, if they meet the applicable provisions of sections 2055, 23106, and 2522 of the Tax Code.

MEMBERSHIP: Each SVGS member will be mailed a copy of the "Society's" quarterly, the VIRGINIA APPALACHIAN NOTES (VAN). The VAN is usually published quarterly. The annual index will be included in the Fall issue of the VAN for that year. Society memberships are on a calendar year basis and those memberships, which are not renewed by January 30, will be deemed as inactive and removed from the VAN mailing list. Single or family memberships are \$20.00; Organization and Library memberships are \$15.00. Members with mailing addresses outside the United States shall add \$10.00 to the above fees and all monies are payable in U. S. currency. All payments should be made by check or money order, payable to: **Southwestern Virginia Genealogical Society, Inc. or to SVGS, Inc.** and mailed to: **SVGS, ATT: Membership, Post Office Box 12485, Roanoke, VA 24026-2485.**

BACK ISSUES of the VAN: 1995 and earlier, are available at a reimbursement cost of \$4.00 each, as long as the supply lasts. More recent issues are \$6.00 each. These prices include postage. Memories can make us happy and at the same time, very sad. When one is elderly, we seem to cherish both happy and sad memories alike. There are happy memories of years gone by, things we did as a child, things we did with our parents, followed by the joyful times with our children and their father as we watched the children grow up and wondered how we had grown so old.

Remembering those years, I think about all the other people close to my age who have similar memories and wish we could share them with each other. One of my fondest memories as a child is of the happy, carefree days of summer evenings in Roanoke when after supper, the neighborhood children gathered on the sidewalks in front of their houses to play. Our parents were sitting on their front porch, visiting with neighbors and sipping sweetened ice tea. We felt loved and safe with Mother and Dad watching over us.

We rode our tricycles, skated, played hide-and-seek, and played tag, always "counting out" to see who would have to be "it" for the first game. We played hopscotch drawn in chalk in front of someone's house. In the cool evening, we could be heard chanting to the rhythm of a turning rope. Jumping rope was my favorite! I remember dozens of the limericks we chanted, jumping to the rhythm of the rhyme.

Who will I Marry?

Rich man, poor man,
Beggar man, thief,
Doctor, lawyer, merchant, chief,
Tinker, Tailor, soldier boy, sailor!

When you missed the rope during the limerick, the word you last chanted was destined to be your mate!

We learned to jump rope very quickly while two children turned it faster and faster with:

Mable, Mable, set the table
Don't forget the vinegar,
Mustard, salt and pepper!

Each time the word "pepper" was chanted, the rope was turned as fast as the two children could manage. Your turn at jumping ended when you missed the rope.

Teddy Bear

Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear, touch the ground, ground, ground
Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear, turn around, 'round, 'round
Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear, show your shoe, shoe, shoe
Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear, how old are you?

The "Teddy Bear" chant now required you to jump your age and then "run out" so the next person could have a turn.

All this could go on for hours, changing rhymes or limericks when we grew tired of one and agreed on another. These are such pleasant memories of years past!

Now, at nearly 90 years old, I go for rides to these old neighborhoods and I am saddened by how it has all changed. The growth of the area and the removal of many proud and beautiful buildings make it hard to recognize what was once a familiar neighborhood, if the place can be found at all. I realize how much I have seen and experienced in my life. I miss my husband, family and friends, now long passed. But no matter what the future brings, I know that the children of today will continue to play games with their friends and create wonderful memories just like those that are so precious to me and that make me so happy and sad all at the same time.

New Book by Max S. Thomas

A new book by Max S. Thomas is just off the press. Titled *THIS PLEASANT LAND: A Blue Ridge History*, it is being published posthumously by Harvestwood Press. The author's daughter, Jean Thomas Schaeffer, has served as editor, compiler, and publisher of the book.

This Pleasant Land is a 250-year chronological history of the border areas of Floyd, Franklin, and Patrick Counties in the Blue Ridge Mountains of southwestern Virginia. The book covers an area reaching out from the epicenter where the author lived by the Blue Ridge Parkway, about fifteen miles in all directions. In the book, the author also describes going with his father in a wagon to Roanoke to sell farm-grown products at the downtown Market.

The book is a local history but it is written within the context of what was happening in the outside world during the 18th, 19th, and 20th centuries. The paperback book has about 200 pages and begins with the first settlers coming to the area. The book goes on to explain how certain events impacted the local people – events such as the American Civil War and Reconstruction, the American chestnut blight, the Great Depression, the building of the Blue Ridge Parkway, and World War I and II.

The last half of the book is a collection of the author's earlier writings on a variety of topics such as early music, the language of the area, early roads, the mountain economy, country stores, old-time tools, fences, foraging, early marriages, women and their lives, photography, weather, geology, critters and maladies that caused problems, passing on, old-time medicine, and communicable diseases. One chapter tells about Sparrel Tyler Turner who represented the area in the Virginia House of Delegates and the Virginia State Senate. The book has twenty photographs, including a picture of Turner.

Speaking about the manuscript he wrote, Max Thomas said, "I am a fifth-generation descendant of the first settlers in this part of the Blue Ridge Mountains. I have lived all of my life on the same piece of land on a high plateau on the Floyd-Franklin County line in southwestern Virginia. Since I was a boy, I have been told stories about my ancestors and their neighbors, men and women who came to and lived in a pleasant and rugged land during the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries. No matter who told the stories, they were always the same. It is also my story, for I was born in 1908 and witnessed events through most of the twentieth century, including the building of the Blue Ridge Parkway in the 1930s. . . . So in 1997 at age 89, I began writing this history in longhand."

Jean Schaeffer has this to say about her father's book: "In publishing my father's book, I have made every effort to be true to his writing and intent. He wanted people to know about the Appalachian heritage of this area, and he wanted them to understand the local history within the context of what was going on in the outside world. He knew what he had to tell was extraordinary. His was a generation that served as a bridge, beginning with the most basic way of life typical of the nineteenth century and evolving into the modern technological age of the late twentieth century. He was a farmer and

school teacher. Having lived on the same piece of land for almost ninety-three years, he was drawn to it in a way that a native will understand. Beyond that, he wanted to know all he could and studied about the area the way a scientist or historian studies. He learned from his grandparents and other people, he learned from books, and he learned from his own observations about the natural environment. He knew first-hand about the land and its people and he wrote about them continually. He was interested in everything and was blessed with an excellent memory throughout his life. He was a deep and divergent thinker, and he wrote this history the way he thought and talked – like a conversation he might have had with a visitor on his back porch.”

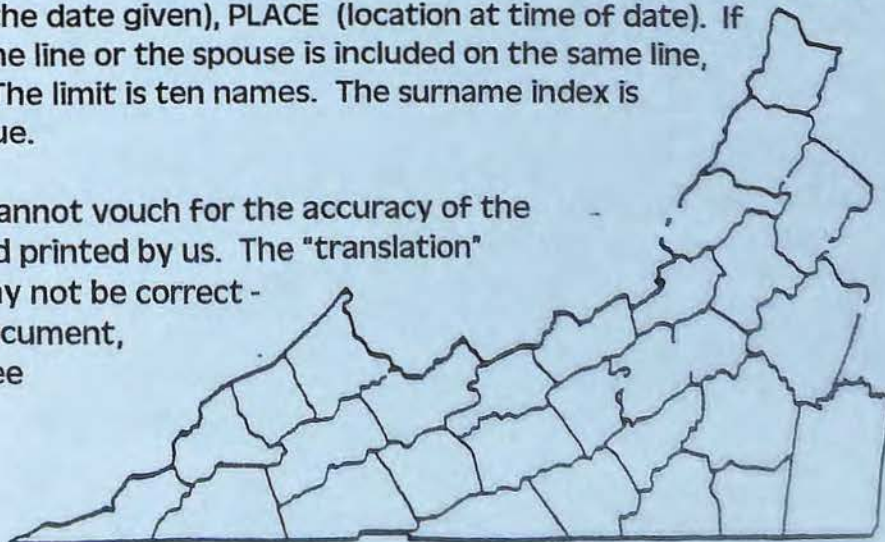

If a large amount of material is sent , it may take some time to publish because we try to have a variety of material in each issue. (1) **READY FOR PUBLICATION** (which the editor loves). Use 8 ½ X 11 paper, with a minimum margin on all sides of 1 inch. Center your title. Be sure to include your name, address and e-mail address. PLEASE read material carefully before submitting, double-check dates and use "spell checker". If you wish to save the cost of postage, articles for publication may be e-mailed to the editor or The Virginia Room. Photos to be included with your submission may also be e-mailed, most formats can be accommodated. (2) **GIVE SOURCE OF MATERIAL.** Original documents - where found, type of record, page number, etc. or, if known, who (or what facility) now has the document in their possession. We CANNOT print material from printed sources unless we have written permission from the publisher, which you must furnish. We must have the source of materials to give credit to the person who has done the work. (3) **DEADLINE** for submitting material should be at least two months before date of publication. (4) **MATERIAL WILL NOT BE RETURNED.**

SURNAME INDEX: Information will include NAME (given and surname), DATE (birth, death, marriage or where living at the date given), PLACE (location at time of date). If this data takes more than one line or the spouse is included on the same line, it will count as two names. The limit is ten names. The surname index is published in the Summer Issue.
