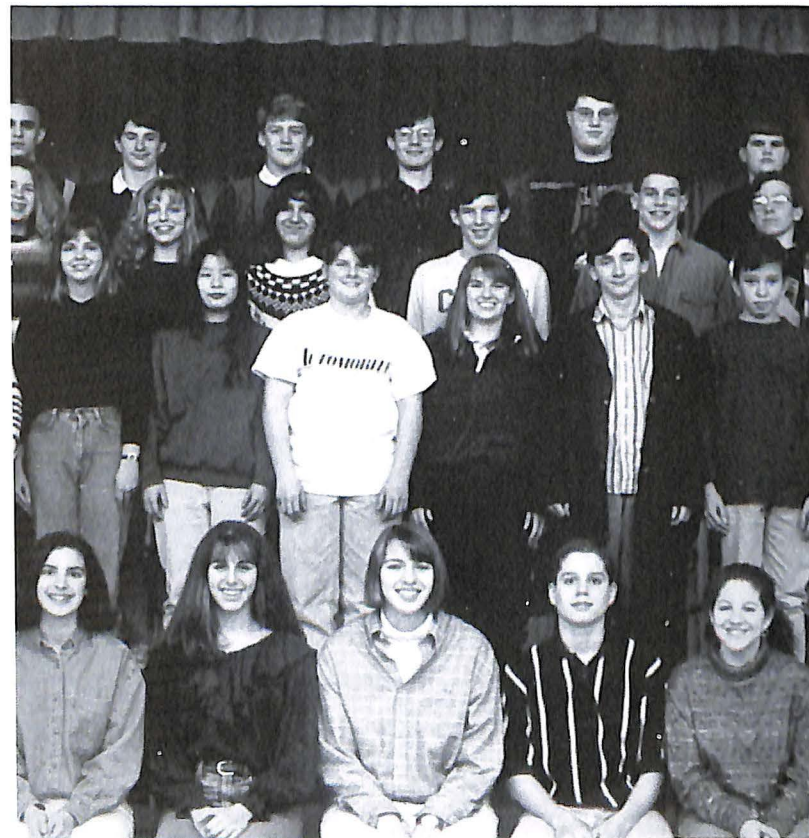

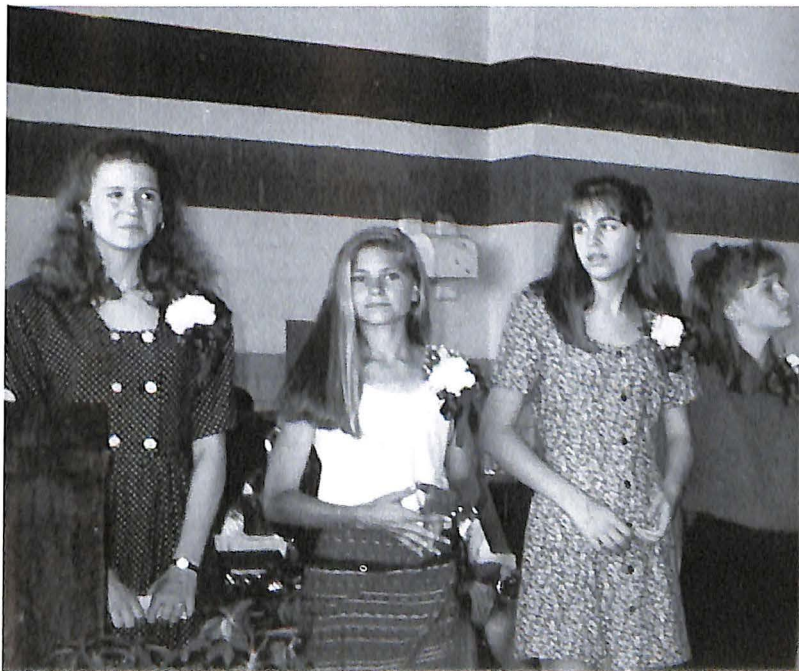
P O W E R S THAT BE

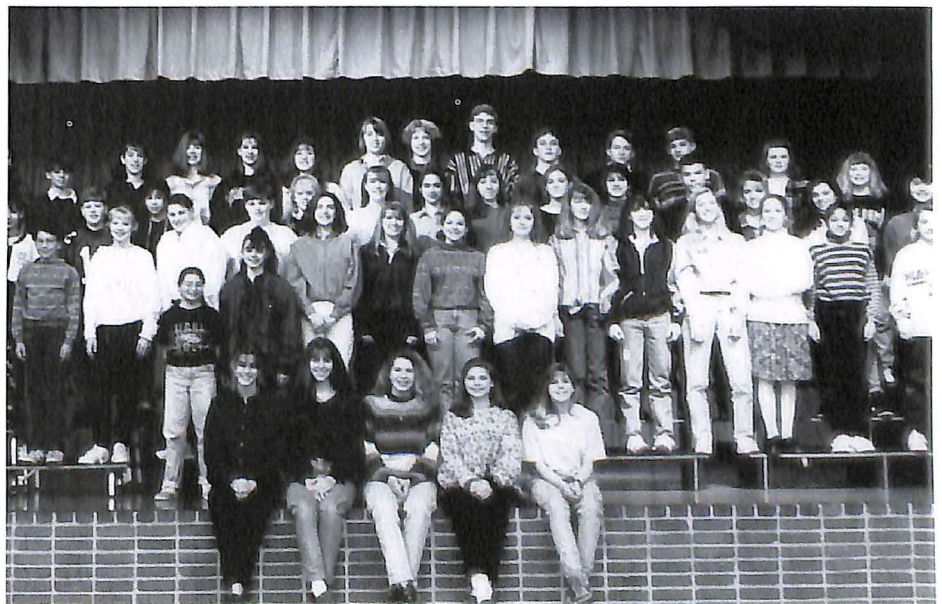
