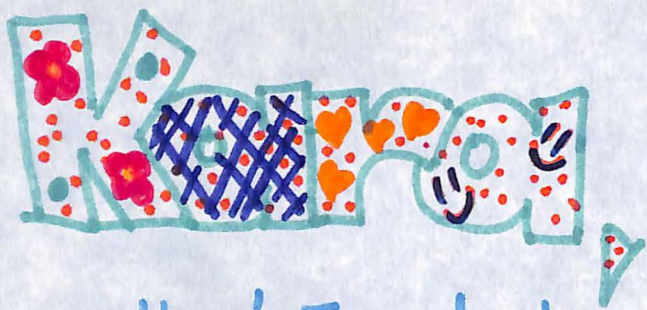

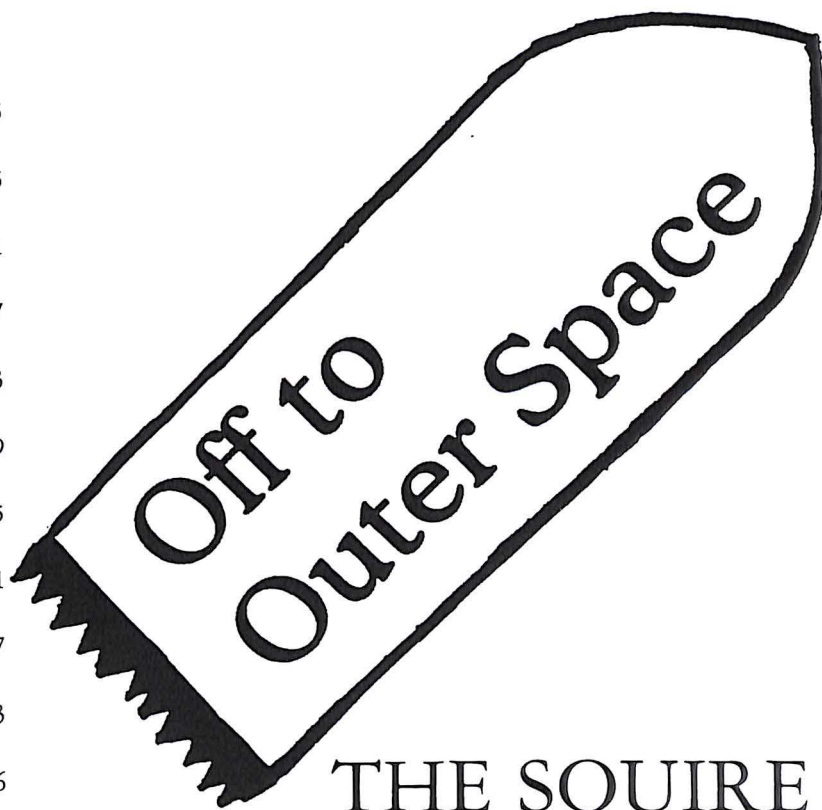

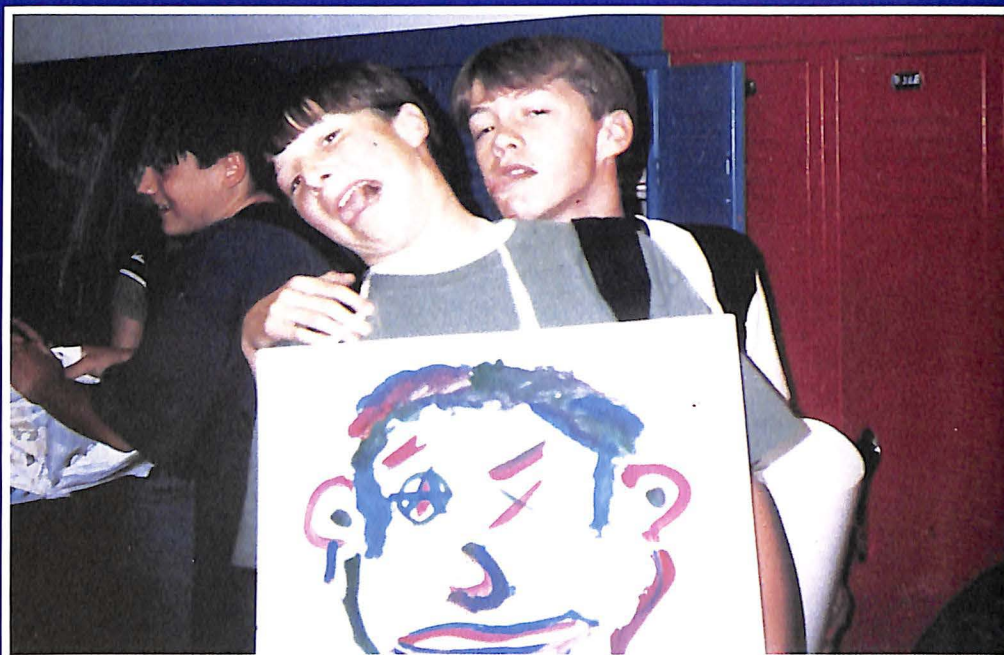

Ever been doing your homework and gotten the feeling that someone is staring at you, even though you're the only one home? Have you ever thought, "What if we're not alone?" What would you do if you found out that your best friend wasn't even human, but was an alien? Are you ever afraid that you'll be abducted in the night and have weird experiments performed on you? It could happen. It may have already! How do you explain all the stories of people being abducted? And what about those mysterious crop circles that farmers have been finding? Maybe we're not as alone as we thought. In fact they could be watching you right now, while you're reading this and looking at your yearbook. Can they see into our minds? Do they know our every thought and movement? Was that teacher you had in 4th grade really from earth? She sure never acted like she was! Or how about that weird kid that used to sit next to you in math; only an alien could be that smart. And, if we aren't alone, then what do aliens look like? Are they ugly? They could look like anything. What if they could become anything that they wanted to? That way, we would never know that they were here. An alien might be able to turn into a chair or a pencil if he felt like it.

Actually, the search for aliens has often been called a science without a subject matter. Some scientists estimate the number of advanced civilizations in the milky way to be anywhere from 1 to 1,000,000. Descriptions of UFO's range from glowing wheels to colored balls of light to cigar, disc, or crescent-shaped objects. The term "flying saucer" was coined in 1947 when a businessman told reporters that while flying a private plane near Mt. Rainier in Washington, he saw nine objects flying near the mountain in formation and at a speed of more than 1600 miles an hour. He described the objects as moving like "a saucer skipping across the water." After that, the description was shortened to flying saucers. The U.S. government has thousands of records of UFO sightings. Ninety percent of all UFO sightings can be explained by natural phenomenon like weather balloons, satellites, aircraft lights, or formations of birds. But what about the other 10%? An astronomer at Northwestern University says that since a few of the most reliable UFO reports have never been clearly explained, this is definite proof that the earth is being visited by aliens.

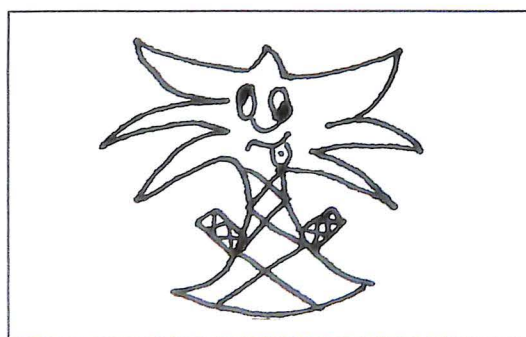
Alien

The National

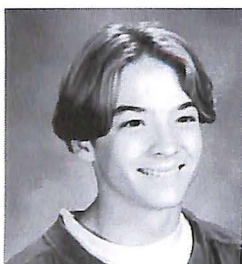

In the guidance sponsored programs there are many people trying to help their friends and the school in a variety of ways. Natural Helpers help their peers on a one-on-one basis. They go through summer training to learn how to use refusal skills and a variety of other skills. Guidance Advisory advises the guidance program. 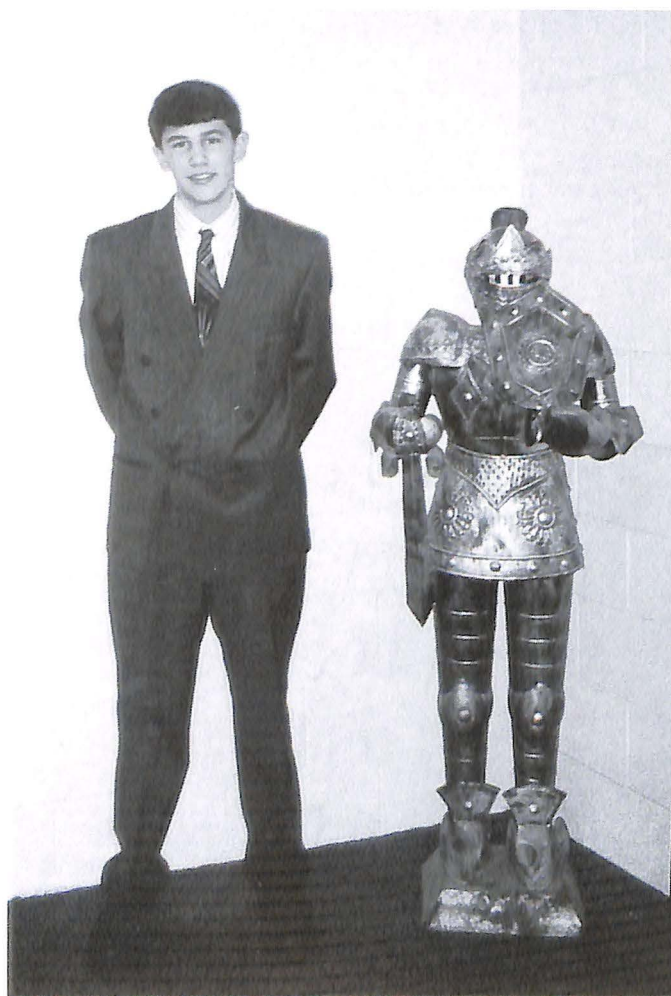
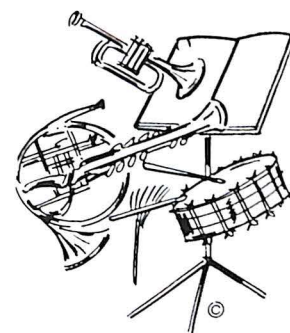


Star QUALITY

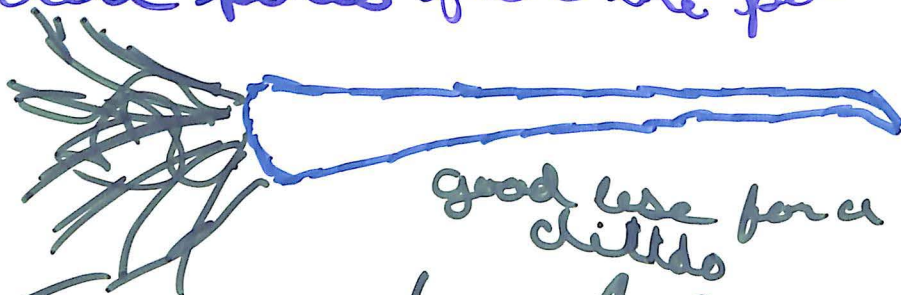
