We're All in the Same

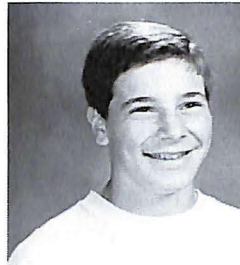

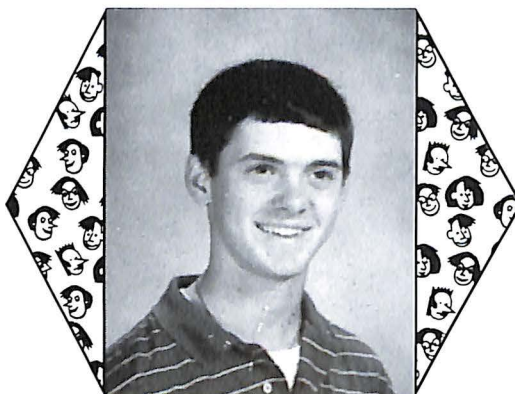
IN MEMORIAM

Robert Giles came to Cave Spring Junior High in 1981. He is remembered as a dedicated teacher who had a quick sense of humor and as a good friend that would listen to his students and help with anything that he could. He began a 7:30 a.m. voluntary Bible study called *Camaraderie*. Mr. Giles planned a Baltimore field trip every year for the entire seventh grade. Robert Goodwin Giles died on May 8, 1997. If you are interested in joining one of these groups, talk to your guidance counselor. The organizations are fun, but do require training and time.

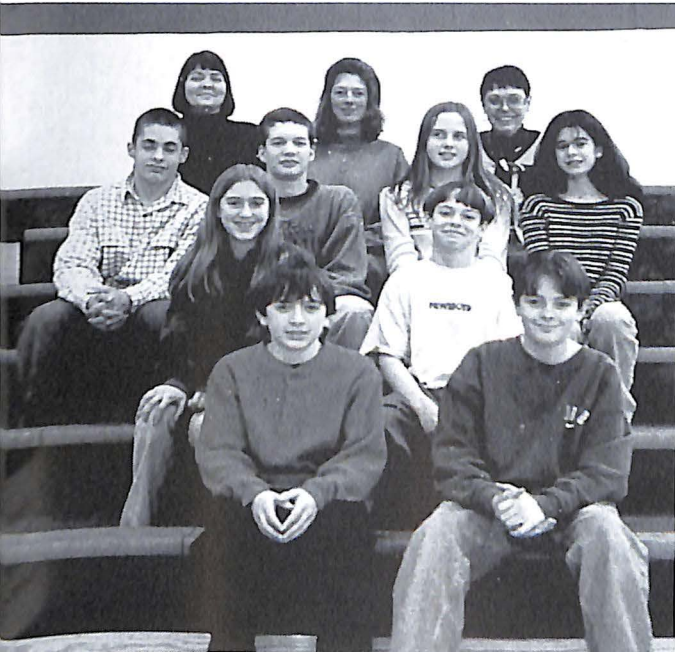

When asked about their likes and dislikes of being a twin; Kelly replied, "I don't like having to share everything." "But we do it anyway," both Kari and Kelly agree.

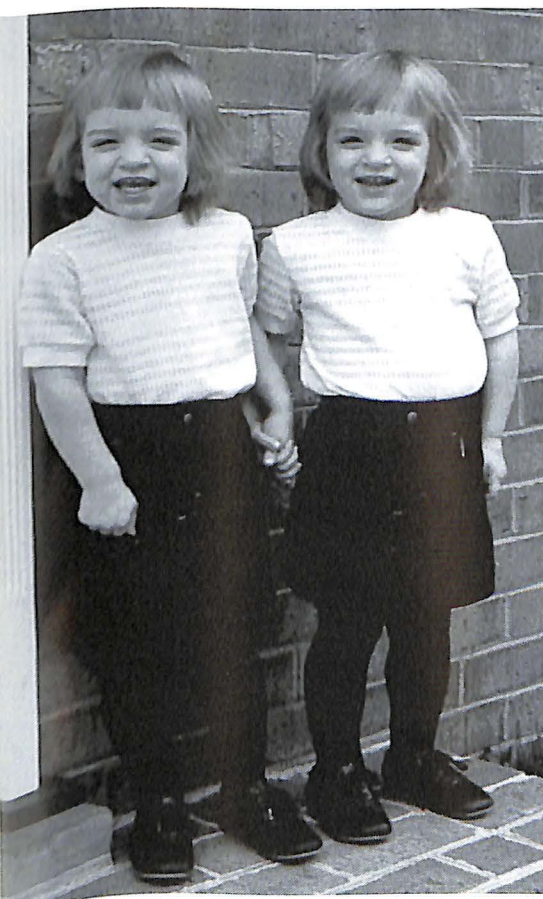

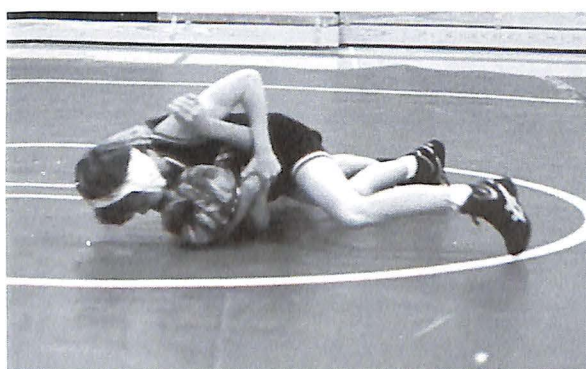


Twist and Turn . . .

Freshmen Athletes

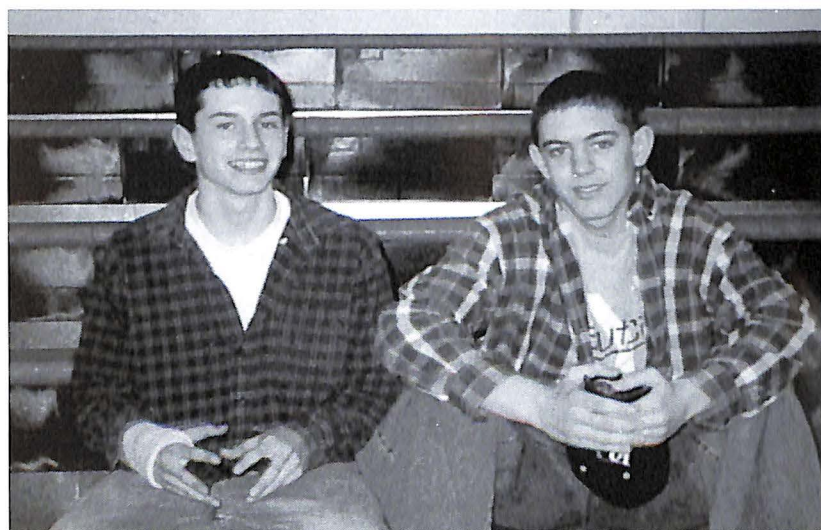

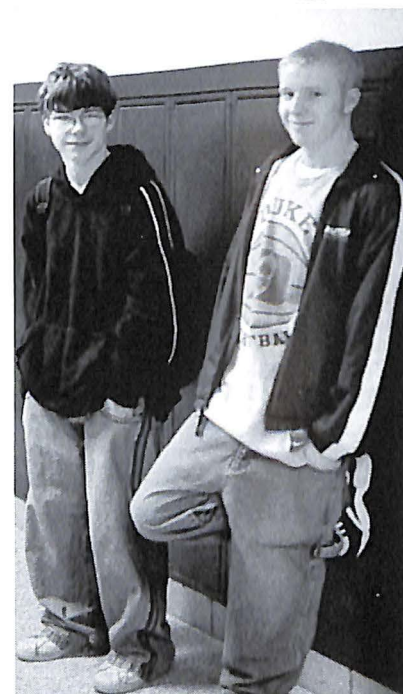
A New Sword for the Stone
