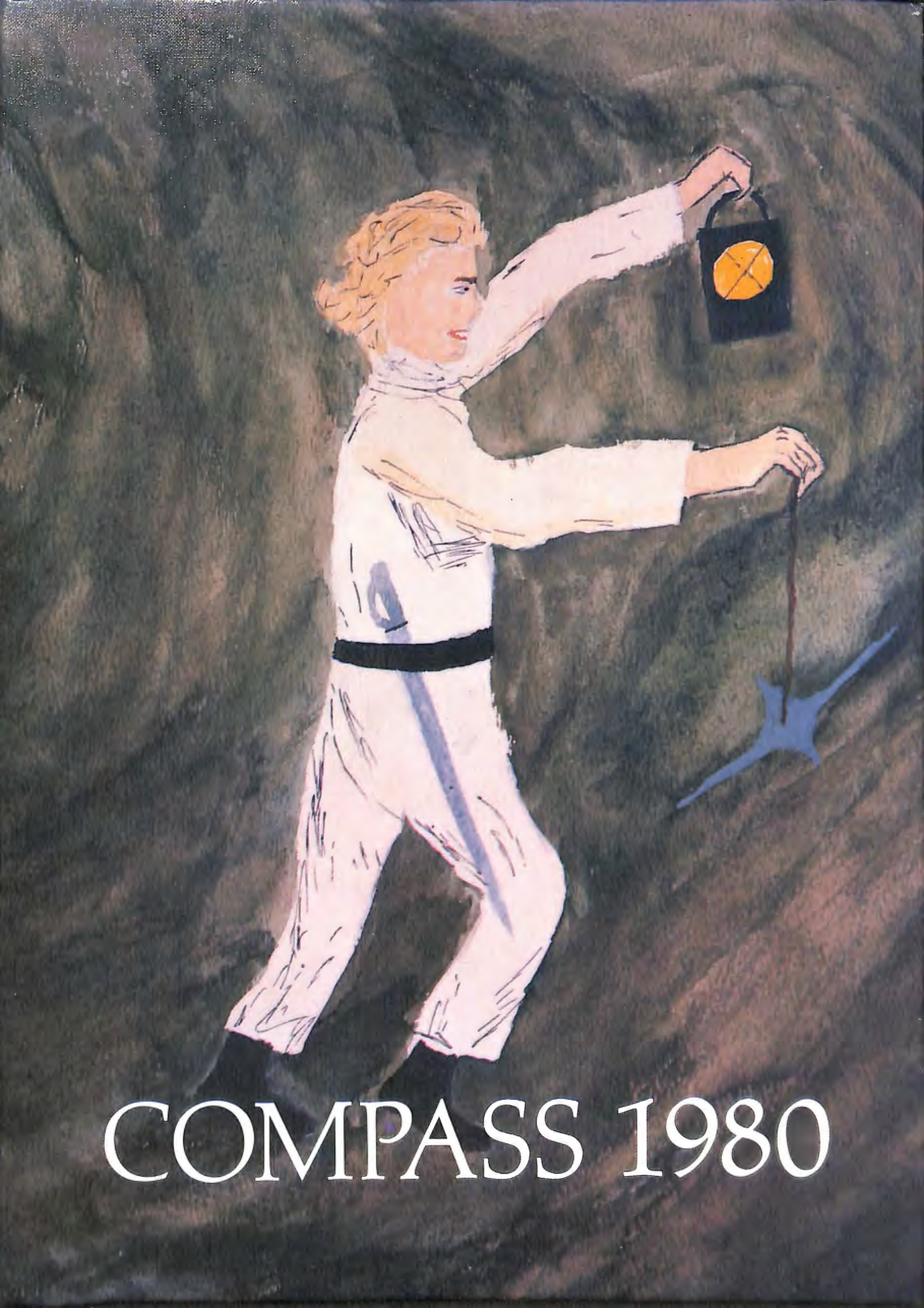

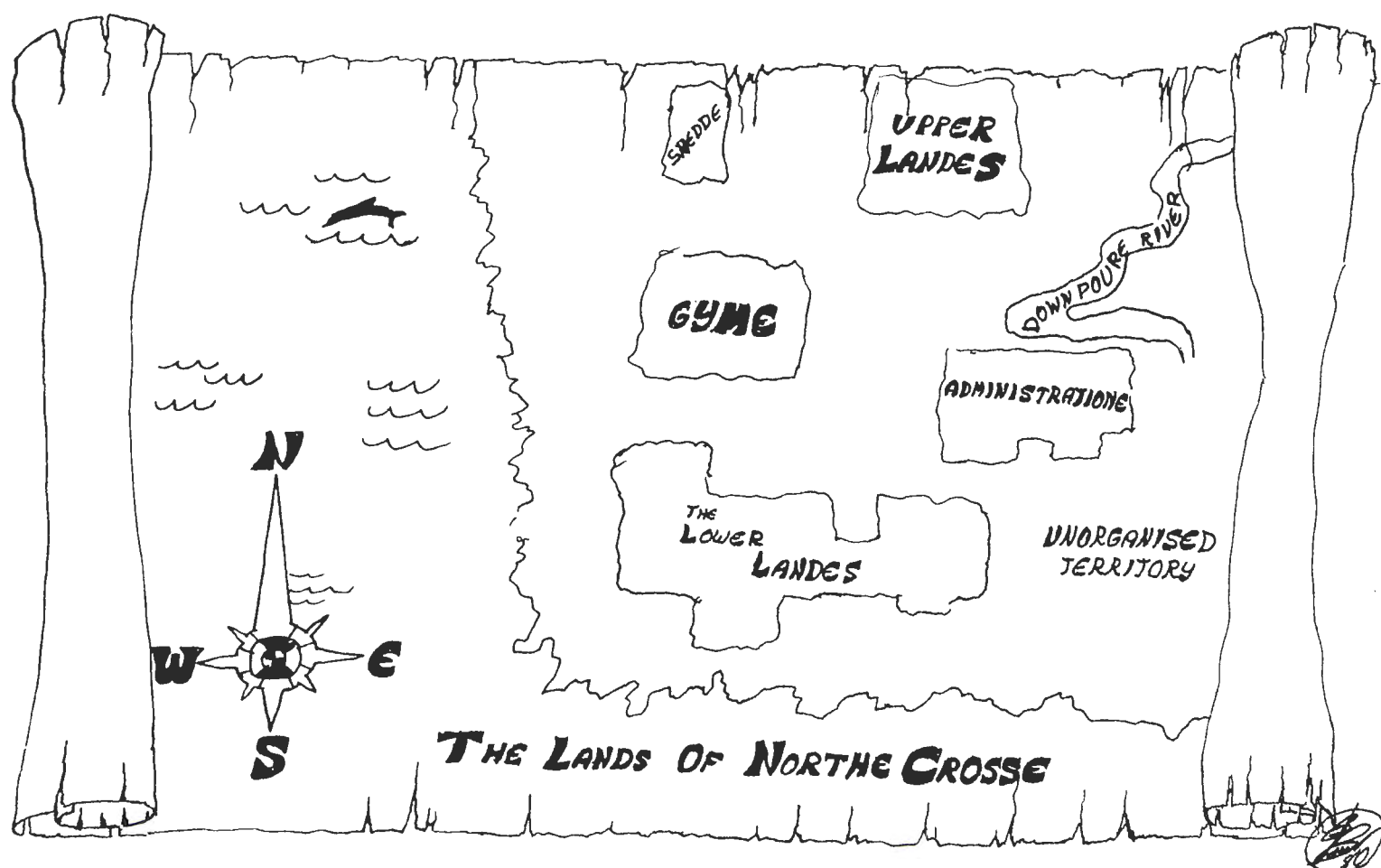

but to us she's a grammar corrective.

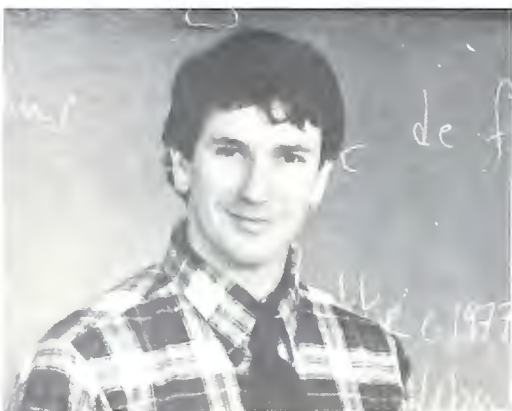
Mr. Meagher does a good imitation,
