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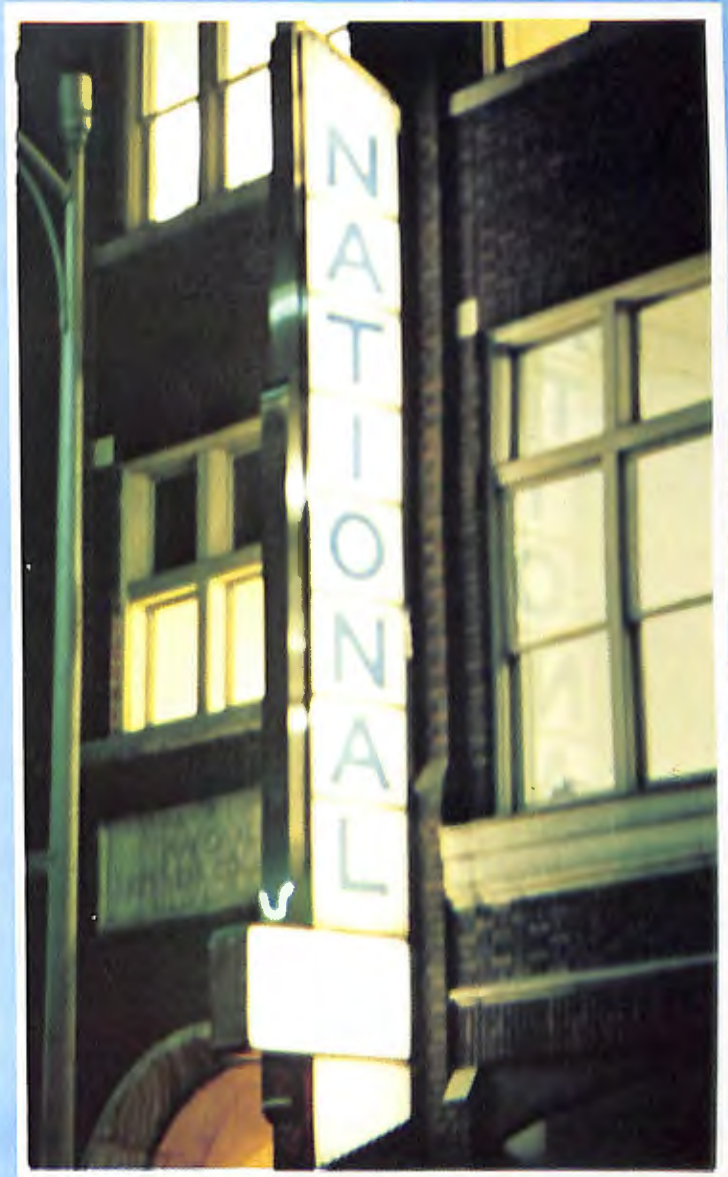

Mr. Coulter, son of the Late Mr. E. M. Coulter, President Emeritus, became an instructor at the College in 1936, after having been graduated from National and Virginia Polytechnic Institute. In 1941 he was called to active duty with the United States Army.

Upon his release from active duty with the rank of Lt. Colonel, he returned to the College in January, 1946, and became Vice-President the following September. In 1951 he succeeded Mr. Smythe as only the 3rd President of National Business College.

President M. K. Coulter, with Mrs. Dorothy Hancock, Vice-President of National Business College. Close co-operation between these two executives has marked the progress of the school, during the 15 years of their office.

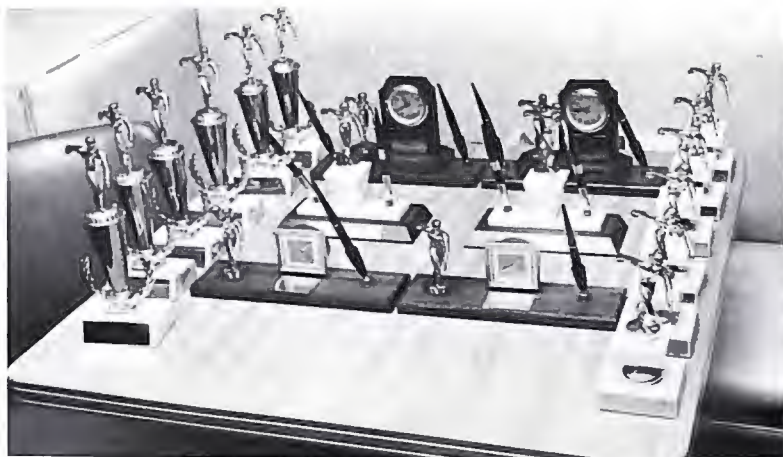

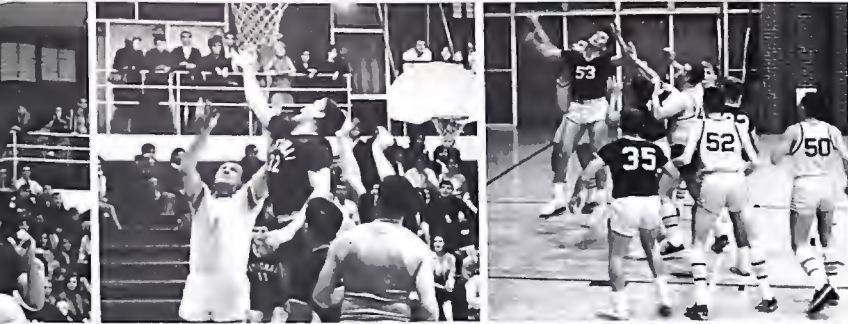
Candid's
